Indian minister takes responsibility for Maoist massacre

Offers resignation but PM turns down

AFP, New Delhi

Indian Home Minister P Chidambaram said yesterday he took "full responsibility" for the brutal massacre of 76 security personnel in a Maoist ambush.

Tuesday's attack, the Maoists' bloodiest strike against India's security forces, has tarnished the image of Chidambaram, who was drafted into the key ministry in 2008 to improve internal security.

"I have no hesitation in saying this: the buck stops at my desk," Chidambaram told an annual function of the Central Reserve Police Force, his post. whose members were killed in the

Chhattisgarh.

"I accept full responsibility for what happened," he said after paying tribute to the dead officers.

The prime minister's office said Chidambaram had offered to resign on Wednesday, but was turned down by 28 states. Premier Manmohan Singh.

"The home minister offered to quit. He gave his resignation in writing on Wednesday but it was immediately rejected by the prime minister," a spokesman in the office told AFP.

The opposition Hindu nationalist Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) said it agreed Chidambaram should stay in

"We do not think he should resign. ambush in the central state of This is not the time for a blame game.

We have to put an end to the Maoist menace," BJP spokesman Rajiv Pratap Rudy said.

India's Maoist insurgency began in the state of West Bengal in 1967 and has since spread to 20 of the country's

Prime Minister Singh has labelled the insurgency India's biggest internal security threat, but little is known about the movement's leadership or cadre strength, variously estimated at between 10,000 and 20,000.

Chidambaram has previously said the government needs to tackle the root causes of the insurgency and has offered talks with the rebels -- on condition they renounce violence before-

India's Reliance buys \$1.7 bln stake in US gasfield

India's energy giant Reliance Industries said yesterday it had signed a joint venture with Atlas Energy for a 1.7 billion dollar stake in a US-based natural gas field.

India's largest private firm has now gained an overseas foothold through the Marcellus Shale deal, in what it calls one of "the most exciting" upstream markets of the

As part of the deal Reliance will pay 339 million dollars in cash and a further 1.36 billion dollars to fund part of Atlas's drilling expenses and develop the project, the companies

The gas project spreads across parts of Pennsylvania, West Virginia and New York in the United States.

Reliance will acquire 40 percent -- or 120,000 acres -- of the total 300,000 acres in Atlas's core Marcellus position. Pennsylvania-based Atlas

will be the development operator of the JV, with a 60 percent stake.

UNHCR reviewing rules on Afghan and Sri Lankan refugees

The UN refugee agency revealed yesterday that it is reviewing the handling of Afghan and Sri Lankan refugees after Australia suspended asylum applications from those states.

The UN High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) declined however to make a "judgment" on Australia's move to stop accepting new asylum seekers from Sri Lanka and Afghanistan.

UNHCR spokeswoman Melissa Fleming said the agency was reviewing its guidelines on refugees from the two countries when Australia made its announcement.

Fleming pointed out that the situation in said. Sri Lanka was changing.

"We are currently examining that (Australian) announcement... particularly with regards to issues around detention of vulnerable persons and the provision of social support for the asylum seekers who are subject to this suspension," she said.

"This decision from the Australian government is taken independently from us. We are looking at the implications," she added.

Australian Immigration Minister Chris Evans said earlier that the government

would temporarily suspend processing new visa applications from asylum seekers from Sri Lanka and Afghanistan, "in the light of the changing circumstances" in those coun-

Fleming noted that the UNHCR is "in a process ourselves of looking at the situation in Sri Lanka and Afghanistan and will be issuing those guidelines."

In Sri Lanka's case, current guidelines were made based on "the situation of generalised violence there -- basically that no Tamil should be returned forcibly, and that they should be considered individually, under the 1951 (refugee) convention," she

"This situation in Sri Lanka is changing... many of the internally displaced persons have now been able to return to their homes. There is freedom of movement... in this case, we are reexamining our guidelines," the UNHCR spokeswoman added.

Fleming conceded however that events in Afghanistan were "incredibly more complex." She nonetheless declined to comment on Australia's move, stressing that the agency was "not making a judgement on that at this point."

Pakistani troops kill 24 militants

Say officials

Pakistani troops killed up to 24 militants in gunfights after insurgents attacked checkpoints in the country's lawless tribal region bordering Afghanistan, officials said Friday.

The violence was concentrated in the districts of Orakzai, where the military has been waging a nearly three-week offensive against the Taliban, and Kurram, which has a tradition of sectarian unrest and Islamist militancy. The deadliest clash took place in Bezot Khel

village in Orakzai overnight. "Troops killed 15 militants in a gunfight which started after an attack on a checkpoint," local military spokesman Major Fazlur Rehman

Rehman said the troops captured four militants wounded during the fighting and that three soldiers were also injured.

Local administration official Sajjad Ahmad confirmed the incident and casualties.

The military has announced a running death toll of more than 100 militants in the Orakzai operation since March 24, but the figures cannot be verified independently because access to the remote area is extremely limited.

Orakzai is a former bastion of Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan leader Hakimullah Mehsud, whom US officials believe probably died in a US drone attack in January. The Pakistani military says it has no evidence he is in the area.

The military said troops killed nine militants and wounded 10 others in Kurram, after the rebels stormed their checkpoint at Dogar vil-

Nato aircraft crashes in Afghanistan

A US Air Force tilt-rotor aircraft crashed in southeastern Afghanistan, killing three service members and one government

Other personnel aboard were injured and were taken to a military base for treatment, Nato said.

The CV-22 Osprey went down about 7 miles (11 kilometers) from Qalat, the capital of Zabul province, Nato said. The cause of the crash was under investigation.

The Osprey takes off and lands as a helicopter, but its engines roll forward in flight, allowing it to fly faster than a standard helicopter.

A Zabul government spokesman, Mohhamed Jahn Rasuliyar, confirmed the crash and casualty figure.
