

## Strike at Burimari ends

### Ctg port returns to normalcy

Import and export through Burimari land port under Patgram upazila came to a halt yesterday morning as the day labourers observed work stoppage demanding increased wage.

About one thousand labourers working at the land port did not join their work.

However, they withdrew their programme in the afternoon after a meeting with the Clearing and Forwarding Agents and land port officials. They will join their work today as they were assured of increased wage soon.

The day labourers said they are deprived of minimum wage from the clearing and forwarding agents. The C & F agents give Tk 70 for unloading one tonne goods from the truck, whereas the government fixed Tk 120 for it, said labourer Momin Mollah.

Labourer Kashem Ali said, "We did not dare to protest this in fear of C & F agents. Now we are united and we shall establish our right by any means."

President of Clearing and Forwarding Agents Association Sayeduzzaman said, "The day labourers observed work stoppage

illegally. They are always paid reasonable wage."

#### Ctg port

Our Staff Correspondent in Chittagong reports: Cargo handling started at both Chittagong port jetties and outer anchorage since early hours yesterday as Bangladesh Nourjan Sramik Federation withdrew their

nite inland water transport strike after seven days.

With the resumption of work by transport workers full-swing cargo handling started at 17 vessels of twelve cargo jetties of the port since last midnight, said Chittagong Port Authority (CPA) secretary Syed Farhad Uddin Ahmed.

Cargo handling took place at the outer anchorage and all

the 60 lighter vessels started movement as per schedule.

Forty-five vessels went to take delivery from the feeder vessels at outer anchorage while 15 loaded vessels left for their respective destinations, said Water Transport Coordination Cell (WTCC) Executive Director Commodore (ret'd) Abu Zaher Nizam yesterday afternoon.

## 30 shops, 7 houses gutted

A devastating fire broke out at Pharmacy Patti in Mathbaria upazila town gutted at least 30 shops early Saturday.

Locals said, the fire broke out at a shop at about 12:30 am and soon engulfed the adjoining 29 shops.

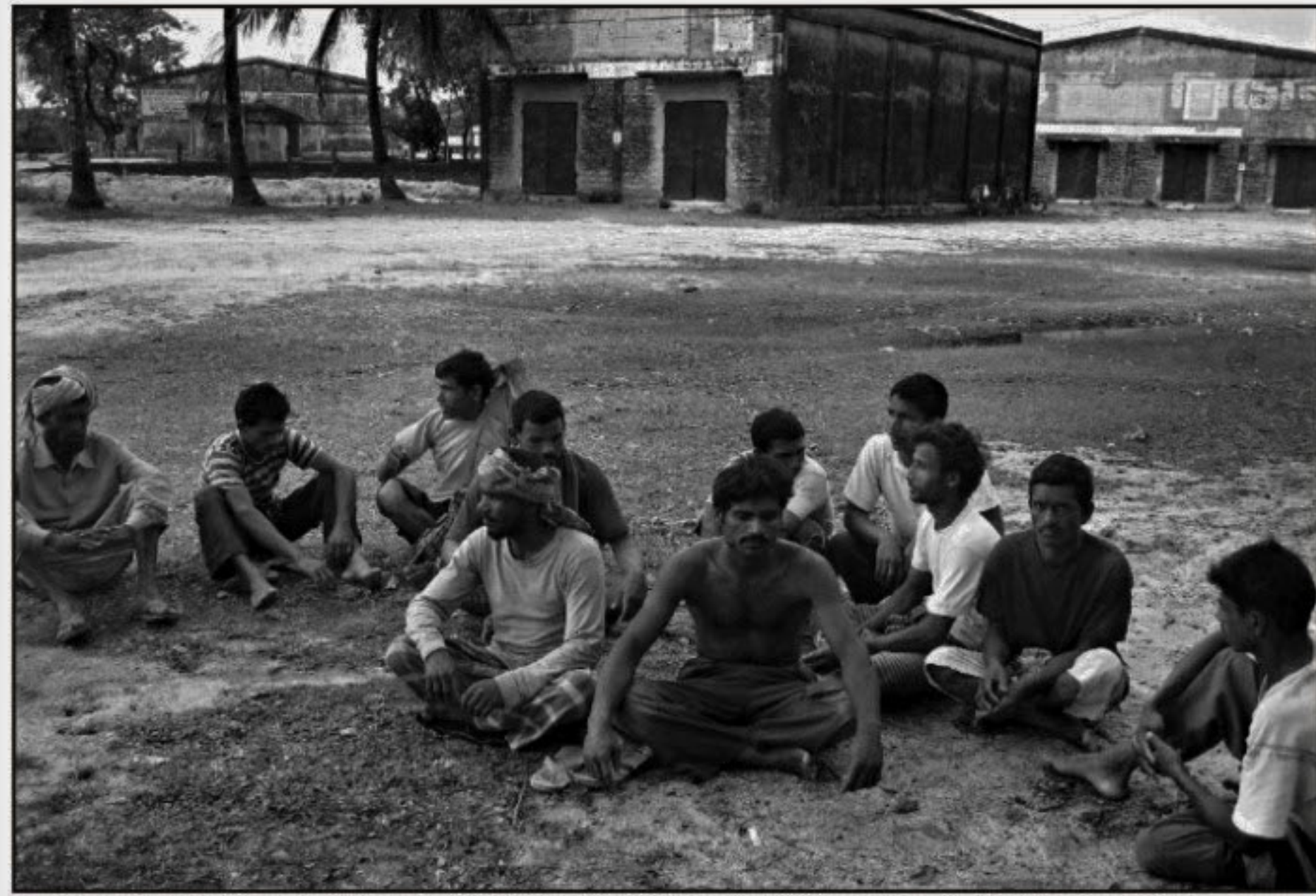
On information, Mathbaria fire fighting unit rushed to the spot and extinguished the flame after three hours of hectic efforts with help of local people.

The reason behind the fire could not be known immediately.

The affected shop owners claimed that cash and valuables worth over Tk 2 crore were gutted in the blaze.

In Chapainawabganj, seven houses were gutted at Noyadiari village in Gomostapur upazila on Friday night.

Locals said the fire originated from a burning electric wire that fell on the rooftop of the house of Nazrul of the village at about 8:00pm from a nearby electric pole and soon engulfed the adjacent six houses.

## Two cyclone shelters built in Sidr-hit Sharankhola

Two newly built cyclone shelters in the Sidr affected Sharankhola upazila were formally handed over yesterday.

Built with USAID help, the cyclone shelters will be used as schools during no-cyclone period.

Lawmaker Dr Mozammel Hossain, president of Bagerhat District Awami League, received the cyclone shelters on behalf of the locals.

Presided over by Bagerhat Deputy Commissioner Md Moazzem Hossain, the handover ceremony was held at Dhansagor Radhaluxmi Junior Girls' High School-cum-cyclone shelter in Bagerhat district.

US Ambassador James F Moriarty was present as guest of honour. He handed over cyclone shelter documents

to chief guest Mozammel Hossain.

Each of the two newly constructed cyclone shelters provide protection for at least 1500 people during cyclonic storms.

There are four restrooms in the shelter, two for men and two for women.

Cyclonic storm Sidr hit Bangladesh on November 15 in 2007.

The USAID funded SHOUHARDO (Strengthening Household Ability to Respond to Development Opportunities) programme identified two locations where the locals had little ability to take refuge in safe shelters during cyclone or tidal surge.

With USAID support and in partnership with the Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) the new cyclone shelters were later constructed at Dhansagor village of Sharankhola upazila.

### Housewife commits 'suicide'

A housewife allegedly committed suicide by hanging herself at her room at Sarnakhola village in Naria upazila Friday night. The deceased was identified as Sweetie, 18, daughter of Jabbar Sarder of the village. Family sources said Sweetie's mother-in-law Rezia Begum rebuked her harshly for returning home late after attending a marriage ceremony. Angered by the insulting remarks she committed suicide at midnight. On information, police recovered the body and sent it to Sadar hospital morgue for autopsy. A UD case filed.

### PSTU bans rally, procession

Patuakhali Science and Technology University (PSTU) authorities yesterday imposed ban on all kinds of gathering, rally and procession on the campus to avert any untoward situation over expulsion of 21 BCL activists from the university. Deputy registrar Nasir Saleh, on behalf of the vice-chancellor of the university, announced the ban effective from 10:00am. Disciplinary committee of the university earlier temporarily expelled 21 Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) men and fined seven others on charge of creating anarchy on the campus. Of them, one was expelled allegedly for misbehaving with a female teacher on Friday while 20 others for violating discipline on the campus on May 13.

### Extortionists held

People caught two extortionists red-handed when they came to realise illegal toll from contractors in Mirpur in the district on Saturday evening. The extortionists were later handed over to police. According to police, a local gang demanded Tk 5 lakh illegal toll from three contractors constructing a building of Paharpur High School. The contractors informed the matter to local seniors. On the day when two extortionists Chhanu of Talbaria and Walmet of Khoirpur in Mirpur upazila came to the school to receive the money at about 7:00 pm locals caught them red-handed. After a good beating, they handed them over to Mirpur police.

### Arms peddlers held

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) yesterday arrested two arms peddlers and recovered one shooter gun and six bullets from them at Telkupi frontier village of Shibganj upazila. The arrestees are Iftekharul Islam Babu, 28, son of Imran Hossain and Mohamad Dhulu, 25, son of Abu Bakkar of Telkupi village under Shibganj upazila in this district. Rab sources said, on a secret information, a Rab team raided Babu's house at Telkupi village at around 5:00 am and arrested them with the arms. Later, Rab handed them to Shibganj police station and filed a case against Babu and Dhulu under Arms Act.

### Cocktails seized

Police seized 6 cocktails at village Lashkarpur in Sadar upazila on Saturday evening. Acting on a tip-off, a police team recovered the cocktails from a bush adjacent to a clinic at about 6:30 pm. ### Body recovered

BSS, Chittagong

Police yesterday recovered the decomposed body of a truck helper from a roadside ditch at Pukuria under Banshkali upazila. The victim was identified as Shahabuddin, 22, son of Abdul Kader, hailed from Mainimuk area of Langadhu upazila under Rangamati district. On a tip-off, police rushed to Pukuria in the morning and recovered the body, bearing several marks of injury. The victim came to Banshkali from Rangamati Saturday night with the truck driver. Later, police detained truck driver Hasmat Ullah, 48, for interrogation. A case was filed with Banshkali police station in this connection.
