Ensure constitutional, land rights of indigenous people

Human chain in Thakurgaon demands

Jatiya Adivasi Parishad, a platform for the indigenous people, yesterday formed a human chain on the premises of deputy commissioner's office here to press home their nine-point demand.

The demands included establishing constitutional rights of indigenous people and formation of a separate land commission to protect their land rights.

The participants placed memorandum to prime minister through Deputy Commissioner after the human chain.

A discussion followed the programme on the DC office premises.

The speakers at the discussion said that the indigenous people are victims of discrimination in different fields as the government did not pay proper attention to their causes.

They are always lagging behind as they are being deprived of their rights in all sectors, they said.

The speakers demanded immediate formation of a separate land commission to protect their rights on the plainlands.

They also called to establish a separate ministry for indigenous people to deal

with their problems.

Indigenous people are becoming landless as criminals and local influential people with the help of a section of officials are grabbing their lands, they pointed out.

Urging the government to save the indigenous people from the land grabbers, they said all fake documents made to occupy their land should be declared illegal.

They also demanded allocation of land among the landless indigenous people for their survival.

Demanding withdrawal of all false cases against the indigenous people, they said the indigenous community is still lagging behind in the society as they are not getting facilities like others in the field of education and job.

The speakers also demanded mother tongue-

based primary education for their children and the community's quota in higher education and government service.

They said adibashi people played a significant role during the liberation war in 1971 but they are yet to be given constitutional rights.

Earlier, several hundred indigenous people brought out a procession that paraded different streets in the town.

Huge toxic mangoes seized in C'nawabganj

A mobile court comprising an executive magistrate, police and BDR seized 3,360 kg of toxic mangoes from a wholesale market at Kansat in Shibganj upazila on Monday night.

The team also seized 10 kg of toxic carbide, 200 grams of another poisonous chemical ecophene, a spray machine and 114 plastic cartons from there.

Anisur Rahman, Sub Inspector (SI) of Shibganj police station said a mobile court led by executive magistrate Mohammad Jasim Uddin raided the warehouse of one Sadek Ali at around 10 pm and seized the toxic mangoes, poisonous chemicals and the spray machine while the workers were mixing carbide with mangoes.

Sensing presence of the law enforcers, mango trader Sadek Ali fled the scene.

Anisur said that the seized mangoes would be destroyed after getting order from the court.

A case has been filed with Shibganj police station against mango trader Sadek Ali.

6 children drown in ponds in Sherpur, Gaibandha

Six children drowned in ponds in separate places in Sherpur and Gaibandha districts in the last three days.

In Sherpur, four children drowned in ponds in Sadar and Nalitabari upazilas of the district on Sunday and Monday, according to UNB.

Locals said two children - Usha, 5, of Tarakandi village and Nupur, 4, of Charsapmari village of Sadar upazila fell in the pond while playing near it at about 3pm on Monday.

Asif, 4, and his cousin Rubel, 3, slid and fell in a pond near their houses at Poragan village of Nalitabari upazila and met the watery grave on Sunday afternoon.

In Gaibandha, two children drowned in a pond at Jhamudanga village in Sadullapur upazila of the district yesterday evening when they went there to attend a religious ceremony reports our Correspondent.

The victims are Govinda Chandra Sarkar, 7, and

Biplob Chandra Sarkar, 2.

Eye witnesses said, relatives of late Bhola Nath Sarkar came from far-flung areas to the village yesterday to join his 'sradha' and assembled at the house of the deceased.

Meanwhile, the two children went to play on the bank of the pond. All of a sudden they fell in the pond and drowned as both did not know how to swim.

Relatives later found their bodies floating in the water.

MONDAY'S ATTACK ON CONTRACTOR

4 arrested, gun seized from them in Natore

The law enforcers arrested four people hours after a contractor was shot at Tengragari in Natore Sadar upazila Monday evening.

The arrestees are Masud alias Pagla Masud, 30, Rabiul, 28, Uttam, 30 and Palash, 27.

Natore police arrested the four at Dhalan under Natore Sadar upazila while they were going to Rajshahi in an ambulance. They (police) also recovered a shutter gun and two bullets from their possession.

Contractor Mohammad

Ali, 48, of Baro Gachha area in Natore town got work order for construction of a road from Khajuria to Koror Gram under Natore Sadar upazila. Construction work of a portion of the road was given to Bakul Sarker, son of State Minister for Youth and Sports Ahad Ali Sarker.

Mohammad Ali went to Kholabaria in the evening and found that Bakul Sarker's men were keeping stones on his work site. As he protested it, they had an altercation with Mohammad Ali. Later, Ali started for Natore town in a motorbike.

Ali alleged that when he reached Tenragari nine people riding three motorbikes waylaid him and shot at his legs. He was admitted to Natore hospital and then shifted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital.

Denying the allegation, Bakul Sarker said he is building a portion of the road, using Mohammad Ali's licence.

Officer-in-Charge of Natore Sadar Police Station Abdullah Al Mamun said no case was filed in connection with the incident as of yesterday afternoon.

3 Indians held on intrusion charge

Three Indian nationals were held on charge of intrusion in Barashashi border area under Boda upazila in Panchagarh on Monday night.

Company Commander of Barashashi border outpost (BOP) Nayek Subedar Abul Basher filed a case with Boda police station yesterday afternoon against the three.

Later the arrestees were produced before a Panchagarh Judicial Magistrate Court and judge Abdur Rouf ordered to send them to jail.

The arrestees are Razon Roy, 50, son of late Shukanu Roy, his son Sumon Roy, 30, and his nephew Manik Roy, 25, of Khorja Gumti Sarkarpara village in Jalpaiguri district.

Locals and BDR sources said the detainees entered

into Bangladesh eight days ago without any legal documents and visited different places in Thakurgaon, Panchagarh and Dinajpur districts and met their near and dear ones.

On Monday night they returned to the village to go to India through Barashashi border.

At that time some villagers on suspicion asked them about their whereabouts.

As they said they were Indians, locals detained them and handed them over to Company Commander of Barashashi BOP.

Later the BDR members handed the three over to Boda police station.

A case was filed by the company commander with Boda police station under Section 3(1) under Bangladesh Code of Entry Act of 1952, OC Kaiser Ali said.

Fake medicine, saline factories unearthed

A mobile court here on Monday raided a medicine factory and a saline factory and fined those Tk 3 lakh for illegal production.

During the drive the mobile court aided by Rab, drug and BSTI officials found that the factories were manufacturing a number of medicines without permission.

Also there were no chemist and quality control. The team also found some fake medicines manufactured by them.

The team on Monday raided Green Plus Pharmaceuticals, a herbal medicine factory at village Buderhat in Sadar upazila and Sadat Food Products at village Gobinda in the municipality area. "In Green Plus Pharmaceuticals there were no

chemist, quality control or equipment required for a drug factory. They even had no list of raw materials. The mobile court also found unhygienic environment in the factory," Md Emam Uddin Kabir, Additional District Magistrate (ADM), Pabna, also the head of the mobile court told this correspondent.

The team fined Green Plus Pharmaceuticals Tk 2 lakh, he added.

The mobile court then raided Sadat Food Products and found that the factory was manufacturing oral saline without permission. "They were using normal salt in the saline pack. They had no machine for calculating the proportion of sodium and potassium," a member of the mobile court said.

The saline factory was fined Tk 1 lakh, he said.
