

....... Japan Foundation assisted Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy (BSA) in organising a weeklong workshop on Japanese water-based woodcut prints. As part of the initiative an exhibition of Japanese artworks is being held at

National Art Gallery, BSA.

Noted Japanese printmakers Shu Ueno and Toshiya Suzuki are conducting the workshop that ends today. Veteran Bangladeshi printmaker Anisuzzaman is the coordinator at the workshop. Participating painters are Rokeya Sultana, Sheikh Mohammad Rokonuzzaman,

Golam Faruk Bebul, Mohammad Jasimuddin, Mokhlesur Rahman, Selina Chowdhury Mili, Rezwanur Rahman, Asmita Alam Shammi, Zafor Iqbal Jewel, Kamruzzaman and others.

Shu Ueno is a former professor and director of Sokei University of Fine Arts and Design, one of the leading

Asian art institutes. He is an expert in water-based woodcut prints and has received several awards for his contribution to the field.

Ueno said, "This is my first visit to Bangladesh. The artists of Bangladesh are very congenial and proud of their heritage and independence. I have been introduced to many artists and art scholars here.

"I think, concept is very important when creating something. I like to focus on human relationships. Works that highlight only colours and compositions do not impress me that much."

Anisuzzaman, coordinator of the workshop and teacher of Printmaking, Faculty of Fine Arts, Dhaka University, said, "I consider this exhibition to be a cultural bridge between artists of Japan and Bangladesh. Japanese prints are technique-based and elaborate. Our printmakers are quite keen on Japanese printmaking. At the workshop, Bangladeshi artists have learnt several methods and






