and chair of the Department of Anthropology of Jahangirnagar University, described the different areas of empowerment regarding the bodily integrity. Binayak Sen, research


director of Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies, focused on the economic aspect of women empowerment and work related issues.

The government would stop all sorts of environmental degradation following hill cutting, forest plundering or poor management of industrial waste, said Primary and Mass Education Minister Afsarul Amin.
