

Cultural organisation Chhayanaut will hold a twoday festival on June 18 and 19.

Titled "Nazrul Utshab-1417," the festival will be a homage to the National Poet. Highlighting the poet's life and works, the festival will be held at Chhayanaut Shangskriti

Bhaban auditorium in Dhanmondi, Dhaka.

Noted Nazrul singers of the country, as well as students and teachers of Chhayanaut, will render songs at the festival. The two-day event will be divided into three sessions. The inaugural session will be held on June 18 morning, from 10am to 12 pm. Nazrul exponent Asadul Haque will inaugurate the programme.

The evening session of June 18's programme will feature renditions of songs and a memorial lecture. The memorial lecture will honour the founder of the organisation, poet Begum Sufia Kamal. Former Professor of Rajshahi University Khandakar Sirajul Haque will deliver the lecture.



Anne Hathaway is stepping into a new Cinderella story. The star of "Ella Enchanted" and "The Princess Diaries" will appear in the film adaptation of David Nicholls' popular novel "One Day," about a working-class woman's romance

with a charming rich man, played by Jim Sturgess. The movie begins filming this summer. It will be directed by Lone Scherfig, an Oscar nominee for "An Education." The project was announced Tuesday by Focus Features

and Random House Films, which have a partnership. "One Day" was a No. 1 best-seller in England. It was released Tuesday as a paperback by Vintage Books, an imprint of Random House, Inc.

Nicholls has written the script for the film, scheduled to come out next year.

"My first music teacher was Haropada Das in 1975; next I took music lessons from Mosharraf Hossain (from 1976) at Udichi," says Ardhendu. Later, he took music lessons under tabla newaz, Pandit Ajit Goswami in 1980. He further honed his music skills under Jagadananda Barua in 1982. "I went to India to acquire a higher degree in music. There I trained under Pandit Arun Kumar Bhaduri at Kolkata Sangeet Research Academy in 1995. Besides, my mentors in Rabindra Sangeet were veteran singers Dr. Sanjida Khatun, Waheedul Haq and Goura Gopal," he continued.

He obtained a 1st class in M. Muse in Kolkata with distinction in 1998 and was conferred the title of 'Sangeet Bivakor.'

The artiste finished his primary education in his native primary school, SSC in Kalyani in Kolkata, HSC in City College in Jessore, B.A honours in Jessore M.M College and MA in Rajshahi University.

Ardhendu told The Daily Star that he embarked on his academic career as a music teacher at Munshi Rais Uddin Sangeet Academy in 1978 and in 1982 at Kingshuk academy. He was a trainer of classical music at Jessore Shilpakala Academy and Shaheed Altaf Mahmud Sangeet Bhaban Khulna.

At present he is president of Dhruba Parishad of South-West zone and acting president of Jessore district Jatiyo Rabindra Sangeet Sammilon Parishad.

Ardhendu has won awards from several music academies for his contribution to music. He wants to continue with classical music and intends to compose books on music and will conduct research on Nazrul songs.

Recently, Laser Vision has produced Ahmed's fourth solo album "Phalguner Diney." Renowned literary critic and cultural personality Mustafa Nurul Islam was the chief guest at the album launch. Noted Tagore artistes Tapan Mahmud, Sadi Mohammad, Sajed Akbar, Salma Akbar and Lily Islam were special guests at the event.


