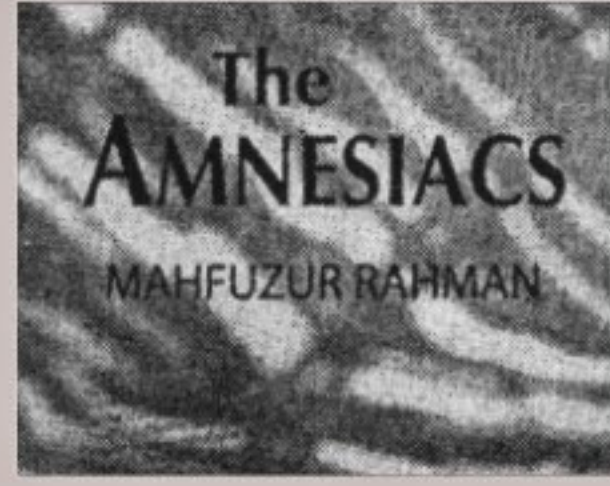

Eminent Nazrul Sangeet artiste Feroza Begum's physical condition has improved, according to family sources. The veteran songstress is undergoing treatment at Mount Elizabeth Hospital in Singapore.

Feroza Begum was hospitalised after she was having difficulty breathing from pneumonia.

Her family hopes that after necessary tests, she can return home within the next ten days.

Feroza Begum popularised Nazrul Sangeet in the 1960s both in Bangladesh and West Bengal and became an icon of the music genre.
