

## Six killed in road crashes

At least six people were killed and 37 others injured in separate road accidents in Sirajganj, Satkhira and Mymensingh yesterday.

A correspondent from Sirajganj reports: At least two people were killed and three others injured in a road accident on Bogra-Pabna highway in Baghabari area under Shahjadpur upazila of the district yesterday.

The victims were identified as Jamal Uddin, 5, and Abdus Salam, 40, of Jalalpur Mohollah under Sadar upazila of Pabna.

Police said the accident occurred at around 3:00am when a Dhaka-bound microbus collided head-on with a truck coming from the opposite direction in Baghabari area, leaving Jamal and Salam dead on the spot and injuring three others.

However, the driver of the truck managed to escape along with the truck.

Police sent the bodies to hospital morgue for autopsy.

The injured were admitted to Bera upazila health complex.

A case was lodged with Hatikumrul Highway police station in this connection.

Our correspondent from Satkhira adds: Two people, including an elderly woman, were killed and 29 others injured in a road accident on Satkhira-Kaliganj road at Shatpur village in Kaliganj upazila yesterday.

The deceased were identified as Mohammad Ali Sahaji, 50, son of Ishaque Ali Sahaji of village Bharashimla and Pagli Rani Ghosh, 60, wife of Sudhanya Ghosh of village Satpur in Kaliganj upazila.

Quoting local police said the accident occurred when a Satkhira-

bound bus skidded off the road and fell into a ditch after hitting passersby, leaving Sahaji dead on the spot and 30 others injured, including the victim Pagli Rani Ghosh.

The injured were taken to Kaliganj Upazila Health Complex where Pagli Rani succumbed to her injuries at about 4:00pm.

UNB from Mymensingh says: Soheli, 22, was killed on the spot when a bus hit him at Boiler crossing in Trishal upazila at 1:30pm.

Local people damaged the bus. In another incident, a leguna fell into a roadside ditch at Cheler ghat in the same upazila after hitting a schoolboy at 7:00am.

Mostafiz, 10, a student of class III, died on the spot while five passengers of leguna were injured in the accident.

## Fake juice factories unearthed

Detective Branch (DB) of Police arrested one person and a large quantity of sub-standard juice during drives in Thakurgaon yesterday.

Sub-Inspector of DB Abul Hasnat said acting on a tip-off a DB team raided a house at Shahapara and found an illegal juice factory producing sub-standard juice.

They also seized different materials including several juicing machines and packaging machines, saccharine, industrial dyes and unauthorised orange flavours and arrested its owner Amir Hossain, 32, son of late Dabirul Islam.

Following Amir Hossain's information, the team later conducted separate drives at the houses of Touhidul Islam, son of Samsul Haque, at College Para and Abdur Rauf, son of late Dabirul Islam of Chitchilawrong of the district.

Police recovered fake juice packs, chutney and chanachur from these two houses.

But none could be arrested as the occupants of the house fled sensing the presence of police.

DB police filed a case under Special Powers Act, 1974, with Thakurgaon Police Station against the three house owners, SI Hasnat said.

## 1200 bottles of Phensedyl recovered in Benapole

Police yesterday recovered 1,200 bottles of banned Indian Phensedyl syrup from Goga Setai village under Benapole Port Police Station.

Rab-6 sources said acting on a tip-off, they conducted a drive at the village and seized the drugs.

Sensing the presence of law enforcers, the people carrying the drugs managed to escape.

Police recovered bodies of a father and his son on Thursday at Chirirbandar upazila of Dinajpur.

The deceased were identified as Md. Rokunuzzaman, 60, son of late Shamsur Ali, and Md. Moktarul Islam, 25, son of Md. Rokunuzzaman of Gabindapur village of the district.

Police sent the bodies to son of Md. Rokunuzzaman of Dinajpur Medical College for autopsy, and said the deceased were murdered due to a land dispute.

## Passenger train derails in Lalmonirhat

Railway control office said around 10 to 12 hours will be needed to resume rail communication along the route.
