BCL men beat up another Shibir cadre at RU

Police remain silent spectator

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) activists yesterday severely beat up another Shibir cadre at Rajshahi University (RU) in presence of the law enforcers.

Sources said a group of BCL activists caught Shibir man Sayeduzzaman, a third year student of Arabic department at the university Kazla gate and beat him with sticks and iron rods at around 10:30am.

The BCL men took Sayed

to police tent at the university Tukitaki Chatter from Kazla gate and asked him about his alleged involvement with February 9 campus violence.

During the interrogation, the BCL men severely beat him again in front of the law enforcers at around 11:00am. Later they handed him over to the law enforcers at Motihar police station, sources said.

Officer-in-charge (OC) of Motihar police station Abul Khair told this correspondent

that the arrestee might have been involved with February 9 campus violence that killed BCL worker Faruk Hossain.

"Necessary steps would be taken after primary interrogation", he added.

Also on Monday, police arrested a Shibir activist at RU in connection with February 9 violence on the campus.

Arrestee Asaduzzaman is a second year student of Arabic department of the university. At around 11:00am, Chhatra League (BCL) activists led by Nayan and Ferdous of Sayed

Amir Ali Hall unit caught Asad in front of the university gymnasium. They took Asad to room 308 of the hall and severely beat him with sticks, hall sources said.

On information, a team from Motihar police station rushed to the hall and arrested the Shibir man.

According to the police sources, over 200 Shibir leaders and activists have been arrested till date in 14 cases filed in connection with February 9 violence.

Sylhet trade fair uncertain as row over venue drags on

Much talked 'Sylhet International Trade Fair-2010' faces uncertainty as Sylhet Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SCCI) has failed to arrange venue for the event earlier scheduled for March, mainly due to opposition from a section of business people and locals.

The SCCI authorities are, however, still hopeful about organising the fair soon although they had to cancel their decision for proposed venues twice during the last two months.

In line with the schedule given by the commerce ministry for holding the fair in March, the SCCI engaged JF International, an event manager, for the purpose.

At first the SCCI authority reached an understanding with the authorities of Government MC College for holding the fair at the college playground but an education ministry order barred using

the playground of an educational institution for such event, SCCI sources said.

Then they opted for a field at Shahjalal Uposhahar but the idea had to be abandoned as some community leaders of the area urged not to hold the fair there.

Then Sylhet Alia Madrasah ground was selected for the event, but a large section of the city's business community, especially traders of different markets and shopping malls under the banner of Sylhet Zila Babosayee Oikya Kalyan Parishad seriously opposed the move.

Students and teachers of the madrasah also prepared to 'resist' holding of the fair in their field.

Consequently, SCCI administrator Faruque Mahmud Chowdhury issued a statement suspending their move to hold the fair at the madrasah ground.

"We have asked the event manager to look for an alternative venue. We will again write to them to do things in a week," the SCCI administrator told this

correspondent on Tuesday.

"To ensure transparency, for the first time we had leased out the event through open tender, which was published in national newspapers. It was leased out for Tk 81,50,500. We have already taken Tk 10 lakh as security money. We are confident enough to hold the event," he added.

In the face of protest by the city's business community who apprehended deterioration in law and order and business loss, the authorities had to shift the fair venue from Alia Madrasah ground in earlier years also.

The government appointed an administrator in the SCCI after the former elected executive committee of the business body was dissolved following a case against its president Zunnun Mahmud Khan and others on charge of misappropriating over a crore taka from the trade fair deal last year.

Students sued for stalking teacher

Four students of Lalmonirhat Government College were sued on Tuesday night on charge of stalking a teacher of the college on May 22.

Principal Mohammad Abdul Bari filed the case with Sadar Police Station against the students after they were found guilty of stalking the teacher in a probe report

submitted to him in the morning.

The accused are Nahid Morshed, Sakib Raihan, Shafiqul Islam and Zahid Hasan. They all are appearing in the ongoing HSC examinations from the college.

Principal Bari said the college authorities will take departmental actions against the four after completing their practical examinations.

The students stalked Hosne Lotifa, lecturer of

political science department, on the college campus on May 22. They assaulted Zakir Hossain, assistant professor of physics department of the college, as he protested the incident.

The unruly students also confined Prof Zakir Hossain to a room. On information, police went to the campus and set him free.

Immediately after the incidents, the college authorities formed a four-member

investigation committee headed by S M Shah Alam, assistant prof of Islamic history department.

Teachers of the college also observed work abstention for two days (Sunday and Monday) protesting stalking and demanding safety of the teachers.

Contacted, the officer-in-charge (OC) of Lalmonirhat Sadar Police said the law enforcers are looking for the stalkers.

Schoolboy drowns in Moulvibazar

A school boy drowned in a pond near Bhabaniganj bazaar in Juri upazila of Moulvibazar district on Monday.

The deceased was identified as Shoumitra Dev John, 12, a student of Sylhet Cantonment School and son of Shankar Prasad Dev of Majortila area of the city.

Sources said Shoumitra came to visit his maternal uncle's house in Juri upazila on Sunday. But while walking along the bank of the pond on Monday afternoon he suddenly slipped into it and met watery grave.

He did not know how to swim.

Later, his body was recovered from the pond after a hectic search.

Youth held on rape, murder charge

Police arrested a youth on charge of rape and murder of a girl from his residence at Uttar Musrat Modati village under Kaliganj police station yesterday.

Arrestee Omor Faruque, 24, is son of Motiar Rahman of the village.

Kaliganj police are now looking for four others including the main accused in the case.

Police and locals said, a girl was gang raped and murdered allegedly by one Liakot Ali and four others at Voltmari Hazraniya village of Kaliganj upazila Monday night.

Police recovered the body of the victim from a maize field near Voltmari Bazar at dawn on Tuesday.

The victim was daughter of Shafiq Rahman of the village and a worker of a bidi factory at Voltmari Bazar.

Two housewives killed allegedly for dowry

A housewife was beaten to death allegedly by her husband for dowry at Nanahar village in Kalai upazila on Monday night.

The victim was identified as Marzina Akhter Eti, 16, daughter of Abul Hossain, of Kusum Shahor village in Khetlal upazila.

Family sources said Marzina was married off with Rabiul Islam about eight months ago.

They said as Marzina refused to bring Tk 50,000 dowry from her father, Rabiul became furious and beat her mercilessly, leaving her seriously injured.

She was first rushed to Khetlal upazila health complex and later shifted to Joypurhat Modern Hospital where the attended doctors declared her dead.

Robiul and his parents went into hiding after the

incident.

Another report from Manikganj adds: A housewife was killed allegedly by her husband for dowry at Uvazani village in Ghior upazila on Tuesday noon.

The deceased was identified as Sabina Akhter, 22, daughter of Shamsur Rahman of Dhulandi village in Shibbalaya upazila.


Family sources said Sabina was married off with Kamal Hossain, a vegetable vendor of the village, one year ago.

Kamal, since his marriage, used to torture Sabina for dowry.

On Tuesday morning he picked up a quarrel with her over the issue and beat her mercilessly.

Later, he informed Sabina's parents that she was ill. But Sabina died on the way to Sadar hospital.

A case was filed in this connection.




