

CORPORATE BRIEFS

US stocks gain

US stocks ended a volatile week on the upside Friday, with investors worrying about the global recovery and facing a new batch of housing and inflation data on the world's largest economy.
"Financial markets continued to trash around... as investors remained generally risk-averse and indecisive about how the future would unfold," US economists at IHS Global Insight said in a note to clients.
"These fears were exacerbated by a new batch of housing and inflation data proclaiming that the economic Armageddon that they had predicted for 2009."

China, Taiwan hold trade talks

China and Taiwan on Sunday held a third round of negotiations for a major trade pact in a bid to seal the deal this month.
Experts from the two sides will convene on the one-day meeting in Beijing the main content of the Economic Cooperation Framework Agreement (ECFA), the state Xinhua news agency said.
The ECFA is intended to normalise China-Taiwan economic ties and bring the two economies closer, Xinhua said. The first round of talks took place in January in Beijing and the second two months later in Taipei.
Taiwan's Beijing-friendly government, which says the deal will boost growth and employment, has been pushing to sign the agreement in June.
However, the two sides were "stuck" in negotiations, Taiwan's premier said Saturday, in the latest sign that they may miss this month's deadline.
