Five get life for killing

A trial court in Sylhet yesterday jail five members of a family for life in a murder case. The convicts are: Nizamuddin, his three sons-Zobayer (absconding), Jewel and Jamil and Sumon, son of Azimuddin of Kapon village under Osmaninagar police station in Sylhet. Prime accused-Azimuddin, brother of Nizamuddin died during the trial. According to the prosecution, at about 4 pm on November 14, 2003 the accused swooped on Miron Mia as he had raised objection to setting electric line behind his house without his permission. They hit him with lethal weapons and Miron succumbed to his wounds in hospital the following day. Victim's nephew Mujibur Rahman filed a case and police on investigations filed charge sheet against the accused on May 5 in 2003.

Youth murdered

A youth was stabbed to death by criminals in Mymensingh railway station area last night. Victim Nazrul Islam Jhantu, 22, was son of Abdul Wahab of Bagmara area in the district town. Police and family sources said, a gang led by one Kala called Jhantu out of his residence at around 11:00 pm last night. Later they took Jhantu to Mymensingh railway station Krishnachura Chattar and stabbed him indiscriminately at around 11:45 pm. Jhantu died on the spot. On information, police recovered the body and sent it to Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital (MMCH) morgue for autopsy. A case was lodged but none was arrested.

One hurt in Rab firing

A suspected mugger sustained bullet injury as Rab men fired at a gang in the city's Tilagarh area Monday night. Another suspect was caught and a dagger and a toy pistol were recovered from his possession. Two others managed to escape. Rab men also seized the private car used by the gang. Rab said, a patrol team opened fire on a private car as its driver tried to speed away defying Rab order near the MC College hostel at about 10:30 pm. Moreover the gang fired at the law enforcers. However, they arrested bullet hit Manik Sagar Dutta, while two others managed to escape.

Buddha statues recovered

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) recovered four precious statues of Buddha from Cox's Bazar district on Sunday. The statues reportedly worth Tk 50 lakh were brought to Rab-7 of Chittagong headquarters at Patenga and showed to the media in the port city yesterday. Sources said, on information that a gang of smugglers gathered at Kalurjana Rangmahal of Latpahar Reserved Forest under Chakaria upazila a team of the elite force from its temporary camp in Cox's Bazar district raided the spot on Sunday evening. Sensing presence of Rab the smugglers fled the scene leaving the four statues at different places of the area.

Arrestee Nurul Islam hailed from Ilishmari village of Sadar upazila. Acting on a tip off, a Sadar police team arrested Nurul at around 9:00 pm, said sub inspector (SI) Saiful Islam of Sadar police station. Nurul went into hiding in 2002 after he was awarded seven years imprisonment in a robbery case.

One hacked to death

A 28-year-old man was murdered with sharp weapons at Mollahat in Bagerhat Monday night. Police recovered his body yesterday morning. Nazrul Islam Tito of Kulai village was hacked in front of his house while he was returning home from Baraghat Bazaar in the upazila. His father Abdul Mannan Sheikh claimed that his son was killed to previous enmity. Nazrul had rivalry with another youth over the business of water supply for irrigation, he said. Police recovered the body yesterday morning and sent it to Bagerhat Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy. No case was lodged till filing of this report yesterday morning.

6 held with obscene video

Police arrested six people including a woman allegedly for making and showing obscene video films from Hujrapur in the town on Sunday night. The arrestees are Abdur Rob, 40, of Mohishbathan village under Mohadevpur upazila in Naogaon district and Laxman Chowdhury, 24, Gour Chowdhury, 19, Liton Lal Chowdhury, 20, Nitai Chowdhury, 24, and Nitu Rani Chowdhury, 20, of Hujrapur Pashchim Para in Chapainawabganj municipal area. Ahsanul Haque, officer-incharge (OC) of Sadar police station said, acting on secret information a police team raided one Azahar Mia's house at Hujrapur at about 10:15 pm and arrested the six with a video footage of sexual activities. Police also recovered a mobile phone with a memory card containing obscene video footage.

Students agitate as Bogra DC finally orders medical college at Cox's Bazar limps

The students of Cox's Bazar Medical College continued agitation for the third day yesterday to press home their demands.

The demands include a permanent college campus, solution to accommodation problem, appointment of teachers and setting up an examination centre for first professional MBBS examinations.

The agitating students took out a procession on the main road of the town and then submitted a memorandum to the education minister through the deputy commissioner. In the memorandum, they threatened to announce tougher agitation programme if their demands were not met immediately.

The students said though the college was established two years ago, it has no permanent campus. They alleged that land for the college has not been acquired yet due to non-cooperation of the high-ups.

They said as the college has no permanent campus, appointments of department heads in the four departments of the college and assistant professors are not possible.

Without departmental heads, there would not be any scope for setting up an examination centre at the college, the students said, adding that 42 students of the second year would not be able to sit for the first professional MBBS exams scheduled for July this

The academic activities of the college have been carried out in a building of Cox's Bazar Sadar Hospital for the last two years.

Sources concerned said the district administration has earmarked 24 acres of land for college campus in Jhilongja area of Cox's Bazar town and sent a proposal to the ministry concerned for acquiring the land. Taka 27 crore foreign aid for purchasing land has also been lying idle for long, sources added.

A meeting will be held at the office of the land ministry's secretary on April 11 to evaluate the justification of the proposal for acquiring the land.

A teacher of the College preferring anonymity said if the land for the College was not acquired by June this year, Tk 27 crore allocated for the purpose would have to be returned.

District administration sources said they have been urging the land ministry to acquire the land for last two years.

Sources said there are four departments in the College-anatomy, physiology, biochemistry and community medicine. Each department should have six teachers. But there are only 13 teachers instead of 24.

At present, the college has 95 students. Of them, 53 are in

first year and 42 in second

College Principal BM Ali Yusuf said except anatomy the three other departments do not have any assistant professor. If assistant professors

could not be appointed in the three departments by April 29, no permission for setting up examination centre will be available. Therefore, 42 students will have to go to Chittagong to participate in the exams, the principal said.

The students said they will have to sit for three papers of first professional MBBS exam-

HSC ADMIT CARD HELD BACK

All for refusing to have private tuition?

Jarin Tasrin, a student of Rangpur Collectorate School and College, could not appear in the ongoing HSC examinations as the institution authorities did not give her admit card before the examination.

At a press conference at Rangpur Press Club yesterday, Jarin said Ali-ul Karim Pramanik, lecturer of accounting at the college, influenced the principal not to issue her the admit card as she did not agree to receive private tuition from Ali-ul Karim.

"The accounting teacher threatened the students to ruin their academic career if they would not receive private tuition from him. All commerce students of the class except me received private

tuition from Ali-ul Karim. I did not go to the teacher for private tuition as my parents could not manage fee for it," Jarin said.

"When I went to college to get my admit card before the HSC examinations, the principal asked my parents to pay Tk 20,000 to Ali-ul Karim as compensation for not receiving private tuition.

"As we declined to give the money, the principal asked the college employees not to give me admit card," she said at the press conference where her parents Bazlur Rahman and Rehena Yesmin were present.

Jarin demanded action against those responsible for her not being able to appear at the HSC examinations.

Asked about the matter, Md Ishak Ali, principal of the institution, said, "Jarin was not allowed to fill up form for the final examinations as she failed in accounting in the test examinations. Her parents made contact with Dinajpur education board and she filled up her form without our knowledge. That is why I did

not give her admit card." As this correspondent asked whether it is possible to fill up the HSC form without permission of the college authorities, the principal said, "They managed it with the help of their men working at the board."

When asked if Jarin's admit card was sent to him, the principal replied in the affirmative.

He, however, denied the allegation of demanding Tk 20,000 from Jarin's parents.

arrest of 4 leaders

Deputy commissioner (DC) of Bogra has ordered arrest of four leaders of the ruling Awami League's associate bodies as they brought 'corruption' charges against the DC.

They alleged that DC Md Iftekharul Islam Khan appointed Shibir leaders and workers as secretaries of different union parishads in Bogra and gave registration to CNG-run three wheelers in exchange for money. Several hundred leaders and workers of Jubo

League, Chhatra League and Sramik League chanted slogans in front of Post, Telegraph and Telecommunication Minister Raziuddin Raju at Bogra Circuit House Saturday evening demanding removal of the DC. The DC told local journalists over cellphone

that he issued an order to arrest the leaders as they made false allegations against him.

A senior official of Bogra police said the DC asked police to arrest Jubo League Bogra district unit General Secretary Sagar Kumar Roy, Chhatra League Bogra district unit President Shubhashis Poddar Liton, Sramik League President Abdul Latif Mondol and General

Secretary Shamsuddin Sheikh Helal. But the DC did not make any written compliant against the four or made any specific allegation against them, the police official added.

Police sources said a case has already been filed with the court against eight people, including DC Iftekharul Islam, on charge of giving registration to CNG-run three wheelers through corruption.

A leader of Jubo League district unit alleged that the DC and a leader of AL district committee arranged gambling in the recently held trade fair and made huge money out of it. He also alleged that the leaders of the

ruling party's associate bodies also lodged complainants against the DC with AL central Joint General Secretary Mahbubul Alam Hanif, saying that the DC gave fertiliser licences to BNP-Jamaat men in exchange for money. But the DC did not protest it, he

A source in Borga AL said AL lawmaker from Bogra-5 constituency Habibur Rahman Habib has requested minister Raziuddin Razu to remove DC Md Iftekharul Islam for his alleged corruption.
