India's foreign minister said he would press Pakistan on the progress of its probe into the Mumbai attacks as he arrived in Islamabad yesterday for talks aimed at reviving a peace process broken off after the assault.

The remarks by SM Krishna came as a top Indian security official accused Pakistan's main intelligence agency, ISI, of controlling and coordinating the 2008 attacks on the Indian financial capital that killed 166 people.

"We hope to discuss all issues of mutual interest and concerns that can contribute to restoring trust and building confidence in our bilateral relationship," Krishna told reporters at Islamabad airport upon arrival.

"This is an important visit as it marks the new beginning of a journey in our effort to build a peaceful, friendly and cooperative relationship between our two countries.

Krishna said he was looking forward to receiving feedback from Pakistan on India's "core concern of terrorism".

Krishna and Pakistani Foreign Minister Shah Mehmood Qureshi are due to meet on Thursday as part of efforts to revive a peace dialogue crucial not only for improving their ties but also the security outlook in Afghanistan where the two countries vie for influence.

India last year linked Pakistan's Inter-Services Intelligence agency (ISI) with the attacks, saying the perpetrators were "clients and creations" of the agency.

Just hours before Krishna's arrival, Indian Home Secretary GK Pillai, in remarks published in Indian Express newspaper yesterday, said the ISI did not have "just a peripheral role" in Mumbai

"They (ISI) were literally controlling and coordinating it from the beginning till the end," the newspaper quoted Pillai as saying.

India has blamed Pakistan-based Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) militants for the Mumbai attacks and has also linked ISI to the attacks, which Pakistan denied. Pillai's comments were the most direct accusation yet of Pakistan by India.

Pillai said the evidence against the ISI emerged from the interrogation by Indian officials of a Chicago man, David Headley, who pleaded guilty to working with LeT to plan the attacks.

Krishna said the issue was discussed during last month's visit of Indian Home Minister P Chidambaram to Pakistan and he would raise it again in talks with Qureshi on Thursday.

Eight dead in Kandahar suicide attack

Three American soldiers and five Afghan civilians have died in a Taliban suicide attack on a police base in southern Kandahar province, Nato said yesterday.

A suicide car bomber rammed the compound entrance before insurgents fired rockets and machine guns in Tuesday evening's raid.

Afghan police backed by Nato troops repelled the attack, Nato said.

Earlier on Tuesday, a rogue Afghan soldier killed three British soldiers in Helmand province.

Nato said a "full-scale manhunt" is under way for the Afghan soldier, who escaped after killing the three Gurkhas in Nahr-e Saraj.

yesterday. The central government and the leaders of the states agreed to revisit their anti-insurgency strategy by deciding to form unified commands in the four worst hit states, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Orissa and West Bengal, with a retired major general as one of its members.

The decision was taken at a daylong meeting convened by the prime minister at his 7, Race Course Road residence. The chief ministers of Orissa, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh and Bihar, the governor of Jharkhand, which is under president's rule, and a minister

from West Bengal attended.

In his opening remarks, the prime minister said that 'though law and order is primarily a state subject, the ramifications of the problem of left wing extremism call for sustained coordination between the centre and the states not only regarding the overall strategy but even on the regular operational issues'.

'On the security side, the state forces obviously will have to be further strengthened, though the position has improved in the past few years. I also think that we need more young men and women from these areas in our security forces. In case there are issues regarding intelligence sharing or the pattern or nature of CPMF deployment, I would like to hear them,' the prime minister said, stressing 'that we cannot afford to let inter-personal issues come in the way of our strategy to tackle Left Wing Extremism'.

day agreed to step up their conservation efforts with the aim of doubling the wild tiger population by 2022, officials said. Officials and conservationists from the tigerrange countries met in the Indonesian resort

island of Bali from Monday through yesterday to hammer out plans to be discussed at the Tiger Summit in Russia in September. The 13 tiger-range countries are

Bangladesh, Bhutan, China, India, Indonesia, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Russia, Thailand and Vietnam. 'This meeting was crucial in that it gave more

focus to conservation plans drawn up at previous meetings in Nepal and Thailand,' said Harry Santoso, director of biodiversity conservation at Indonesia's forestry ministry. 'We are confident that with concerted efforts,

the global tiger recovery programme will be

reduced to an estimated 3,200 animals, including 400 Indonesian Sumatran tigers, according to the World Wide Fund for Nature

(WWF). They are being threatened by habitat fragmentation and destruction, loss of prey, poaching and illegal trade.

At the meeting, countries presented their national tiger recovery programmes and outlined commitments to meet the target of doubling wild tiger numbers by 2022.

The meeting also endorsed a draft declaration to be adopted by leaders at the Tiger Summit in Russia.

It also called for increasing enforcement efforts to reduce the trafficking of tiger parts and to eradicate poaching and identifying and protecting key tiger habitats, such as breding areas.

Shutdown paralyses Kashmir valley

The Kashmir Valley shut down yesterday in response to a call by separatists while life in the summer capital ground to a halt with authorities imposing curfew-like restrictions in several areas.

Restrictions in Srinagar's old city as well as Maisuma and Batmallo localities were imposed as a precautionary measure to maintain law and order, police said.

Security forces were patrolling the areas, disallowing any pedestrian and vehicular movement.
