

Alleged killer of army man held

Kotwali police on Sunday night arrested one Dulal on charge of killing army man Ahadul Islam.

Police arrested Dulal of Sathgara Mistripura under Sadar upazila from Keramotia mosque area while returning home after shopping at Rangpur municipality market at about 8:00pm.

Officer-in-charge of Kotwali police station Abdur

Rashid said Dulal during primary interrogation confessed that he along with one of his accomplices stabbed Ahadul Islam to death and robbed his belongings including money and cell phone.

Police also recovered the cell phone and taka 4,100 from Dulal's house.

Early Sunday army man Ahadul Islam was killed by muggers at Goneshpur area while he was going to his father-in-law's house from Rangpur central bus terminal.

BCL factions at IU lock in fierce clash: 15 injured

At least 15 activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League Islamic University (IU) unit were injured in a factional clash on the campus yesterday.

Two IU BCL factions--one led by Organising Secretary Jahangir Hossain and another by Ali Murtoza Khasru--clashed following assault on an activist belonging to Jahangir group by their party rivals in the morning.

Campus sources said the activists of Khasru group beat up Zahid severely at Arts Faculty at around 10:00am. He was rushed to university medical center.

Immediately after the incident, Jahangir and Khasru went to the medical center and locked in an altercation. At one stage, activists of the two factions, equipped with sticks and iron rods, attacked each other, leaving 15 people from both sides injured.

On information, police went to the medical centre and

dispersed the feuding groups. As Khasru and his supporters took shelter at Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Hall, Jahangir groups entered the dormitory by breaking open the collapsible gate. Being intercepted by police, they entered the provost's room and damaged three computers and official documents.

IU BCL sources said Khasru, younger brother of one of the top Gono Bahini leaders Ali Ehsan Kalu, is trying to capture the post of the general secretary of the unit. Police said they arrested Khasru in January 27 on information that he was planning to create chaos on the campus. He was released on bail on February 2.

1 killed, 135 hurt as villagers clash

One person was killed and at least 135 people were injured as rival groups of villagers in three districts clashed yesterday and the day before.

Our Staff Correspondent in Bogra reports: A man was killed and at least 35 others were injured in a clash between two groups over a piece of land at Jugirbhaban village in Kahlalu upazila of the district yesterday morning.

Locals said the clash ensued between Profullah group and Sanatan Goshwami supporters at about 9:00am over control of 100 bighas of debottor (gifted) land.

Separate incidents in three districts

Both the groups equipped with sticks and locally made weapons attacked each other, leaving one Mokshed, 35, dead and at least 35 injured. The clash continued for about one and a half hours.

Mokshed died on way to capital Dhaka for treatment while the injured were admitted to the local hospitals and clinics.

Our Correspondent in Netrakona reports: At least 50 people were injured as rival villagers clashed over occupy-

ing a water body at Ichhapur village under Khaliajuri upazila in the district.

Police and locals said there was a conflict between Abdul Malek and Indranath Barman over occupying the water body. Yesterday morning when Indranath and his men went to the disputed water body for fishing, Malek and his people attacked them with sharp and lethal weapons. At least 50 people from both groups were injured in the fierce clash.

Seriously injured Abdul Malek, Raham Ali, Sanjit Kumer, Abdul Khalek, Sanju Mia, Nani, Ramzan Ali and Sobahan were sent to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital in critical condition. Others were admitted into local health complex.

Two separate cases were filed with Khaliajuri police station in this connection.

In Habiganj, over 50 people were injured in a fierce clash between two rival groups at Mugkandi village in Bahubal upazila on Sunday.

Police and locals said there was longstanding conflict between Akhanji family and Londoni group of Satkapon union.

With prior announcement, supporters of two groups equipped with home made lethal weapons attacked each other in the evening leaving over 50 people from both sides injured.

On information, police rushed to the spot and fired 10 black shots in a bid to bring the situation under control.

Of the injured, five were admitted to Sylhet Osmani Medical College Hospital in critical condition.
