THE BACKGROUND

In the later part of the 20th century, it was observed that in Bangladesh the few public universities against a population of over 140 million people were quite inadequate to provide admission to the large number of Bangladesh students seeking higher studies. Students, though being intellectually capable, were being compelled to go abroad for such studies spending valuable foreign exchange. Besides, in purpose of accelerating development of Bangladesh, there was an acute necessity of more and more hands to be graduated with high quality. Therefore, the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh accorded approval for establishment of Private Universities under the Private University Act, 1992 with a view to offering increasing facilities of education to rapidly growing number of students in education sector.

Since, specifically within 14 years, a large number of Private Universities have been established, it has become very hard to find out a good institution for standardized education. In case of higher studies, it is now more complex to choose a better one from the over crowded private universities most of which believe in exposure and publicity rather than providing students with quality based education.

At this time of predicament of our country, Primeasia Foundation came forward to establish Primeasia University to provide students with education with stress on quality, proper environment, teaching staff of excellence, moral values and discipline. The authority of the university wants to build up the students groomed up with latest knowledge, strong character and uncompromising patriotism.

Primeasia University, approved on August 26, 2003 launched its activities on October 01, 2003 as a non-profit, non-sectarian private university providing undergraduate and postgraduate education, at a reasonable cost, in a range of subjects that are particularly relevant to current and anticipated societal needs. It aims to provide students with opportunities, resources and expertise to achieve academic, personal and career goals within a stimulating and supportive environment.

Primeasia University started its journey with only 35 students at its rented building at Banani. Now the number of students is about 3800. The number of full-time faculties is about 120. There are about 25 fully equipped laboratories. From its rented house in Banani, the university has moved to three independent campuses. The spacious library now has 20,000 volumes. It is not very far when Primeasia University will turn into a well reputed, full-fledged and one of the leading universities in Bangladesh.
