importtrade. The proposed budget shows the continuation of two recent structural changes in the budget. First, total revenue earnings have been increased by mobilising more revenue from domestic sources, while the dependence on import taxes has been reduced.

This is a positive change. The second structural change is, however, a matter of concern. Even with an ambitious target for the size of ADP, development spending will be less than 30 percent of projected total budget outlay. This proportion is only 26 percent in the revised budget of the current fiscal. There was a significant contraction in development spending during the tenure of the last caretaker government. Previously, since the early nineties up to the recent period, development spending accounted for an annual average share of more than 40 percent out of total budget expenditure.

Undoubtedly, the implementation of the proposed ADP will require making development administration much more proactive and dynamic and less corrupt. The substantial allocations for investments under socalled public-private partnership have remained unutilized. Fund provisions have been made for this purpose in the proposed budget as well. Moreover, the energy and power sector has been allocated funds on a priority basis for understandable reason. Past experience, however, suggests that without significant improvement in the quality of economic management, mere allocations of funds on

paper are unlikely to yield results. The Finance Minister has rightly pointed out that the pro-posed budget for the next fiscal has an added significance, being the first budget under the proposed Sixth Five Year Plan. It took the last two decades to raise the country's average annual GDP growth from 4 percent to 6 percent. The GDP growth target for the Sixth Plan is likely to be set at 8 percent annually. This represents huge growth acceleration. The proposed bud-get hardly gives indications of any such fundamental policy initia-tives that could help to lift the economy to a higher growth

is conducive to maintaining continuity in the industrial policy and the structure of producer incentive. The so-called regulatory tax on the import of certain fin-ished items introduced last year will continue during the coming fiscal. Additional import taxes have been proposed on certain items including cars and sugar. The economic rationale behind increased import taxes needs to be clearly understood. The policy of raising more revenue by imposing higher taxes on the import of luxury items is in conformity with the equity principle of taxation. However, if the purpose is to provide higher protection to domestic production, there should be demonstrated justification for such increased protection. In particular, differential rates of tax at the finished and semi-finished stages of an import item may sometimes lead to exorbitant protection in relation to local value-added. Dhaka burying her 14-year-old son Jasim Úddin at her home in Hosnabad under Muladi

upazila of Barisal. "How can I stay in Dhaka when my son is at my home. I just came to Dhaka to see the building where all my dreams burnt to ashes," said Shefali when asked whether she would stay with her husband in Dhaka.

She was married in 1991 at the age of just 14. Her husband Bachchu Halder mostly stayed in Dhaka. She was abandoned by her husband in 2000 and he remarried that very year.

She showed a laminated photo of her, her son Jasim and daughter Sheuli to The Daily Star correspondents. "Jasim had gone home during Eid last year. But I was sick then. He took me to Muladi upazila for treatment. He also told me to have a picture taken with him and Sheuli [her eight-year-old daughter] fearing that if something happened to me they would not have anything to remember me by," she said.

Jasim was a class-VI student of Nabakumar Institute. He used to stay with his father and stepmother in Dhaka. Shefali said she used to talk to

her son over the telephone often and she had talked to him five days before he died in the Nimtoli blaze. "Jasim had a cell phone that he bought for Tk 1,600 and he often talked to me. As I have no phone, I

would just give a missed call from a neighbour's phone and my son would call back," Shefali said. When Shefali was struggling to make both ends meet, Jasim took a part-time job at a shop on Shia Goli in Hossaini Dalan in

Large-sized budget | China waits for proposal

Chinese Ambassador in Dhaka Zhang Xianyi said yesterday.

Speaking at a press briefing at the embassy ahead of Chinese Vice President Xi Jinping's official visit to Bangladesh on June 14-15, he said China will contribute to building the deep-sea port as it will connect many countries in this region.

The ambassador said China also has a positive attitude to connectivity, and promoting projects relating to roadway and railway links between the two countries to boost trade and economic cooperation. Bangladesh sought Chinese

assistance to build the deep seaport and direct road link with China during Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's visit to Beijing on March 17-21. Asked about Chittagong-Kunming highway through Myanmar, the Chinese envoy said all the three countries are very

positive about building the tri-

nation highway. "All the three

players will have to come together...It needs time to coordinatetheefforts,"headded. On the scheduled visit of the vice president, one of the top decision makers of the Chinese government, the ambassador said it is "very important" as it

takes place on the occasion of

35th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic ties between Dhaka and Beijing.

During his two-day visit, Xi Jinping will have official talks with Sheikh Hasina, meet President Zillur Rahman, Speaker Abdul Hamid and Leader of the Opposition Khaleda Zia.

The Chinese vice president will lead a high-profile delegation. The 35-member team will include Shen Yueyue, vice minister, Organisation Department, CPC Central Committee; Chen Yuan, chairman, China Development Bank; Zhang Zhijun, vice minister, foreign ministry; Liu Tienan, National Development and Reform Commission; Chen Jian, vice minister, commerce ministry, and Shi Zhihong, deputy director, Policy Research Office.

The ambassador said bilateral trade and economic cooperation will be high on Xi Jinpeng's agenda alongside further strengthening the existing friendly relations. Some agreements will be signed during the visit when China may offer some grants for Bangladesh, he said. "The offer our good friendship."

Zhang said China will offer 1.6 billion yuan for Shahjalal Fertiliser Factory. Besides, a deal telecom project may be signed.

on establishment of 2.5 3G Bangladesh sought US\$ 211 million from China for establishment of the telecom project, but the Chinese government is

yet to finalise how much fund it will provide for the project. The two-way trade between the two countries amounted to \$ 4.58 billion last year with Bangladesh's import bill totalling \$ 4.4 billion. "We want to import more from Bangladesh" to reduce the trade imbalance,

said Zhang. In this context, the evoy said China offered zero tariff for 4,721 Bangladeshi products including RMG, which is 60 percent of Bangladeshi exportable goods.

Asked about military hardware purchase from China, he said defence cooperation between the two sides is excellent. He however did not say precisely about any purchase deal. "It's a normal trade...We don't have major contract in last fewyears," he said.
