


Rabindranath Tagore is India's first modern painter. In his songs, drama, fiction and other creative work, he has always upheld the heritage of the subcontinent. Yet in painting he did not follow traditions. What he painted was entirely his own style and vision," says Qayyum Chowdhury. "He based his paintings on lines, following the oriental style. In this way alone he has kept up with traditions. His work depended on treatment of form and space." Tagore took to painting in the latter stage of his life, when he was done with expressing himself in profusion in so many other creative forms, says Qayyum.

"Drawing and painting were novelties for Tagore at the last stage of his life. Of course, in the meantime, he

supported his nephew Abanindranath's paintings of the Bengal School," says Qayyum, and he specially encouraged the paintings on

realised that paintings could not be established on literary values. Painting itself has a different language. He sent Japanese artist Oka Kura to India to guide the artists there. Channel i celebrated the 149th birth anniversary of Rabindranath Tagore through a daylong "Robi-Channel i Rabindramela", at the channel's Tejgaon office yesterday. Sponsored by mobile phone operator Robi, this was the fifth mela on Tagore's birth anniversary by Channel i.

Faridur Reza Sagar managing director Impress Telefilm Ltd and Channel i, inaugurated the mela at 11:30 am. Among others, Shykh Seraj, head of news channel i; filmmaker Chashi Nazrul Islam, Ataur Rahman, Asad Chowdhury were present at the inauguration session.

Throughout the day leading writers, Tagore exponents, poets, Tagore artistes and enthusiasts came to the channel i office to attend the mela. Leading and upcoming artistes performed Tagore songs and recitations, while several cultural organisations staged group performances at the Rabindra mancha stage at the mela premises.

A total of 20 well decorated stalls were set up at the mela featuring books on Tagore, his works, information on the great poet, reproductions of Tagore's artworks and more.

The mela also included an art camp where leading artists of the country -- Hashem Khan, Sheikh Afzal, Biren Shome, Monirul Islam, Farida Zaman, Moniruzzaman and others drew paintings based on the theme of Tagore's poetry. The paintings from the camp will be auctioned; the money gained from the sale will be spent on Tagore research, informed the organisers.

A painting contest for youngsters on the theme "Tagore" was also held at the mela. The contest aimed at generating interest on Tagore among the youngsters.

One of the main attractions of the mela was the handing over of lifetime achievement award in recognition to promoting Tagore and his works. This year the award was presented to accomplished Tagore singer Rezwana Chowdhury Bonna. As part of the award Bonna was presented a crest by National professor Kabir Chowdhury, an uttorio by Faridur Reza Sagar and a cash prize of Taka 2 lakh by Shykh Seraj. Previously Channel i presented lifetime achievement awards to veteran Tagore artiste and exponent Kalim Sharafi and veteran Tagore singer Ajit Roy. The mela was aired live at Channeliwhich continued till 5 pm.
