



# A mirror to an increasingly chaotic city

Artist Murshida Arzu Alpana lives and works in Berlin. She frequently comes to Dhaka and her last solo painting exhibition was held at Bengal Gallery of Fine Arts in 2006. Her latest solo painting and installation exhibition, titled



"Drinking Bottle Water and Breathing Dust Only," is now on at Goethe Institut, Dhaka. The exhibition opened on April 5. Urs Herren, Ambassador of Switzerland to Bangladesh and environmentalist Nazrul Islam, among others, attended the inaugural session.

Alpana is a socially aware painter and her themes mirror various social, political and

environmental issues. The artist is concerned about the state of Dhaka and the rapid changes it is going through. She feels that this fairly old city, which was once ecologically sound and enjoyed a healthy environment, is gradually losing its glory.

Alpana has used various mediums and techniques to express her views on the

Most of the works at the exhibition are oil and mixed media on canvas. Sizes of the canvases vary according to themes and compositions. Her figure-oriented works are expressive and themes are closely related to conceptual art. Her modes of expression are realistic and semirealistic. Nude and semi- nude figures, boats and water lilies are recurring motifs. The drawing-based works are engrossed with meticulous lines and forms.

"It's obvious that the current state of environment of this city is far from satisfactory. If I recall my visit to Dhaka five years back, the city has now become increasingly chaotic and unclean. I think it's high time we discuss and focus on this particular issue," said the artist.

The exhibition ends on April 22.

## Children of the city making masks for Pahela Baishakh

With Pahela Baishakh only a few days away, the TSC swimming pool premises at Dhaka University (DU) is buzzing with activity. Young artists are taking part in "Surf Excel Dekhao Protibha Mukhoshey Mukhoshey" -- a mask-making event. The programme began yesterday.

Sponsored by Surf Excel the event aims to involve school-going children of Dhaka with Baishakhi tradition of mask-making.

After primary selection, the participants will receive training on mask-making at a workshop conducted by students of Faculty of Fine Arts (FFA),

"At the workshop training will be provided in two categories -- cut-paper and paper mache masks," said Sharmin Ahmed Shormi, a fourth year student of Department of Sculpture, FFA.

The workshop will be coordinated by Emam Hossain Shumon, a masters student of Sculpture Department, FFA.

"For years, students of FFA have been making colourful masks on Pahela Baishakh, but this year we want children from different schools of Dhaka to actively participate in the celebrations. We believe that such initiatives will inspire their creativity and generate interest in our traditions and festivals," Shormi added.

### "Star Wars" headed to TV as an animated sitcom

Lucasfilm is getting organised, and this time they aren't planning on blowing up any Death Stars. Instead, they are gathering some of the best comic talent around to launch an animated Star Wars sitcom. Lucasfilm released a statement saying the show would "look at the saga's characters with a playful and irreverent tone."

They are employing plenty of comedy pros, including Brendan Hay of "The Daily Show," and "Robot Chicken" creators Seth Green and Matthew Senreich.

Jennifer Hill, who will be directing, told Variety that Green and Senreich are "shaping the type of comedy we're looking for and the look of the show."

Of course, comedy has backfired before in the "Star Wars" universe. Jar Jar Binks was universally loathed in "The Phantom Menace," causing his character to be minimised in subsequent films. But the creative types at Lucasfilm are confidant this series will handle comedy in a way people like.
