



To celebrate the centenary of Rabindranath Tagore's Nobel Prize winning work "Geetanjali", Rabindra Academy arranged a discussion and musical programme at the Poet Sufia Kamal Auditorium, National Museum on April 5. Eminent personalities, including Tagore exponents, discussed on different aspects of the timeless literary work as well as Tagore's views on his contemporary social setting. Noted Tagore singers of the country later rendered songs at the cultural programme.

Poet Shahed Rahman, general secretary, Rabindra Academy gave the welcome speech.

Chief guest Finance Minister AMA Muhith could not attend the event due to unavoidable circumstances. Professor Mustafa Nurul Islam was the special guest. Prominent scientist and President of Rabindra Academy Professor Jamal Nazrul Islam presided over the session.

Among others, music exponent Professor Karunamaya Goswami; Professor Shafi Ahmed, Department of English, Jahangirnagar University; Dr. Atiur Rahman, governor, Bangladesh Bank; litterateur Azizur Rahman and Indian Tagore researchers Professor Husseinur Rahman and Professor Minakshi Singh spoke at the discussion.

In his speech, Professor Mustafa Nurul Islam said, "If we closely study the life of Rabindranath Tagore, we would find that he wanted a society free from bigotry. If we convey his message among the masses, it is possible to have an ideal society."

In his speech, Dr. Atiur Rahman emphasised on the agrarian aspects of Tagore works.

The musical programme started with the rendition of "Majhey Majhey Tabo Dekha Pai" by Shama Rahman. Anima Roy rendered "Kobey Ami Bahir Holem". Among others, Shanta Karim and Rezaul Karim rendered songs at the programme. Bhaswar Banerjee recited poems at the programme.

Theatre festival by Padatik Natya Sangsad (TSC) begins today

TSC based theatre troupe Padatik Natya Sangsad is organising a five-day theatre festival starting from today to mark the 87th birth anniversary of the troupe's founding president Syed Badruddin Hossain at National Theatre Hall of Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy (BSA).

Former Chief Justice Mohammad Habibur Rahman will inaugurate the festival. Four Bangladeshi theatre troupes, including Padatik Natya Sangsad (TSC) and one from Kolkata, will take part in the festival, the organisers said at a press conference held at Dhaka Reporters Unity on April 5.

Director general of BSA, Kamal Lohani; Shammilito Shangskritik Jote president, Nasiruddin Yousuff and Bangladesh Group Theatre Federation president Liaquat Ali Lucky will be present, among others, at the inaugural ceremony presided over by Syed Tasnin Hossain, president of Padatik

Natya Sangsad.

Padatik will stage "Mousetrap" -based on Agatha Christie's work -- on the inaugural day, while Nagarik Natya Sampradaya will stage "Kathal Bagan" -inspired by Anton Chekhov's "Cherry

Orchard" -- on the following day.

Kolkata-based troupe Theatre Workshop will stage "Joio Galpo" on April 9, while Loko Natya Dal will stage its popular production "Kanjush" on April 10. Aranyak Natyadal will stage "Ebong Bidyasagar" on the concluding day (April 11).

Minister for Information and Cultural Affairs, Abul Kalam Azad, will be chief guest, while Vice-chancellor of Dhaka University, Professor AAMS Arefin Siddique, and Professor Jatin Sarkar will be present as special guests on the concluding day of the festival.

The organisers will confer the Syed Badruddin Hossain Memorial Award on renowned theatre personalities Mamunur Rashid and Shimul Yousuf on the concluding day.

Vice-president Moslehuddin Rumu, secretary Sayem Samad of Padatik Natya Sangsad and convenor of the festival organising committee Nihad Kabir were present, among others, at the press conference.


