

# Stalkers stab protester to death in Kushtia

A man, stabbed by a gang of stalkers for protesting their evil act in Damurhuda upazila of Chuadanga district on June 10, succumbed to his injuries on Tuesday evening.

Mohiuddin Ahmed, 30, of Dudhpatila village died while he was being shifted from Chudanga Sadar Hospital to Khulna Medical College Hospital (KMCH) at around 6:30pm.

Police quoted locals as saying that Raju Hossain, 22, and Sohel Ahmed, 20, of Anwarpur village under the upazila stalked two schoolgirls at

Dudhpatila village when they were returning home at the village from their school on June 8.

As one Jahangir Alam of the village protested, the stalkers and their accomplices beat him up and hung him from a tree. Hearing the news, people of Dudhpatila village rushed to the spot and rescued Jahangir.

Later, the influential people of the two villages called for amicable settlement of the issue and arranged a meeting at the upazila headquarters on June 10.

Accordingly, both sides attended the meeting on the day. When Mohiuddin and other villagers of

Dudhpatila protested the June 8 incident and demanded exemplary punishment to Raju and Sohel for stalking the two girls of their village, the stalkers and their accomplices stabbed him and injured eight others.

Dudhpatila villagers were enraged at Mohiuddin's death on Tuesday night and they beat up one Ismail Hossain, 40, of Anwarpur village and set his motorbike afire.

Mohiuddin's brother filed a murder case with Damurhuda Police Station against 14 people including stalkers Raju and Sohel.

Our Thakurgaon correspondent reported that a stalker and four mem-

bers of his family were sued in Sadar upazila on Tuesday.

Ashraf Ali of Singia village filed a case with Thakurgaon Police Station against stalker Akhtarul, his father Mohammad Siddik, mother Akil Begum, and brothers Manik Islam and Mohammad Robbani of the same village.

In the case statement, Ashraf said Akhtarul stalked his daughter Arfin Jahan Mitu, 15, a student of Balia Fazil Madrasa on Sunday morning. He alleged that the stalker and his accomplices also beat him as he protested their evil act.

# BNP meeting, houses of party activists attacked in 2 dists

At least 25 leaders and activists of Patuakhali BNP were injured as a gang attacked their meeting at the residence of central BNP Vice-Chairman former minister Altaf Hossain Coudhury at Sher-e-Bangla Girls' School road in the district town yesterday noon.

In Benapole, Jessore, at least eight houses of BNP activists were ransacked allegedly by Awami League activists at Putkhali village in the morning following death of an AL man in intra-party clash at the village on Monday night.

Our Patuakhali Correspondent quoted local BNP sources as saying that about 30 unidentified men, equipped with lethal weapons, attacked the BNP meeting where former minister Altaf Hossain Coudhury was the chief guest.

The gang foiled the meeting, ransacked the house, torched a motorbike and took away five others from the meeting venue, sources said.

Of the injured BNP men, Khalilur Rahman, personal assistant (PA) to Altaf Hossain, Al-Amin, Moshir Rahman Milon, Md Chanudu, Md Monir, Kazi Shah Alam, Abdul Khaleq, Md Delwar Hossain, Ahsan Habib, and Dulal were admitted to Patuakhali General Hospital and different clinics in the town, while the rest given first aid.

Altaf Hossain escaped unhurt as he took shelter in a room during the attack. On information, police and Rab

personnel rushed to spot and took control of the area.

Altaf Coudhury blamed local Jubo League and Chhatra League activists for the attack. He told journalists that BCL and Jubo League activists foiled their peaceful meeting and injured at least 25 party men.

Denying the allegation, district Jubo League President Ahsan Habib Khan and BCL President Jahangir Sikder said

their activists were not involved in the attack on BNP meeting. They said the attack was an outcome of local BNP's internal feud.

No case was filed with Sadar Police Station as of filing of this report at 6:00pm yesterday.

According to a Benapole correspondent, Awami League activists ransacked at least eight houses of BNP men at Putkhali village yesterday morning

following death of AL activist Babu Sardar in intra-party clash at the village on Monday.

Locals said Babu faction and Abul Morol faction clashed at Putkhali School ground over control of the smuggling zone in the area. Babu was killed by a bomb during the clash.

Police have so far arrested five people for their alleged involvement in the clash.

# Six NGO men held on charge of cheating

A court here on Tuesday sent six employees of Foyjul Quran Foundation, a pro-Islamic NGO, to jail for cheating.

They were held on charge of cheating people in the name of giving jobs and preventing police from doing their duty.

The arrestees were identified as Fayzur Rahman, 25, Sarwar Alam, 28, Gias Uddin, 20, Billal Hossain, 32, and Ramzan Ali, 22, of the district and Tarequl Islam, 20, of Jamalpur district.

Police quoting locals said, the NGO men took the unemployed youths to their Quran Shikha Kendra and Non-formal Education Centre. There in the name of giving jobs they collected Tk 20,000-30,000 from each of them as security money four months ago.

But failing to get the jobs as per commitment the youths lodged a complaint with the police.

Later, on the basis of the complaint, police raided the NGO office in Madhabpur area of the district town and arrested them on Monday noon. At one stage the employees tried resist the law enforcers.

On Tuesday noon, police produced them to court and Chief Judicial Magistrate Mia Mohammad Ali Akbar Azizi sent all six to jail hajat rejecting their bail prayers.

# 2 to die for killing wives in Narail, Bogra

## Another held on murder charge in Tangail

Two people to die for killing wives in Narail and Bogra while another person has been held for same offence in Tangail.

A court in Narail on Tuesday sentenced a man to death for killing his wife in 2008, according to a correspondent.

Convict Jasimuddin Molla is son of Tabibor Rahman Molla of Bashgram village in Sadar upazila.

According to the prosecution, Jasimuddin used to quarrel with his wife Nilufa Begum, 38, an NGO worker and daughter of Mohammad Idris of the same village, suspecting her extra-marital affair with a man.

On the fateful night on September 13, 2008, he picked up a quarrel with Nilufa over the issue and at one stage hit her with an axe.

Nilufa died on the spot and Jasimuddin fled away.

A case was filed and police after three months arrested Jasim from Satkhira district.

After examining the records and 12 witnesses

District and Sessions Judge Mohammed Nazrul Islam pronounced the verdict at around 11:00am.

A Bogra court on Monday sentenced a man to death and fined him Tk 20,000 for killing his wife in 2006.

The convict was identified as Shukur Ali, 35, reports our Bogra correspondent.

According to the prosecution, Shukur Ali strangled his second wife Mohuba, 30, and looted her ornaments in Dhupchachia upazila of the district on June 8, 2006.

The then officer-in-charge (OC) of Dhupchachia police station Wahidur Rahman filed a case in this connection.

Nitai Chandra Saha, Additional District Judge-3 of Bogra, pronounced the verdict.

Police in Tangail arrested a man on Saturday from Ghatail upazila on charge of killing his wife for dowry.

The arrestee was identified as Mohammad Nasiruddin, 25, of Chaitthra village under Sandhanpur union in the upazila, reports our correspondent.

Sources said, RMG worker

Nasiruddin married Dipu Khatun, 19, daughter of Saudi expatriate Belal Hossain of Monipur village in the same upazila about 11 months ago. After some days of marriage, Nasir started to press Dipu to bring dowry from her father, family sources said.

The couple used to quarrel on the matter on and often, they said.


On Saturday morning, locals saw Dipu's body floating in a pond adjacent to their house and informed police.

Being informed, a team from Ghatail police station rushed to the spot and recovered the body and sent it to Tangail General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

They also arrested Nasir's younger brother Aminur Rahman, 20, in this connection.

Mominur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Ghatail police station said they suspect that Nasir, with the help of others, might have killed Dipu for refusing to bring dowry.

Victim's uncle Nurul Islam filed a case on Saturday with the police station accusing three people.

# ARREST 'DRAMA' AT RU

## 5 BCL men handed over to police by leaders, later freed

Chhatra League (BCL) leaders at the university early yesterday handed over five of their Madar Bux Hall unit activists to police following an intra-party clash at the hall.

The five BCL men are Shah Newaz Tokon of Sociology department, Ruhul Amin Babu of Library Science, Alim of Information and Communication Engineering, Anwar of Law and Justice and Faruq Hossain of Economics department.

They were, however, released afterwards.

Witnesses said at around 11:00pm on Tuesday night, a group of BCL men led by Tokon beat up BCL activists Mehedi and Salauddin and locked them in a room at the hall over a trifling matter.

Following the incident, a large number of BCL leaders and activists from different halls went to the hall to save Mehedi and Salauddin with firearms creating panic among the general students.

Hearing the news, RU unit BCL president Awal Kabir Joy and secretary Mazedul Islam Opu rushed to Madar Bux Hall to settle the matter.

Later, the two leaders called the law enforcers from Motihar police station and handed the five over to them at around 12:30am.

The leaders took the action in face of agitation by other BCL activists who demanded police action.

The arrestees were also suspended from BCL activities on campus for indefinite period at an emergency meeting at the hall, BCL sources said.

BCL president Awal Kabir Joy said the BCL men were handed over to police as they were trying to create discord within BCL at the hall.

Officer-in-charge (OC) of Motihar police station Abul Khair said they detained the five BCL men on getting alle-

gation from RU unit BCL president and secretary.

"They were released later yesterday after primary interrogation," the OC said.

Meanwhile, BCL men severely beat up a student on Tuesday night at Suhrawardy Hall.

Sources said, a group of BCL cadres led by Ashis and Tofazzal beat up Abdur Razzak Shamim, a master's student of Applied Chemistry as he protested smoking by BCL cadres at the hall's TV room at around 11:00pm leaving him critically injured.

Shamim was admitted to the university medical centre.

BCL president Awal Kabir Joy said he will take stern action against the BCL men who beat up Shamim after an investigation.

RU proctor Prof Chowdhury Zakaria said he will also investigate the matter.

# Jubo League man attacked

An activist of Jubo League was injured in an attack by rivals over submission of tender in the town yesterday.

Shafikul Islam Shimul, general secretary of district Jubo League, said yesterday was the last date for submission of tenders for taking lease of Singra Bridge and two water bodies.

Jubo League activist Manik, 30, went to drop tender at Roads and Highways office at about 10:00am. But rivals dragged him out of the office and hit him with sharp weapons, leaving him injured.

He was admitted to Rajshahi Medical College and Hospital.

Police later arrested two people—Samad and Kamal—from Kanaikhali bus stand in the town on charge of their involvement in the incident.
