## Pabna BCL goes on rampage

BCL Pabna district unit activists went on the rampage yesterday afternoon following a rumour that the new district committee would be formed through selection. They ransacked shops at Abdul Hamid Road in the town and damaged at least 10 vehicles. The first session of the district BCL council was held at Doel Community Center in the morning with outgoing president Mostafizur Rahman Sweet in the chair. State Minister for Home Advocate Samsul Haque Tuku spoke as the chief guest while

BCL central committee President Mahmud Hassan Ripon and General Secretary Hayder Chowdhury Ratan inaugurated the council. The election to the district unit was due to be held in the second session through election. As the central BCL leaders did not attend the second session, a rumour spread that the committee would be formed through selection. Following the rumour, the BCL men brought out a procession demanding formation of the new district committee through election. They also went on the rampage, damaging shops and vehicles. However, no committee of the BCL district unit was formed as of 8:00pm yesterday.

## 1 killed, 100 hurt injured in Habiganj clash

A man was killed and over 100 people, including five policemen, were injured in a fierce clash between two groups of villagers over a trifling matter at Olipur in Sadar upazila on Thursday morning. The deceased was identified as Yunus Miah, 60, a cattle trader of Olipur village. Witness said the clash ensued between two groups of villagers following an alterca-

tion between an autorickshaw driver and his passengers at 9:30 am. Both the groups equipped with lethal weapon attacked each other leaving over 100 people injured. Critically injured Yunus Miah died on the way to hospital and Mokhlach Miah, 20, was taken to Dhaka in critical condition. Other injured were admitted to Habiganj Modern Sadar Hospital and different private clinics.

## SHOVA MURDER IN BARISAL Charges pressed against husband

Police on Wednesday submitted charge sheet against an official accusing him of killing wife Nazma Zahir Shova. Accused Zahirul Islam, Executive Engineer of Relief and Disaster Management Ministry was working on deputation in a bridge construction project of World Bank at Sidr-affected Barguna. Sub Inspector Anwar, investigation officer of the case, said Abdul Malek, assistant manager of Hotel Ali International, was also accused in the charge sheet of helping the killer to conceal evidences. Malek allegedly ordered to stop the operation of CCTV camera of the hotel. The charge sheet was submitted under Sections 302 and 109 of the Penal Code against the two accused before the Barisal Sadar Judicial Magistrate Court, said the IO.

a regular customer of the hotel and often rented the VIP room on fourth floor for them whenever the engineer visited Barisal for his work. On February 5, 2010 they came and registered their names as usual for that room for 15 days giving the address of Dhanmondi Road-6/2A House/3A. Engineer Zahir, like other days, left the hotel at 5:00 am on February 15 for supervising bridge construction project funded by World Bank in Barguna district but this time allegedly slaughtering his wife Nazma in the hotel room. Hotel authorities opened the room with duplicate key at about 10:30am on February 15 as Nazma did not come out for taking breakfast despite several knockings on the door. She also did not respond to the cell phone calls. They called police after they found the slaughtered body of Nazma lying on her bed covered with bed sheet in the room. Nazira Zahir Linda, only daughter of the couple, is a Bar-at-Law student in an Australian university. The investigation officer of the case said the charge sheet was made on the basis of the confessional statement of engineer Zahir before the magistrate regarding the murder of his wife.

# 23 sued on war crime charges in 2 districts

Three separate cases have been filed against 23 people in Kishoreganj and Bagerhat on charge of war crimes in 1971. A case was filed with Kishoreganj court yesterday against a former army captain on charge of killing during liberation war, reports a correspondent. Accused Md Nasir, 60, is son of late Abdur Razzak Munshi of Moddopara village in Karimganj upazila. Md Golap Mia, son of Shaid Mia Hossain of Aila village in the upazila filed the case with Judicial Magistrate Court-6 accusing Nasir of killing his father Mia Hossain during liberation war. According to the prosecution, 'Razaker commander' Nasir along with 4/5 cohorts picked up Mia Hossain from his house and shot him dead beside a nearby pond on November 5, 1971. Nasir and his cohorts also torched many houses and tortured women with

the help of occupation Pakistani army, the complaint alleged. Magistrate HM Shafiqul Islam accepted the case and ordered Armandul Huq, officer-in-charge (OC) of Karimganj to take necessary legal steps. In Bagerhat, two separate cases were filed on Wednesday against 22 people on charges of killing five people at Mongla during the liberation war, reports a correspondent. Abdur Aziz Sheikh of Dakkhin Chila village and Mridha Mahtabuddin of Bajikarer Khand village under Mongla upazila filed the cases with the court of Senior Judicial Magistrate Md Yabor Hossain's court. The accused in the cases are two brothers Mridha Nazrul Islam, 65, and Nizamuddin Mridha, 69, of Bajikarer Khand village, Amjad Fakir, 60, Md Shafi Mridha, 58, of the same village, Moslem Fakir, 75, Rajjab Ali Sarder, 77, of Madurpata village and Rahim

Sheikh, 62, of Dhalir Khand village. The seven have been accused in both the cases. Besides, 15 others have been accused in one or the other of the two cases. Plaintiff of a case Abdul Aziz Mridha said on April 12, 1971 the 'rajakers' led by two brothers Nazrul Mridha and Nazim Mridha picked up five people including Aziz Mridha. He said they later shot four dead while he himself received bullet injury on the back. Plaintiff of another case Mridha Mahtab Uddin in his case said, the rajakers led by the two brothers caught him and Suraj Mallick of Madurpata village on April 12, 1971 while they were working in the field of Profulla Bairagi at Bajikar Khand village. The accused shot Suraj Mallick dead and injured Mahtab seriously by shooting.

## Sec 144 outside Dinajpur medical

The district administration yesterday morning imposed Section 144 outside Dinajpur Medical College and Hospital (DJMCH) as Chhatra League (BCL) and Chhatra Dal (JCD) of the district organised separate programmes at the same venue the same day. Acting Deputy Commissioner of Dinajpur Md Shamsul Alam imposed the ban with effect from 10:00am yesterday to continue till 10:00pm today prohibiting any programme outside the DJMCH complex to avoid any untoward incident.

## SQ Chy's street rally foiled

Ruling AL activists and supporters yesterday foiled a street rally scheduled to be addressed by BNP Standing Committee member Salahuddin Quader (SQ) Chowdhury in Chandanaish upazila. Podium of the rally and at least eight arches set up to greet SQ Chowdhury were also vandalised by unknown people in the early hours of the day. SQ Chowdhury was scheduled to address the street rally organised by Chandanaish upazila BNP on his way to Bandarban where he was to attend a Jubo Dal rally in the afternoon. Chandanaish Pourashabha (municipality) units of Awami League, Jubo League and Chhatra League as well as local unit of Muktiyoddha Sangsad also organised a rally at the same venue near Gachbaria College at 3:00pm to demand trial of war criminals. As SQ Chowdhury reached near the street

rally venue at around 2:45pm some AL men and freedom fighters attacked his motorcade. They pelted shoes and stones damaging one of the vehicles in the motorcade witnesses. SQ Chowdhury then went to Bandarban rally without stopping at the street rally venue. However, the local leaders denied their involvement in ransacking the podium and arches. They rather blamed the two rival factions of Chandanaish BNP for the incident. Local BNP leaders and activists alleged that AL men ransacked the podium and arches in presence of police. Prior to the rally police also arrested Chandanaish upazila BNP general secretary MA Hashem Raju at around 2:45am, they said. However, officer-in-charge (OC) Noor Mohammad of Chandanaish police station said Raju was arrested in a fraud case filed with Paltan police station in the capital. Police were not informed of the street rally, said the OC expressing his ignorance of ransacking any podium or arches.

### Extortionist arrested

Chudanga police on Saturday noon arrested an Awami League (AL) cadre Fozlu who mercilessly beat up a school teacher for protesting Fozlu's extortion on March 3. A court sent Fozlu to jail. According to police, Fozlu, a top cadre of ruling AL in Alamdanga upazila in Chudanga demanded Tk 2 lakh from contractor Bablu Mia who was constructing a building of Khasbagunda Government Primary School. Fozlu also threatened the contractor to stop the work if his demand is not met. Bablu informed the matter to school authorities. Headmaster of the school Serajul Islam asked the contractor not to pay toll to Fozlu. The headmaster informed the matter to high level AL leaders in the upazila. This angered Fozlu. On March 3, Fozlu went to the school and beat up the headmaster while he was taking class at about 3:00 pm. Bringing on the school field, Fozlu mercilessly beat up the teacher. Fozlu also threatened others with pistol who went to save the teacher.

### 6415 bullets recovered

Police recovered 6,415 bullets in 11 cartons kept hidden in a water body at Shilmuri village in Barura upazila yesterday. Tipped-off by locals, police rushed to the spot early in the morning and recovered the cartons of the bullets from the water body. Earlier, on Saturday the law enforcers recovered 415 bullets packed in a sack from under a culvert of the same area. None was arrested in this connection.

### 'Mugger' beaten to death

UNB, Keraniganj

A suspected mugger was beaten to death by mob at Kaibattapara under Dakkhin Keraniganj police station Saturday night. The deceased was identified as Shukur, 25. Witnesses said when a gang of muggers were snatching in the area at gunpoint locals caught two of them and gave them a good thrashing leaving Shukur dead on the spot and his accomplice Momin, 17, seriously injured. Police rescued Momin and sent him to Mitford Hospital. Shukur's body was sent to morgue for autopsy. Two other snatchers managed to escape. Locals said the gang was involved in snatching in the area since long.

### Human chain in B'baria

A human chain was formed and a rally held in the district town on Friday protesting rising incidents of teasing girls. Two social organisations, Peace Vision and Brotherhood, jointly organised the programme at the premises of local Pura Adhunik super market. The programme was presided over by Ali Akbar Majumdar. Guardians in the protest meeting expressed concern over rising incidents of teasing in the town and demanded arrest of the culprits without further delay.
