

# Hillary Clinton presses Azerbaijan-Armenia peace efforts

US Secretary of State Hillary Clinton sought yesterday to revive peace efforts between Azerbaijan and Armenia amid rising tensions in their long-running conflict over the breakaway Nagorny Karabakh region.

On visits to the two countries on US Independence Day, Clinton also pressed Azerbaijan on human rights and said she had raised issues of freedom of expression in the ex-Soviet republic.

Before arriving in Armenia where she was to meet President Serzh Sarkisian, Clinton said in the Azerbaijani capital Baku that reaching a peace deal on Karabakh was a "high priority" and that Washington was ready to help.

"We stand ready to help both Azerbaijan and Armenia to achieve and implement a lasting peace settlement. The final steps toward peace are often the most difficult. But we see peace as a possibility," she said at a news conference with her Azerbaijani counterpart, Elmar Mammadyarov.

"We believe there has been progress. This is a high priority for the US," Clinton said.

Clinton had earlier met with Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev, who said he expected the United States "to work closely with us and with others on the resolution" of the conflict.

"This is a major problem for us and the major threat to regional security," Aliyev



she had raised the issue of two jailed bloggers whose case has intensified concerns over media freedom in Azerbaijan.

Clinton said that despite "considerable progress" with regards to freedoms in Azerbaijan, "there are still lots of challenges".

"President (Barack) Obama and I have both received many letters about the two young bloggers who are in prison. I've certainly raised those in my meetings today," she told a group of youth activists.

The two bloggers, Adnan Hajizade and Emin Milli, were arrested and jailed on hoologanism charges last year shortly after posting an Internet video of a donkey giving a press conference, lampooning the country's docile press and statements by government officials.

The charges related to a scuffle in a restaurant but the bloggers and rights groups say the arrests were politically motivated.

Clinton's first visit to the country as secretary of state came as the United States seeks to shore up ties with Azerbaijan -- a key link in supply lines for Afghanistan and an important energy hub -- after Baku complained that Washington had neglected relations.

Azerbaijan accused the US of ignoring its interests by backing reconciliation efforts between Armenia and Turkey, which closed its border with Armenia over the Karabakh conflict, without linking Baku's demands to the efforts.

After meeting with Aliyev, Clinton said

"We want to find a resolution based on international law and we want to find it as soon as possible. Our people are suffering."

Tensions over Karabakh have risen in recent months amid stalled negotiations over the status of the region, where ethnic Armenian separatists backed by Yerevan seized control from Baku in a war in the early 1990s that claimed an estimated 30,000 lives.

At least four Armenian and two Azerbaijani soldiers were killed in fighting over the region in June.

Aliyev also last month threatened to withdraw from foreign-backed peace talks after he accused Armenia of stalling the negotiations.

# A JuD office-bearer among those in Pakistan custody

The Pakistani government may continue to find it difficult to legally pin down Jamaat ud-Dawa chief Hafiz Mohammed Saeed in the 26/11 case, but its own investigators have bared the JuD's link with the Mumbai attacks. It now turns out that a JuD office-bearer -- a fact that was never made public -- is among those arrested and facing trial in Pakistan for financing the attacks.

Muhammad Younas Anjum, who was arrested much after Zaki-ur-Rehman Lakhvi and Zafar Shah, has been identified by the Pakistan Federal Investigation Agency in its 61-page interim chargesheet, now a submitted court challan, last September as "Ameer of Jamaat-ud-Dawa, District Multan".

Since the trial is being held in-camera, the only information let out about Anjum is that he was a "financer". But his JuD links have been kept a tightly-held secret, shared only with the court.

Anjum has been charged with transferring Rs 81,000 to the Karachi bank account from which marine equipment for the attack was purchased, proving the fact that JuD and LeT are indeed the same outfit.

The chargesheet states: "The role attributed to Muhammad Younas Anjum is that as Ameer of Jamaat-ud-Dawa, District Multan, he sent Rs 81,000 from his own account no. 2430-7 ABL, Rasheedabad, Multan, to co-accused Shah Jamil Riaz having A/c no. 2464-0 ABL, Drigh Colony, Karachi."

According to the details submitted to the court, Anjum's role came to light after Pakistani investigators traced the account being operated from an Allied Bank Ltd (ABL) branch in Karachi. Funds from this account, opened by accused Shah Jamil Riaz, were used to fund the preparations for the Mumbai attack.

The chargesheet says: "By this act accused Muhammad Younas Anjum fully participated in the commission of offence by financing terrorists based in Karachi during their preparations for Mumbai terror attacks and enabling them to carry out Mumbai terror attacks successfully."

This court challan, obtained by The Sunday Express, gives a detailed account of the investigations being carried out in Pakistan. It has joined the dots on several important leads passed on by India, and shows that the Pakistani Federal

Investigation Agency (FIA) has also independently established the linkages that trace the genesis of the attack to Pakistan. This later formed the basis on which a Pakistan special court eventually indicted 20 Pakistanis in the case, including Lakhvi and Zafar Shah alias AbdulWajid.

The Karachi account was unearthed as follows: The FIA made initial investigations on the basis of a complaint filed after "brief facts" were passed on by India through diplomatic channels. Soon after, Pakistani investigators went after the outlet from where the Yamaha engine No. 1020015, recovered from the dinghy used by the terrorists to land in Mumbai, was purchased. FBI investigators, it may be recalled, had established that the engine was imported by Business & Engineering Trends, 24 Habibullah Road, off Davis Road, Lahore.

From here, according to the chargesheet, it was found that the engine had been sold to one ARZ Water Sports, M-172 Brohi Mohalla Sher Shah, Karachi. But Muhammad Ali, owner of the ARZ Water Sports, told FIA investigator Altaf Hussain that he had sold it to one Amjad Khan for Rs 1,80,000 on September.

## Mastermind of 72 Munich Olympic attack dead

Palestinian leader Abu Daoud, who planned the daring deadly attack against Israeli athletes at the 1972 Munich Olympic Games, died Saturday of illness at the age of 73, Palestinian officials said.

Daoud, whose real name was Mohammed Daoud Odeh, "was ill and passed away this morning," in the Syrian capital where he was living, a Palestinian official told AFP.

His funeral is expected to take place following afternoon prayers at the Martyrs Cemetery in the Yarmouk Palestinian refugee camp on the southern outskirts of Damascus, the official added.
