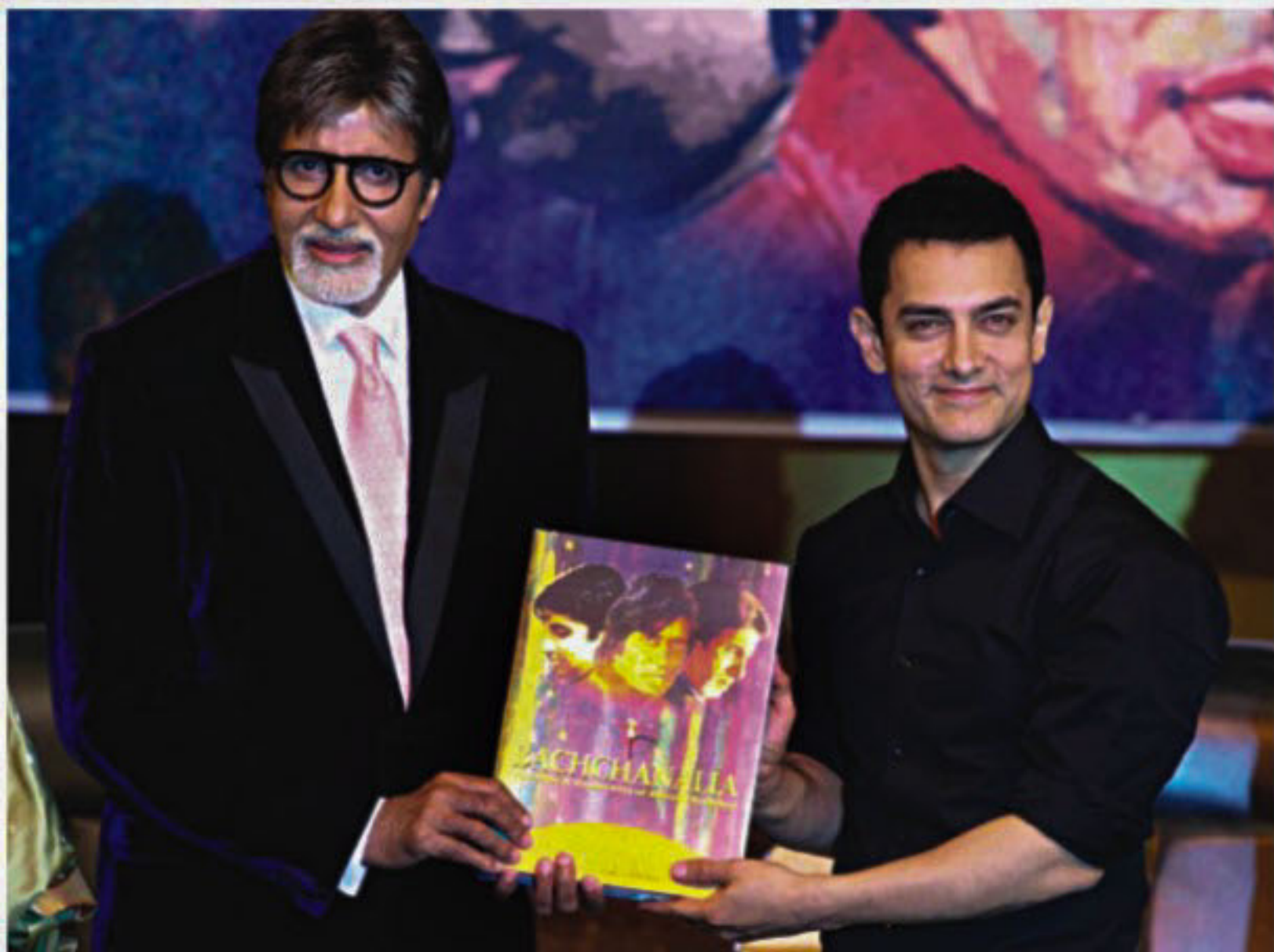
Aamir to join Twitter on Amitabh’s insistence

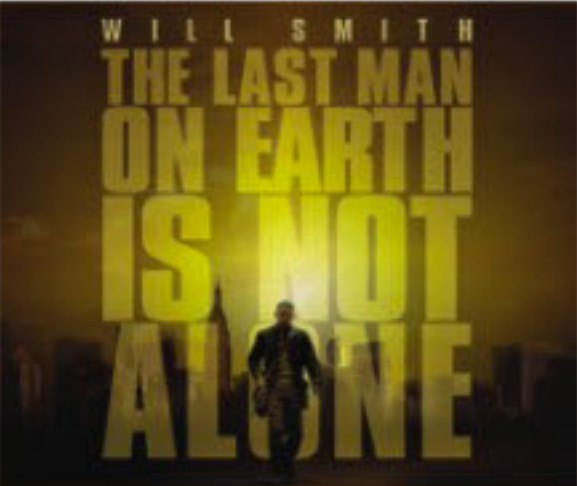
