
"This exhibition is our way of celebrating the month of independence," said Subir Chowdhury, director of Bengal Gallery.

The exhibition is supported by BRAC Bank.

"Once we were in a village and were trying to get rid of mud. The mud was rather sticky and wouldn't come off. A village girl noticed this and said that the soil of our country has such love that it does not let go. There is just something about the country that is ingrained in our souls," said Syed Mahbubur Rahman, Deputy Managing Director of BRAC Bank.

"The reason I didn't have a solo exhibition in the past 12 years is because I just didn't have the time. Along with my school, I was preoccupied with other obligations," said Chanchal Mahmood.

"I would say that this generation of photographers is rather lucky. Back in the day, we had to struggle a lot to learn the technicalities of the medium. Now there are courses and degrees on photography. Taking photography as a career was unthinkable when I was young. My father didn't accept my decision to

> Mahmood's photographs do not only speak of the Liberation War, but also about the rather subtle beauty of this country that is often overlooked.

"I love the greenery manifested the portrayal of our national flag or in our nature," said the photographer. It is a wonder how such finer details that go unnoticed by most, could create such a beautiful

There are also photos of lonesome travellers and birds that have not yet spread their wings. There is a similar feeling of emancipation in both images.

Fashion photography is said to be Chanchal Mahmood's forte. Naturally this aspect was also prevalent in his exhibition through portraits of popular actors and models.

There is an ode to flowers at the exhibition as 'Kash Phool' sway gently in the breeze, and orchids bloom in magnificent colours. The national flower water lily emerges demurely radiant in a photo.

There is an amusing photo that draws most of the viewers' attention: three children and a goat behind them. It seems as if all, including the goat had posed well, and yet the image has spontaneity written all over it.

Bangladesh, as a theme, has so many aspects that it is hard to imagine that all of these can be covered with one exhibition.

"My teachers had always asked me to put forward stories of success before anything else. My work reflects that philosophy," said Mahmood.

The absence of the late photographer Dr Nawazesh Ahmed, who was supposed to open the exhibition, was felt deeply. "He had been a constant source of inspiration," said Mahmood.

The exhibition will remain open till March 30.

Theatre troupe Battola premieres "Khona"

Premiere of theatre troupe Battola's latest production "Khona" was held at the Experimental Theatre Hall, Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy on March 18. Written by Samina Lutfa Nitra and directed by Mohammad Ali Haider, "Khona" is the third production of Battola. Theatre personalities Sara Zaker, Shimul Yousuf and President of Battola, Dr. Saleque Khan, among others, attended the premiere.

The story of Khona, a legendary philosopher-astrologer from ancient Bengal, is shrouded in mystery. Khona induced a violent rage and jealousy in her father-in-law, Boraho, who was the royal astrologer. Boraho had

Khona's tongue severed.

In the play, Samina Lutfa Nitra has tried to explore a myth -- are the famed adages known as 'Khonar Bachan' (words of Khona) truly her legacy or did she become the mouthpiece of the illiterate farmers' agricultural experiences? Was Khona a victim of male chauvinism or was it a class conflict, as she enraged the rulers by trying to improve the lives of farmers?

Nitra played the titular role. The cast also included Mohammad Ali Haider, Nasiruddin Nadim, Sharmin Eti, Toufique Hasan Bhuiyan and Tahmina Sultana. Bratya Amin and Sharmin Eti jointly directed the music. Abu Daud Ashrafi is the set and light designer of the play.
