Tk 1 cr for safe drinking water in Aila-hit areas

Tk 47 lakh for Khulna, Tk 53 lakh for Satkhira

Government has allocated Tk one crore for implementation of Safe Water Supply Programme (SWSP) in the Aila affected areas of Khulna and Satkhira districts. The programme will continue for 75 days from the day of receiving the fund, said a source at Khulna office of public health engineering department (PHED). Of the total allocation, Khulna would get Tk 47 lakh while Satkhira Tk 53 lakh, the source said adding, deputy

commissioners of the two districts will receive the fund through the chief engineer of PHED. The fund will be spent by the upazila disaster management committee in the affected areas, the source pointed out. The PHED assisted by Unicef has been distributing safe drinking water at 21 points of Dakope upazila, six points of Koira upazila in Khulna district and 13 points of Shyamnagar upazila of Satkhira district since last February. Under the SWS programme 1,25,000 litres of

safe drinking water will be distributed every day. Of this, 30,000 litres will be distributed in Dakope upazila, 25,000 litres in Koira upazila of Khulna district while 58,000 litres in Shyamnagar upazila and 12,000 litres in Assasuni upazila of Satkhira district. Cyclonic storm Aila on May 25 last year destroyed almost all sources of safe drinking water in the affected upazilas of Khulna and Satkhira districts. According to sources at Khulna PHED, Aila destroyed 1161 pond sand filters, 5231

tubewells and 1846 ponds of sweet water in the affected areas. Meanwhile, Khulna PHED office so far reinstalled 4076 tubewells, 46 rain water harvestors and 806 pond sand filters. Superintendent Engineer at Khulna office of PHE department Md Kamal Uddin Ahmed told this correspondent that the allocated fund is not adequate for ensuring safe drinking water for thousands of homeless people in the Aila affected upazilas of Khulna and Satkhira districts.

WAR CRIMES 13 sued on charge of killing FF in Khulna

Thirteen people have been sued for killing a freedom fighter (FF) during the liberation war in 1971. A petition case was filed on Wednesday by one Aleya Begum accusing the 13 in the court of Senior Judicial Magistrate of Bagerhat Md Rakibul Islam.

The court ordered officer-in-charge (OC) of Morrelganj police station to record a regular case after proper investigation into the allegation of the complainant. The complainant stated in her petition her freedom fighter father Yusuf Sheikh of Telighati village under Morrelganj upazila in Bagerhat was shot dead on the night of November 20 in 1971 at Gazalia bazar. The accused killed several other freedom fighters at the same time on the same day and later set their houses on fire, the complainant said in her petition case. The accused are Ukiluddin Sheikh, Nura Shikder, Mokser Didar, Asman Didar, Rustam Molla, Idris Molla, Ensaf Didar, Syed Ali, Kalam Molla, Imam Sheikh, Moktar Howlader, Zafar Ali and Karim Didar.

FF hacked to death

A freedom fighter (FF) was hacked to death on Wednesday night near Lal Hospital at Khalishpur of Khulna city. The victim was identified as Altaf Hossain, 60, son of Anwar Hossain Molla of Khalishpur Housing Estate. Altaf was a retired jawan of Bangladesh Army. According to police, a gang of criminals attacked Altaf with a knife while he was on the way to his residence at 10:30 pm from Khalishpur Muktiyoddha Command office. He succumbed to his injuries at 1:45 am yesterday while under treatment at Khulna Medical College and Hospital, said Abu Mokaddem, officer-in-charge (OC) of Khalishpur police station. The OC quoted wife of the deceased Jahanara Begum as saying that the murder was a sequel to a long-standing dispute over land property with one of the attackers. Jahanara lodged an FIR with Khalishpur police station at 3:00 pm yesterday accusing three people and unidentified others of murdering her husband.

Two militants of Allar Dal held in Gaibandha

Sadullapur police in a drive early yesterday arrested two suspected militants of banned Islamist outfit Allar Dal from village Kismat Bagchi under Sadullapur upazila. Police said, on Wednesday night some unknown faces joined a religious gathering at the house of one Mukul Mandol. People came to know that a motivational session of Allar Dal is being held to expand its activities in the area. Being suspicious, the villagers encircled the house. Former BDR personnel Moslem Ali said as he raised protest against the militant activities, the organiser group of Allar Dal beat him up, injuring him seriously.

Being informed, a team from Sadullapur police station rushed to the spot. Sensing police presence, the unknown faces who came to attend the meeting for training fled away through the back door. Police raided the house and arrested Mukul Mandol, 43, and Hazat Ali, 26, from the spot. Police suspect that the arrestees are close associates of Allar Dal kingpin Matin Mehdi who was sentenced to death by a court for his involvement in militant activities. The arrestees will be taken on police remand for further interrogation, said Abu Md Delwar Hasan Inam, officer-in-charge (OC) of Sadullapur police station. The injured BDR personnel was sent to Sadullapur health complex for treatment.

94 plots lying unused in Mongla EPZ for 9 years

Despite having much potential Mongla Export Processing Zone (EPZ) could not be developed properly in the last nine years. Entrepreneurs are not showing much interest in investing in the EPZ area. Ninety-four plots have been lying unused as only eight local and foreign companies are now operating in the zone. Bagerhat Chamber of Commerce and Industries sources said the EPZ was not developed properly due to non-cooperation of the authorities concerned. Thousands of unemployed people of the southern region would get employment opportunity if sufficient number of industries were established here, they added. The EPZ was established on 193 acres of land in March 2001 in Mongla port area. The price of plots is almost half comparing to plots in other EPZs and there are roads and waterways needed for

transportation of goods. EPZ sources said 30 plots out of 142 have been allotted so far and 11 factories have been built up on the land. Eight factories are operating now while three others have been shut down.

Manager of Agro Growers Processors Abdur Razzak said if water, gas supply, banking system and communication system could be developed here it would have attracted more investors.
