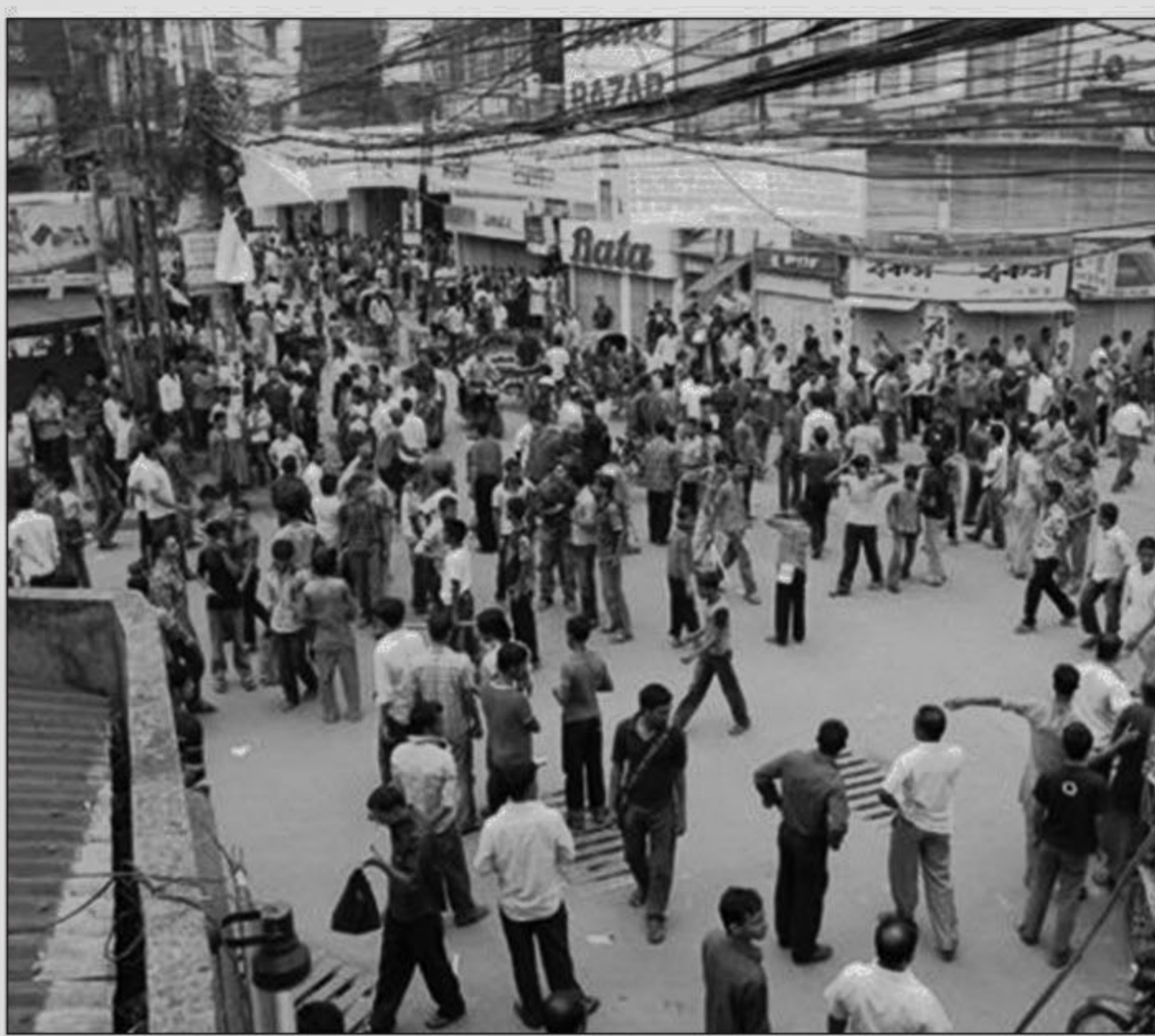


'THEFT' OF OMS RICE IN KHULNA Ruling party men at loggerheads

STAFF CORRESPONDENT, Khulna Leaders of Khalishpur units of Jubo League, Chhatra League and Swachhchasebok League yesterday stormed into Khulna Press Club VIP lounge where OMS rice dealer Mridha Belayet Hossain was addressing a press conference, refuting allegation against him of selling rice meant for OMS in black market.

selling OMS rice in black market is a conspiracy to tarnish his political image. A group of policemen, who are beneficiaries of four-party alliance government, cooked up the conspiracy, he alleged. General Secretary of AL Khulna Sadar upazila unit Saiful Islam, General Secretary of AL Khalihpur unit Monirul Islam Bashar and President of ward-14 unit of AL Kazi Enayet Ali were present at the press conference. When the leaders of the AL associate bodies protested his statements, saying that Belayet is a black marketer and smuggler, his supporters swooped on the leaders. Police on duty at the press club compound rushed to the VIP lounge and brought situation under control. Jubo League, Chhatra League and Swachhchasebok League leaders also alleged that dealer Belayet had sold the entire amount of OMS rice allotted against him on the black market. They highly appreciated police for arresting him with four bags of rice.

Sylhet shop owners keep shutters down for 6 hrs Demand release of two employees

STAFF CORRESPONDENT, Sylhet Shop owners at malls and in other areas of the city kept shutters down for six hours yesterday demanding immediate release of two employees of a shop at Al-Hamra Shopping City. The employees, Sayedur Rahman and Shabbir, were arrested along with three shop owners on Monday night following a clash with police at the shopping mall. The agitating shop owners and employees also blocked the road from court point to Chouhatta intersection for one and a half hours from 11:30am. They withdrew the road blockade after city Mayor Badar Uddin Ahmed

Kamran and AL central Organising Secretary Misbah Uddin Siraj assured them of taking immediate measures to free the two shop employees on bail. Addressing a rally in court point area with AL-Hamra Shopping City Baybosayee Samity President Abdus Salam in the chair, the speakers demanded withdrawal of the police assault case against shop owners and employees of the mall. City Mayor Badar Uddin Ahmed Kamran and AL central Organising Secretary Misbah Uddin Siraj also spoke. Fifteen people, including three cops, were injured during a clash between police and shop owners and employees at Al-Hamra

Shopping City on Monday night. The trouble began at around 8:00pm when a customer and the employees of a cosmetics shop at the mall exchanged heated word over price of an item. The customer went out of the mall and returned to the mall with a patrol police team at around 8:30pm. Seeing two people with knives in hands with the policemen, the shop owners and employees swooped on them, leading to a clash between the two sides. After the incident, police arrested three shop owners and two employees of the mall. They (police) later released the shop owners and produced the employees in a court that sent them to jail.

Rab recovers arms, ammo in 3 dists

STAFF CORRESPONDENT, Ctg Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) yesterday seized two firearms and five bullets from Nimtala area under Sitakunda upazila in the district. Acting on a tip-off that an armed gang gathered at Taipat Road near Dhaka-Chittagong highway to commit criminal offence, a squad of Rab-7 Chittagong raided the area at around 12:15am. Sensing presence of the elite force the criminals fled the scene immediately. Later, the Rab-men recovered a .22 pistol with a magazine, a light gun (LG) and five bullets of M-16 rifle searching the area. In Dinajpur, two suspected gunrunners were arrested along with four arms and bullets from Dhanhati crossing in Birampur upazila on Tuesday, reports UNB. Acting on a tip-off, a Rab team stopped them at the intersection at about 11:30am while they were coming to Birampur from frontier Dangapara area in a motorbike.

The elite force searched their bodies and seized two pistols, two magazines and 12 bullets. A correspondent from Munshiganj adds: A gang of gunrunners fled away leaving nine firearms after a gun battle with the members of Rapid Action Battalion at a char under Louhajang on Sunday night. The firearms included seven foreign made revolvers and two pipe guns. Rab-3 officials said the gunfight took place as the criminals opened fire on the law enforcers at remote Maowarchar at around 10:30pm. An official of Rab-3 told this correspondent that the Rab personnel in guise of clients went to the spot following a deal to buy 10 firearms from the gang. But as soon they understood that the arms purchasers were Rab men, they opened fire at them and sped away by speedboats leaving their firearms on the spot, said the official.

6 Shibir men held in Ctg remanded

STAFF CORRESPONDENT, Ctg Six Shibir activists arrested on Monday night while holding a secret meeting, were remanded yesterday. The court of the Chittagong Metropolitan Magistrate granted one day's remand following a prayer by the Investigation Officer (IO) for three days' remand on Tuesday. The Shibir men are Mostafa Araf, 23, Mojamal Hossain, 22, Syed Moin Uddin, 25, Ishtiaq Reza, 24, Moinal Hasan, 24, and Rashed Chowdhury, 23. They were arrested along with a number of Islamist books on Monday night at the time the Shibir men were holding a secret meeting on the rooftop of a seven-storey building at Gulistan Residential Area in city's Ghat Forhad Bag area keeping the gates of the building under lock and key, police said. IO Sadip said the Shibir men were arrested under Section 54 and brought to the police station yesterday for quizzing.

Schoolgirl abducted in broad daylight Another untraced for 29 days

STAR NATIONAL DESK Our Correspondent in Kushtia reports: Police failed to rescue schoolgirl Shakila who was abducted from Gangni in Meherpur 29 days ago. On Monday the family members blamed police for inaction at a press conference held at Gangni upazila press club. They alleged that police did not arrest any of the culprits despite filing case against them soon after the incident. Sources said, Shakila Khatun, 14, daughter of Raisul Islam of Jorapukuria was abducted by one Aiytal alias Nayan. She was a student of class ten at Kalaroa Pilot High School. Quoting locals police said a gang led by Nasim, son of Azibar Sardar of the same village, used to tease Kalyani on her way to school regularly. Yesterday morning, while she was going to school, Nasim and his accomplices abducted the girl and took her to an unknown place by a private car. Victim's father Uttam Kumar Ghosh filed a case with Kalaroa police accusing Nasim and four others. Contacted, officer-in-charge (OC) of Kalaroa PS Enamul Haque said, they are trying to rescue the girl and arrest the culprits.

SNIPPETS Two get life for murder STAFF CORRESPONDENT, Bogra A Bogra court yesterday sentenced two people to life imprisonment for killing a man in Kahalu upazila of the district in 2007. The convicts are Afsar Ali Mondol, 35, of Dhekra village, and Musa Paramanik, 35, of Niamatpur village under the upazila. Judge Nitai Chandra Saha of the Additional District and Sessions Court-3 also fined the convicts Tk 20,000 each, in default, they are to suffer two more years in jail. According to the prosecution, Afsar Ali Mondol and Musa Paramanik borrowed Tk 40,000 from Mojahar Ali of Niamatpur village three years ago. As Mojahar pressed for return of the money, Afsar and Musa abducted Mojahar on August 13, 2007. Mojahar's wife Moslema Begum filed an abduction case with Kahalu Police Station on August 17 the same year. Mojahar's body was found in the septic tank of an abandoned house at the village on August 19. BAU teachers' fresh ultimatum OUR CORRESPONDENT, Mymensingh Teachers of Bangladesh Agriculture University (BAU) yesterday issued a fresh ultimatum to arrest the culprits involved in March 17 attack on a proctor, students and employees of the university by March 28. Otherwise, they threatened to launch a fresh agitation programme on March 29. A group of outsiders attacked Assistant Proctor Prof Alamgir Hossain, students and employees on the night of March 17 as they opposed a programme organised by the outsiders, marking the birth anniversary of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman on the campus without prior permission of the university authorities. 59 hurt in Sirajganj clash OUR CORRESPONDENT, Sirajganj At least 50 people were injured in a clash between two groups of labourers in Baotira ring embankment area in Shahjadpur upazila of the district yesterday. Police also arrested 27 people on the spot. Police and WDB officials said the labourers of the two groups clash over taking work for reconstruction of Baotira ring embankment that collapsed a few days ago due to strong current of the Jamuna. Four robbers arrested OUR CORRESPONDENT, C'nawabganj Police arrested four robbers, raiding different villages under Gomostapur upazila of Chapainawabganj district in the last two days. The arrestees are Milon, 30, Saiful Islam, 24, Mukul, 45, and, Ismail, 25. Police said the four entered the house of one Nazimuddin at Madhaipur village under Gomostapur upazila on the night of March 20 by breaking open the main gate. They beat up the family members and looted gold ornaments and others valuables.
