

# Truck drivers, workers in Rangpur block road

## Repair of local truck stand demanded

Truck drivers and workers blocked Rangpur-Bogra highway yesterday demanding repair of infrastructure of a local truck stand.

Road communications with Rangpur and four other northern districts remained snapped for one hour from 12:00 noon. About two thousand vehicles got stranded while police played the role of silent spectators, witnesses said.

President of Rangpur Truck Workers Association Manik Miah claimed that Rangpur municipality authorities leased the bus stand. "They take money for it but never bother for its repair," he said.

Despite frequent request the municipality mayor did not take any initiative to repair the truck stand, Manik said.

Contacted, Rangpur municipality mayor Abdur Rouf said it was a dirty trick by a leader of Rangpur Motor Vehicle Owners Association.

"Having failed to take lease of the truck stand at Tk 4,00,000 for next one year, he instigated the truck workers to stage road blockade," he said.

"Last year Rangpur municipality leased the truck stand at Tk 12,00,000. This year Moshir Rahman Ranga wanted to take lease of the truck stand at only Tk 4,00,000. He and his men did not let the others to participate in the

bid. Therefore, we cancelled the bid and decided to call fresh bid. That's why Ranga became angry and told the truck workers to block road," the mayor said.

But Moshir Rahman denied his involvement with road blockade programme. There is no connection between the bid and truck workers demonstration, he said.

"As secretary of Rangpur Motor Vehicle Owners Association, I must say the demand of truck workers is justified," Ranga said.

He said mayor Abdur Rouf has no right to charge lease money as the municipality does 'nothing' for the truck stand.

# 7 accused out of 34 arrested in Ctg

Seven of the 34 accused in Durgapur upazila Jubo League leader Abdul Karim murder case were arrested in Fatikchhari upazila of Chittagong district on Monday night, police said.

The arrestees are Md Shahiduddin, Abu Chand, Sohag Mia, Billal Hossain, Al Amin, Abdul Berek and Sumon Mia. They all hail from Chalkpara village under Durgapur upazila of Mymensingh district.

Acting on a tip-off, law enforcers from Durgapur Police Station went to Saha village in Fatikchhari and

arrested the seven with the help of Fatikchhari police at around 9:00pm.

Abdul Karim, a member of the executive committee of Durgapur upazila Jubo League, was killed by a gang of criminals while returning home at Chalkpara from nearby Dawdukun Bazar on June 2 this year.

Karim's brother Abdul Alim filed a murder case with Durgapur Police Station the following day against 34 people including the arrestees.

Police yesterday produced the seven in the Senior Judicial Magistrate's Court that cancelled their petitions and sent them to the jail.

# Export-import resumes thru' Benapole port

Import and export through Benapole land port resumed yesterday morning after remaining suspended for one day.

A total of 57 truckloads of goods from India entered Bangladesh while 32 truckloads of goods went to India since morning till filling of this report yesterday afternoon.

Custom Cargo Officer Debashis Kunda at Benapole check-post said import and export between the two countries resumed on a full scale from morning.

Earlier, on Monday the activists of CPI and CPM halted import-export by hoisting a red flag at Indian land port Petrapole, as the parties called a dawn-to-dusk strike all over India to protest price hike of oil and gas in India.

# 7 injured as Jubo Dal rivals clash

At least seven people were injured as rival factions of Palashbari upazila Jubo Dal clashed on the eve of BNP called country-wide human chain programme.

To make today's agitation programme of BNP a success, a faction of Palashbari upazila Jubo Dal brought out a procession led by its secretary Majedur Rahman Mukul.

When the procession reached near Rabbi Hotel another faction led by former secretary Faridul Huq Rubel came face

to face with Mukul's group.

Activists of Mukul group chased their rivals with lethal weapons. Panicked shop owners pulled their shutters down and the pedestrians ran helter and skelter for safety. During the clash and brickbats seven people were injured.

Meanwhile, Upazila BCL and Jubo League activists brought out a counter procession and chased the activists of Jubo Dal. At this, the activists of both the factions of Jubo Dal fled away.

Later BCL and other front organisations held a street rally which was presided over by Feroj Kabir Sumon. The meeting was addressed, among others, by Tofazzal Hoassain, president of upazila Awami League, Mofluber Rahman, Azadul Islam and Ali Mostafa Reza.

The speakers expressed concern at police inaction and demanded arrest of the troublemakers on street within 12 hours.

During the rally around a hundred vehicles remained stranded on both the sides of Rangpur-Bogra highway.

# Outlaw killed in mob beating

A leader of outlawed Purba Banglar Communist Party, who was injured in a mob beating during robbery at Atulia Bazar in Tala upazila on Saturday night, died at upazila health complex on Monday night.

The deceased was identified as Moslem Moral alias Navy, also second-in-command of 'Salam Bahini'.

Police said, on Saturday night when a gang of robbers numbering 15-16 were committing robbery at Atulia bazar local people caught Navy and gave him a good thrashing, leaving him seriously injured.

Later, police admitted Navy to upazila health complex on Sunday morning where he died at about 10:00 pm on Monday.

Police said, he was wanted in several cases including that of murder.

## BSF kills Bangladeshi

Bangladeshi cattle trader, injured in BSF firing on Joynagar border on July 3, died at Sathkira Sadar Hospital yesterday. The victim was identified as Abul Bashar, 30, son of Abul Khair of Godaghata village under the upazila. The BSF men of Joynagar camp opened fire on the cattle trader while he was crossing the border at about 4:00am, sources said. Locals rescued Khair and sent him to Sathkira Sadar Hospital in a critical condition where he succumbed to his injuries.

## Fake examinees held

Four fake examinees were held while they were appearing at the first year final of degree examination under National University at Thakurgaon Govt Women's College on Monday afternoon. A vigilance team headed by executive magistrate Zaharul Islam held the four at the exam hall. Identified as Abu Sayeed, Abu Zahed, Faruque Hossain and Loket Pal, they were giving proxy in the English examination for Mortuza Ali, Shohel Rana, Md Rafiqul Islam and Asaduzzaman of Thakurgaon Govt College. The college authority later handed them over to Thakurgaon police. Two cases were filed in this connection.

## Rapist gets life

A Narsingdi court on Monday sentenced a man to life imprisonment for violating a girl. The convict is Mafizuddin of Kharab village under Manohordi upazila. According to prosecution, Mofiz raped a girl of the village in a field near his house on November 17 in 2006. Victim's father filed a case with the local police against the rapist the same day. After examining the records and witnesses, Judge M Sadiqul Islam Talukder of the Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal pronounced the verdict.

## Robber held with firearms

Police arrested a robber with firearms at his house at Koira village under Koira upazila of Khulna district early yesterday. The arrestee is Manjurul Islam Sheikh, 35, son of Yunus Sheikh. Acting on secret information, police raided the house of Manjurul at around 1:00am and arrested him. They also recovered two guns and three bullets from his possession. M Alamgir Hossain, acting officer-in-charge of Koira Police Station, said Manjurul was wanted in several criminal cases.

## Boy drowns in pond

An 18-month-old boy drowned in a pond at Sambalkati village under Sadar upazila of the district yesterday. Local people and family sources said Anik, son of Sameeran Halder, was playing near the pond adjacent to the house at around 8:00am. Suddenly, he fell into the pond and drowned. In another incident, Tuhin, 18, a rickshawpuller, drowned while he was swimming along with his friends in the Sugandha River at Krishnakati village near the district town yesterday. Family sources said Tuhin, hailed from Gopalganj district, was an epileptic patient.
