# Motor show ends on high note

Most of the participants in the three-day Dhaka Motor Show that ended yesterday were happy as they witnessed a huge turnout and many of them bagged satisfactory spot

Rangs Ltd, the sole distributor of Mitsubishi brand cars, sold eight new cars at the show -- the highest number followed by Navana Ltd.

Qazi Saad Ulla Hill Alim, assistant sales manager of Rangs Ltd, said his company offered after-sales services that attracted many buyers and helped log good sales.

Navana Ltd, the distributor of Toyota cars in Bangladesh, sold seven cars at the fair.

Toyota, the market leader in personal car segment, sold more than 1,800 cars in 2009.

Shajia Afrin, senior sales executive of Navana, said, the prices of most of the cars sold in the show range from Tk 17 lakh to Tk 2009, and sales would rise further, he said. 75 lakh.

However, some companies were not happy with sales.

Arefin Islam, sales executive of Pacific Motors Ltd, the sole distributor of luxury brand Nissan, said: "Sales at the fair dropped compared to the previous year."

This year the company sold four cars, while the number was five at the last year's

Industry insiders said automotive market in Bangladesh maintained a double-digit growth in the last couple of years mainly because of the flourishing corporate sector and export-oriented enterprises.

Although the annual sale is mostly domi- at 207 stalls.

nated by reconditioned cars, sales of new cars increased to around 6,000 in 2009, up from 4,000-4,500 in 2008 and 3,500-4,000 in 2007, they said.

They said car sales usually remain high in the last three to four months of a fiscal year, when government purchases start.

However, many visitors came to the fair only to know about the prices of cars, motorcycles and trucks, and to compare those with the prices of reconditioned vehicles.

Cars apart, sales of batteries also increased in the last five years, said Mohammad Saifur Rahman, senior market development officer of Rahimafrooz.

Rahimafrooz, the market leader in battery segment, sold more than three lakh pieces of batteries across the country in

"Sales of battery for both commercial vehicles and IPS (instant power supply) devices remain high during the March-July period, as people use batteries more to cope with the summer," Rahman said.

The company logged satisfactory sales in lubricant, tyre and battery at the fair, he said. Rahimafrooz also displayed its new bat-

tery Globatt, which is meant for export to the European and North American markets.

A total of 60 companies showcased cars, trucks, motorcycles, motor parts and accessories such as batteries, tyres and lubricants

#### BAT sets up safe drinking water plant in Kushtia

British American Tobacco (BAT) Bangladesh has recently launched a safe drinking water plant at Bheramara in Kushtia, said a statement.

The company's new CSR (corporate social responsibility) initiative -- Probaho -aims at providing safe drinking water in arsenic-prone areas.

BAT Bangladesh has taken the initiative to help the community where it operates by providing them with safe drinking water to complement development efforts made by the government to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs). Water and sanitation is a critical factor to achieve the MDGs by 2015. The company has so far set up six filtration plants to make water free from arsenic and other harmful contents.

### JS body moves on quick disposal of revenue cases

A parliamentary body yesterday asked the authorities concerned to take immediate steps for disposing of 12,000 cases involving around Tk 5,000 crore as revenue, now pending with the High Court for years.

The parliamentary standing committee on finance ministry also directed the ministry to increase manpower at the income tax tribunal and reorganise it through adding members from legislative and account sections of the government.

"The committee called for recovering the huge amount as revenue from different organisations that owe to the National Board of Revenue," AHM Mustafa Kamal, chairman of the committee, told reporters after a meeting at Jatiya Sangsad (JS) Bhaban. "Different organisations filed petition with the High

Court about the revenues and the number of cases has now piled up as strong steps were not taken in the past to dispose of the cases," Kamal said.

"We have asked the authorities concerned to settle those cases as soon as possible to recover the money," he added.

The committee at the meeting also recommended turning income tax ordinance-1984 into law.

The parliamentary body has directed the ministry to ease procedures in income tax return and self-assessed income tax systems.

On preparing of an income tax law, the committee chief said the income tax ordinance was enacted in 1984 when there was no parliament session. Many foreigners face difficulties with the present income tax ordinance as they do not get any information about the matter through internet.

The strike called by the workers' body is a sequel to a clash with Ghojadanga Truck Owners Association over an assault on an Indian truck driver by BDR at Bhomra land port on March 19.

Bhomra Customs Superintendent Hasan Morshed confirmed the incident and said the governemnt is facing huge revenue loss because of the strike.

#### **US hosts next Apec talks**

The United States said Friday it would host annual talks among trade ministers of 21 economies of the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation forum in the western state of Montana in May next year.

"Bringing the APEC Trade Ministers to Montana will broaden our horizons both literally and figuratively, giving our partners a fresh perspective on the diverse places from which America's entrepreneurs and exports can spring," said Ron Kirk, the top US trade envoy.

"The American West has always been a place of limitless possibility," he said. Farm-rich Montana is often referred to "Big Sky" country, well known for its mountainous western region, part of the famous Rocky Mountains.

#### GP declares 60pc cash dividend STAR BUSINESS REPORT

Grameenphone (GP), the only listed telecom company in Bangladesh stockmarket, has recommended 60 percent cash dividend for the year 2009.

The recommendation was made at GP's board meeting on Friday, according to price sensitive disclosure by the mobile phone operator published in different newspapers yesterday.

The net asset value (NAV) of the company stood at Tk 5,015 crore with NAV per share at Tk 37.14 and earnings per share (EPS) at Tk 12.08. Net operating cash flow per share was Tk 24.77 at the end of December 31, 2009.

The annual general meeting (AGM) will be held on June 8, while the record date will be on April 8. Time and venue of the AGM will be announced later.

# Ctg port to be digitised by year-end

Chittagong port will be digitalised by year-end to upgrade the premier seaport's operations.

The port will be brought under a full computer network as part of digitalisation under Chittagong Port Trade Facilitation Umbrella Project, said officials with Chittagong Port Authority.

The Tk 225 crore project will be implemented with the financial assistance of the Asian Development Bank.

To this end, all activities including submission of bill of entry for export-import and the process for imposing duty of the Chittagong Customs House have already been brought under automation. Work for implementation of two projects -- the Port

Management Information System (PMIS) and the Container Terminal Management System (CTMS) -- is nearly complete. The projects are being executed to make other opera-

tional activities technology-dependent, including administrative management, goods handling of ships and scanning of goods delivery of the port. "To turn Chittagong port into a world-standard port, its

activities are being computerised," said RU Ahmed, chairman of Chittagong Port Authority.
