He said technical education has been neglected in terms of budgetary allocation and the standards of educa-

Highlighting the government's plan on technical education, he said a technical school would be set up in each upazila across the country and the curriculum will be prepared in line with the At a press conference demand of time and foreign it. labour market.

"We are taking suggestions from the investors and local and foreign employers to

prepare the curriculum. We are also figuring out what types of labour forces the foreign countries need.

"We want that the students of the country receive such education which they can apply in their professional fields," he said.

Nahid said a technical subject would be introduced for class six, seven and eight in the future so that all students can have an idea about

Over 17,000 foreigners are working at upper level jobs in the garments industry, he said, adding that the government wants to create scopes for the students of the country to do the same jobs.

"We have upgraded the textile institutes into universities to this end," he said.

Nahid said technical education is yet to reach a dignified level socially and that is why many people do not want to enrol their children in such courses. "This mindset needs to be

changed", he said and stressed the need for a massive campaign to raise awareness. The events of the week

include rallies, seminars, discussions and meeting with the people involved in this sector.

Bribe to Cover Up Murder Case

Court asks CID to submit probe report by Aug 8

Case was filed against Shah Alam, Babar and two others

A Dhaka court yesterday asked the Criminal Investigation Department to submit by August 8 the probe report of a bribery case filed against Bashundhara Group chairman Ahmed Akbar Sobhan alias Shah Alam, former state minister for home Lutfozzaman Babar and two others.

The case was filed for taking and giving bribes to cover up the murder case of Humayun Kabir Sabbir, a director of Bashundhara Group.

Metropolitan Magistrate SK Tofail Hasan passed the order as the Investigation Officer (IO) of the case failed to submit the probe report by yesterday.

With this, the court gave the CID nine dates in total to submit the probe report.

Two others accused in the case are director of Prime Bank and East West Property Development Pvt Ltd Abu Sufian and former BNP lawmaker Qazi Saleemul Huq Kamal.

Earlier on May 2, the same court directed the IO to submit

the report. Babar, who got bail in this

case, now in jail custody in another case, was not produced before the court yesterday while a counsel represented Qazi Saleemul Huq Kamal.

Abu Sufian was absent from the court without taking any

An official of the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court of Dhaka said he did not find any documents that show Shah Alam having bail in the case from any other courts or being on the run.

Earlier on May 6, 2008, Anti-corruption Commission pressed charges against former prime minister Khaleda Zia's son Tarique Rahman, Babar, Saleemul Hug, Shah Alam and his two sons Shafiat Sobhan Sanvir and Sadaat Sobhan, Abu Sufian and Tarique's personal secretary Mia Nur Uddin Apu.

The anti-graft body said the eight were involved in the bribery to save Sanvir from the charges of killing Sabbir.
