Businessman killed, night coaches looted by robbers

Robbers shot dead a businessman in Bandarban and looted two night coaches in Sathkira.

Robbers murdered a businessman and took away Tk 7 lakh at Ringbhong on Lama-Chakoria border in Alikadam upazila of Bandarban yesterday.

Liaquat Ali, owner of Liaquat Tobacco Limited, accompanied by his son Ahsan was going to Chakoria from his factory at Ali Kadam. A group of 5 to 6 armed robbers intercepted his jeep at about 2:00 pm.

The gang shot him twice, snatched away the money and fled to the nearby forest.

Fatally wounded Liaquat was rushed to Central Hospital where doctors declared him dead.

Police suspected that the robbers had prior information about Liaquat's traveling with the money through the road which usually remains lonely between Kumari and Ringvong.

Our Correspondent in Sathkira reports: Robberies were committed in two Sathkira-bound night

coaches coming from Dhaka near Jhhowdanga college in Sadar upazila on Sathkira-Dhaka highway at about 3:00 am yesterday.

The robbers decamped with cash and valuables worth Tk 3 lakh, police said.

Police later arrested five people for their alleged involvement in the robberies.

The arrestees are Abdul Bari, 36, son of Asgar Ali Mollah of village Mohonpur; Shahin, 25, son of Sunnat Ali of village Waria; Aatur Rahman, 3, son of Monsur Ali of village Gobindakati; Sheikh Rasheduzzaman, 32 son of Abul Hossain of village Tujalpur and Mithun Kumar Ghosh, 35, son of Madhusudan Ghosh of village Jhhowdanga in Sadar upazila.

Quoting locals police said an armed gang stopped the two Sathkira-bound night coaches of MRR Paribahan and Sathkira Express by putting barricade on the road in front of Jhhowdanga College.

The robbers then looted cash and other valuables from the passengers of the two coaches and managed to escape the scene.

Health complex ransacked as child dies without treatment

Agitated relatives and locals went on rampage at Sadullapur upazila health complex after a child patient died in the emergency ward without treatment for absence of any physician Sunday afternoon.

The mob ransacked Resident Medical Officer's office and damaged doors and windowpanes of the complex.

Police said, one and a half years old Apsia Akhter fell in a pond at her village at Hamindpur under Sadullapur upazila.

Locals rescued her in an unconscious state and rushed to the health complex for treatment.

But after a wait for about two hours no physician was available in the complex and Apsia died without any treatment.

The incident sparked violent protest by locals who went on rampage at the health complex.

An employee of the health complex seeking anonymity told this correspondent that virtually the health complex has no physician for the last four days. Out of two physicians, Dr Shakawat Hossain is on leave while Dr Abdus Salam was not present at the upazila headquarters.

In another incident yesterday noon, one Ariful of Madhapara rushed to health complex with major finger injuries but no physician was available. At this locals again tried to ransack the complex but police foiled the attempt, said Hasan Inam, Sadullapur OC.

Locals alleged that the health complex remains

without physician most of the time depriving the people of minimum treatment.

Earlier, people of the area urged the health directorate and concerned ministry for ensuring physicians. They also held procession and formed human chain but to no effect.

The health directorate several times sent physicians

including consultant but soon after joining they went on leave or got transferred to other places, said Khademul Islam Khudi, upazila chairman, Sadullapur.

"Being frustrated, a few days ago I put the complex under lock and key as a note of protest but all in vain," he said.

Docs, staff at Pabna Mental Hospital protest attack by outsiders

Doctors, nurses and other staff of Pabna Mental Hospital formed a human chain in the town yesterday demanding arrest of the outsiders who assaulted social psychiatric officer of the hospital on May 9.

They also submitted a memorandum to the deputy commissioner and the police superintendent demanding immediate arrest of and exemplary punishment to the culprits. Otherwise, they threatened to launch a tougher agitation programme.

Hospital sources said Social Psychiatric Officer Md Mojahar Ali came under attack by the outsiders allegedly led by Faruk and Harun when he was going to his hospital campus residence at about 7:30pm. They attacked Mojahar over entering the hospital campus, sources added.

Mojahar was taken to Pabna General Hospital but doctors referred him to Dhaka Medical College Hospital as his condition deteriorated the same night.

Demanding arrest of the persons responsible for assaulting Mojahar, doctors, nurses and other staff of hospital have been observing strike for two hours from 11:00am to 1:00pm since

May 10. They also stopped admitting patients to the hospital.

Their agitation causes immense sufferings to patients, especially those coming from distant places.

Contacted, Director of Pabna Mental Hospital Dr Md Enayet Karim said he asked the doctors and officials concerned to ensure patients' admission to the hospital.

Mojahar's wife filed a case with Pabna Sadar Police Station on May 11 accusing two, Faruk and Harun, but the accused are yet to be arrested.

Addressing a rally at the venue of human chain at Abdul Hamid Road, Dr Nikhil Kumar said outsiders often misbehave, even assault doctors and staffs of the hospital on various pretexts.

The criminals attacked Mojahar as he took steps to prevent entrance of the brokers and frauds to the hospital, he alleged.

Officer-in-Charge of Sadar Police Station Md Motiur Rahman told this correspondent that the accused had gone into hiding soon after incident.

He further said the law enforcers are raiding different areas to nab the culprits.
