# A rescue at all too difficult place

Hope was fading away fast for Alamgir as the rescuers were : yet to find his wife and three children till yesterday after-

# Death toll climbs to 23

## 10 rescued out of debris; 5 still missing

Rescue workers yesterday pulled 19 more bodies from the rubble of a five-storey building in the capital's Begunbari area,

Eight women and four children were among the dead, said

"It's no game. It's life," said Marzina Begum, who lost three

of her grandchildren in the incident. That was her reaction after onlookers gathered around the

bodies of the children pulled from the rubble in the night. The 50-year-old woman, distraught by the loss, was in a

desperate search for her missing daughter-in-law.

Her son Md Alamgir said it would be less painful to die from taking poison than living with "this loss -- to see my children dead". Minutes later he passed out.

Fire-fighters rescued 10 people yesterday. Five residents of least six people including · three tin-roofed houses ruined by the crashing building are believed trapped inside.

Twenty-four hours into the collapse, the rescuers struggled · to conduct the operation, as the lanes to the site are too narrow

As the day wore on, two divers from the fire brigade searched for bodies in a lake.

### HC records fatwa victim's statement

The B'baria girl was tortured for having an affair

A 17-year-old girl yesterday stated before the High Court that she was tortured physically during a village arbitration in Brahmanbaria for having an affair.

The girl's mother also backed her statement at the court. However, they both denied any instance of a fatwa (religious edict) against the girl. She was reportedly given 101 lashes as a punishment for having an affair.

The HC bench of justices Syed Mahmud Hossain and Gobinda Chandra Tagore recorded their statements separately in a chamber attached to the courtroom.
