

RU BCL activists stab four Shibir men, beat another

Chhatra League (BCL) activists severely stabbed four Shibir cadres...

Monday.

Witnesses said, a group of BCL activists led by Masud hit Salam, Hanif and Rikat with iron rods and stabbed them in front Begum Rokeya Hall yesterday noon.

Sources said, they had come from Pabna district a few days ago to meet a female relative who is a resident student of the hall.

BCL activists also hurled abuses at the female student as she protested the attack, witnesses said.

Later, BCL leaders and activists handed over the three to the Motihar police.

Besides, the BCL men severely stabbed Abul Basher

suspecting him a Shibir cadre on Tukitaki premises at around 11:30am yesterday and handed him over to the law enforcers.

Earlier, the BCL activists of Bangabandhu Hall unit caught Abul Motin from the hall gate and severely beat him with sticks Monday night. He was also handed over to police.

Contacted, Tofazzel Hossain, officer-in-charge (OC) of Motihar police station told this correspondent that they will take legal steps against the arrestees after quizzing and investigation.

Ilyas Ali, wife granted bail

The district and Sessions Judge of Sylhet yesterday granted ad interim bail to the former lawmaker and district BNP chief M Ilyas Ali and his wife Tahsina Rushdi in the case filed by the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) about 2 and half years ago.

The same court on Monday issued warrant of arrest against the couple as they skipped court on the day.

The judge also set 10 March for framing charges against the accused.

Ilyas and his wife appeared before judge Momin Ullah yesterday and prayed for ad interim bail, Public Prosecutor Misbah Uddin Siraj told this correspondent.

The ACC on May 6, 2009 pressed charges against the couple. The Chief Judicial Magistrate of Sylhet sent the case records to the District and Sessions Judge on March 4 this year, court sources said.

The then ACC Assistant Director, Sylhet, Khandaker Enamul Basir filed the case on July

21, 2008 with Sylhet Kotwali Police Station against the couple for amassing wealth worth Tk 91 lakh and hiding information.

Earlier, the anti-graft watchdog issued a notice on Ilyas on January 28, 2008 asking him to submit his wealth statement to the commission. Accordingly, Ilyas submitted his wealth report to the ACC Sylhet office through his lawyer on February 14.

Ilyas went into hiding in January 2007 and remained absconding till mid July that year as his name was on the list of 50 corruption suspects published by the ACC.

In his statement, Ilyas showed wealth worth Tk 3.99 crore in the name of the couple. The property included two vehicles worth Tk 1.5 crore, a house at Banani in Dhaka, money in cash and land property at village home and in the capital.

After investigation, the ACC found that Ilyas and his wife had concealed information of wealth worth Tk 91 lakh in the document submitted to the commission.

Abducted boy rescued in Kishoreganj, 4 arrested

Police on Sunday night rescued a kidnapped boy and arrested four people on charge of abduction.

Police said, Mehedi Hasan Rahat, 9, a class three student of Anwara Kindergarten and son of Mafiz Uddin of Hossainpur Sadar upazila was kidnapped by Azharul Islam, 21, son of Jalal of Khurshid Mohol village under Gafargaon upazila in Mymensingh on Sunday afternoon.

Azhar forcibly took Rahat on a tempo near the school. He confined the boy to the house of his relative late Faruk Master at Char Pakundia village under Pakundia upazila.

Afterwards, Azhar demanded over mobile Tk 1.5 lakh from Rahat's sister as ransom.

Amrutaj, mother of Rahat filed a case with Hossainpur police and a team led by ASP Nasir Uddin later arrested Azhar from Pakundia bazaar Sunday mid-night.

Following Azhar's confession police rescued Rahat from Faruk Master's house around 2:00am.

Police also arrested three accomplices of Azhar.
