

Mokammel in Sydney

Movies can resolve conflicts

Tanvir Mokammel in Down Under.

It was a big thumbs up for film director

At a conference on Peace and Conflict Resolution organised by the University of Sydney, he not only shared his thoughts with peace activists, academicians, filmmakers, theatre activists, researchers and teachers from 17 different countries but also had his two documentaries "Swapnabhoomi" and

"Karnaphulir Kanna" and last feature film "Rabeya" proving a big draw for Bangladeshis settled in Australia.

The five-day conference, which saw media and film personalities from the UK, Ireland, the USA, Japan, India, the Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh, Indonesia, New Zealand, and of course host Australia, opened on July 6, Mokammel told The Daily Star.

At the inaugural session, prominent peace activists from different regions of the world talked about the role the media and cinema could play in conflict resolution. On July 8 Mokammel was a discussant on the role of theatre activism in developing harmony and peace among conflicting nations and ethnic groups.

The next day, he, along with the screening his two documentaries, presented his discussion paper on the Role of Documentary Cinema in the Process of Conflict Resolution, narrating his experiences of battling the legal and psychological hurdles in Bangladesh to make the films and how they helped reduce tension among the conflicting parties.

Mokammel's latest feature film "Rabeya" set against the backdrop of

Bangladesh's Liberation War was shown at the Sydney Civic Theatre where a large number of Bangladeshi expatriates attended the screening.


In the question and answer session that followed, the audience was engaged in an absorbing conversation with the director about his art and other aspects of contemporary cinema in Bangladesh. The show was organised by the Bidesh Bangla Television of Australia.

"It was a great feeling interacting with the audience and its response to my films," Mokammel said. In his paper presented at the conference, Mokammel said documentaries on ethnic tensions, if made objectively and without bias, can bring about reconciliation and expressed satisfaction that "Swapnabhoomi" and "Karnaphulir Kanna" had helped in achieving that objective in Bangladesh.

Pointing out that the Bangladesh High Court had in the year 2008 paved the way for citizenship for stranded Biharis, Mokammel recalled an interesting anecdote in this context at the conference. According to him, "a Bengali judge of that bench, which pronounced the verdict, later told a lawyer, an acquaintance of mine, that his views about the Biharis changed immensely by watching 'Swapnabhoomi'!"

Similarly, "Karnaphulir Kanna" "definitely has made some impact in sensitising Bengalis about the plight of the Hill people in the Chittagong Hill Tracts," Mokammel said. He, however, rued that the documentary was banned in Bangladesh and he had to move the High Court seeking a lifting of the ban.

Soon after returning to Dhaka from Australia, Mokammel is preparing to fly to Mumbai to collect some historical footage for his near-completion mega documentary "1971" on Bangladesh's LiberationWar.
