DEATH IN ROAD ACCIDENT

Cops open fire on protesters, 1 killed

33 injured in clash in Munshiganj; schoolboys among 16 bullet-hit; OC suspended

One person was killed and 33 others including schoolboys were injured yesterday as law demanding a speed breaker on Dhaka-Mawa highway at Kuchiamora under Sirajdikhan upazila of the district.

The demand for constructing the speed breaker came following the death of Mehedi Hasan, a class-VII student of local Adarsha High School, in a road accident in the area Wednesday.

The deceased in yesterday's clash was identified as Moslem, 32, son of Md Ehsan of Maddhachar village in the upazila.

Of the injured, eight were police personnel while 25 locals and students. Sixteen of the 25 sustained bullet wounds.

Students of Adarsha High School Rony and enforcers opened fire on agitating locals Uzzal of class-X; Al Amin, Alamgir, Israfil and Dil Mohammad of class-IX; Sagor Saha and Kanti Rajbangshi of class-VIII; Jarina, 55, a staff of the school; and college student Jahangir, 19, were among the bullet injured, said Uma Kanta Roy, a witness and headmaster of the school.

Assistant Police Super Saiduzzaman Faruki, 36, Officer-in-charge Mizanur Rahman, 45, and Second Officer Mushfiqur Rahman, 42, were also injured in the clash.

Lost battle for a hartal victim

Faruque Hossain finally succumbed to his injuries yesterday after spending five agonising days at the Burn and Plastic Surgery Unit of Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

He had undergone a severe case of burns as criminals torched a car on the night before June 27 hartal. He died in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) at about 2:15am on Thursday, Mohammed

Selim, his older brother told The Daily Star. On June 26, Faruque had left home for Mohakhali with his friends Sumon and Foysal to look for a job. On their way back in Foysal's car, they stopped near Moghbazar level crossing as Foysal went to buy something. Without any warning a group rushed towards the car, poured petrol on it and set fire. By the time they managed to come out of the blazing car, Faruque was badly injured.

Youth killed in 'gunfight'

Cops say he was a mugger; victim's wife alleges 'killing' after arrest

A businessman, whom police claim as a mugger, was killed during a 'gunfight' with law enforcers in the capital's Gulshan early yesterday. The wife of the deceased however differs on the account.

Taslima Begum, the wife, said a team led by SI Anisur Rahman of Gulshan Police Station raided her house at Nayanagar in the city's Badda on Tuesday around 4:30am and arrested her husband Mizanur Rahman.

Mizan, 29, was the owner of electronic goods shop Liza Sound System in the area. Injured Manik, 30, too is a resident of Nayanagar.

Police arrested two other muggers -- Jalal and Aslam -- and recovered a pistol and a private car from the spot.

Gulshan police Officer-in-Charge Mohammad Kamal Uddin said a resident of the area informed him that a silver car was roaming suspiciously at Banani yesterday around 1:00am.

A force led by the OC immediately rushed to the spot. Sensing the crime busters' presence, the car drove to road No 42 in Gulshan.
