On the fourth day (July 12) of the ongoing theatre festival featuring plays on the Liberation War, Udichi staged "Bou Bashonti" at the Experimental Theatre Hall, Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy. "Bou Bashonti" has been written by Ratan Siddiqui and directed by Abul Kalam Azad of Prachyanat. The play zooms in on a remote village during the Liberation War. Although the war is on, the people of the village are not that concerned about it. The war has not yet affected them in a major way. They are more concerned with their basic needs. The play includes familiar village

characters such as a landlord, two thieves, farmers, young women, a tailor etc. A radio takes the centre stage. Through radio broadcasts and dialogues, the playwright recreates an ambience that is not yet ravaged by the atrocities of war. During the war, mundane life doesn't change in the village. Burglary doesn't stop; people continue getting married. But the social structure of the village changes. A small-time fraud, turned into a Pakistani collaborator, strives to become the village chief. Ratan Dev and Anowarul Haque enacted the roles of the two thieves, Badar and Monu. Shaidul Alam Dipu performed as Moin. Among others, Maruf Rahman,

Amit Ranjan Dey and Fahmida Haque Koli played important roles in the play. Saiful Islam was the set and light designer, while Rahul Anand did the music for the play. On the same day, the Department of Drama of Shilpakala Academy staged "Khetmojur Khoimuddin" at the National Theatre Hall. Golam Sarwar directed the play. The festival ends today through the staging of two plays. Theatre Art Unit will stage its acclaimed production "Court Martial" at the National Theatre Hall and Mahakal will stage "Ghum Nei" at the Experimental Theatre Hall. The plays will begin at 7pm.
