

Criminals kill Sylhet businessman

Armed criminals chopped a businessman and AL leader to death in Companiganj upazila Sunday night.

Victim Zainuddin Ahmed, 45, was president of the Dayarbazar Bayboshayee Samity and a member of the upazila Awami League committee.

Locals and police said, Zainuddin was attending a meeting of the Dayarbazar Bayboshayee Samity at about 8:30 pm Sunday. Following a call on his cell phone, he came out of

the meeting and went to the nearby auto-rickshaw stand.

As he reached there, a gang all on a sudden attacked him and slit his throat with a sharp cleaver and left the place.

After some time, some pedestrians informed the meeting that Zainuddin's body was lying on the road.

His colleagues took him to the Companiganj upazila health complex but the attending doctors declared him dead.

His body was handed over to family members after post-mortem yesterday afternoon. Zainuddin was recently

elected president of the Dayarbazar Bayboshayee Samity.

A few days ago, he along with locals drove out the drug peddlers from Dayarbazar. He also caught some of the peddlers and handed them over to the police. Besides, Zainuddin was an aspirant for the Uttar Ronikhai union parishad chairmanship, locals said.

Police yesterday morning arrested one Rozon Miah of Kalibari area as a suspect in the killing.

Zainuddin was vocal against the drug net and this might have caused his brutal killing, police said.

KIBRIA MURDER CASE

Date for 'further probe' report deferred again

Divisional Speedy Trial Tribunal Judge of Sylhet yesterday deferred the date for filing the report of the 'further investigation' in Kibria murder case to July 25.

Earlier, special public prosecutor Kishore Kumar Kar prayed for extension of time on the plea that the CID could not finish the job and it needs more time for the purpose.

It was the 37th time that the CID sought for time extension, court sources informed.

The CID failed to file the 'further investigation report' in the last 40 months.

The then investigation officer (10) of the case, senior ASP of CID Munshi Atiqur Rahman, through a petition, informed the Sylhet divisional Speedy Trial Tribunal about necessity of the 'further investigation' on March 7, 2007.

Munshi went on retirement after several months and ASP Md Rafiqul Islam was given the task.

Former finance minister SAMS Kibria, his nephew advocate Shah Manzurul Huda, local AL leaders Abdur Rahim, Abul Hossain and Siddique Ali were killed in a

grenade attack at a public meeting at Baiderbazar of Habiganj Sadar upazila on January 27, 2005.

CID officer senior ASP Munshi Atique filed charge sheet in the case on March 20 that year against 10.

Of the accused, eight were arrested while two remained absconding till date.

The eight, including the Habiganj district BNP vice-president Abdul Quaiyum, remaining in jail for three years, came out on bail and claimed themselves innocent. Later on the CID started further investigation.

The Rab on March 8, 2010 arrested alleged Huji operative Mizanur Rahman Mithu, who gave confessional statement before judicial magistrate in Habiganj following day.

The CID then remanded the former state minister for home affairs, Luthfuzzaman Babar in the same case.

CID ASP Rafiqul Islam, investigation officer of the case, told this correspondent weeks ago that they need some more time to submit supplementary charge sheet as 'further investigation' was in progress. At that time he claimed the job would be completed soon.

Robbers loot 5 houses

Robbers looted valuables worth over Tk 3 lakh from five houses in Betagi upazila early Sunday.

Police quoting locals said a gang of armed robbers swooped on the houses of Abdur Rahman and Nazrul at Zilbunia village and looted valuables worth about Tk 2 lakh after tying up the members of houses.

The gang at one stage beat up and injured house owner Nazrul and Jesmin Begum as they tried to resist them.

In another incident in Hosnabad village, robbers took away valuables worth Tk one lakh from the houses of Sattar Talukder, Khaleque Talukder and Manu Karigor.

Manu Karigor was injured by the robbers as he tried to resist them.

The injured were admitted to different clinics. Another report from Gopalganj adds: Police arrested two robbers along with firearms and sharp weapons from Chapail ferry ghat area of Sadar upazila while they were taking preparations to commit robbery early Sunday.

Additional Police Super intendent Rokonuzzaman said, being tipped off that a gang of robbers numbering 7/8 were going to the town's BSCIC industrial estate to commit robbery a police team led by officer-in-charge M Borhanuddin chased them at about 12:30am in the Ferry ghat area.

The law enforcers arrested two of the gang identified as Meraj of Induhati village of Khulna and Liton of Nijra village of Gopalganj.

Jubo League man stabbed to death

A Jubo League activist was stabbed to death in Sonaimuri railway station area of the district on Sunday night.

The deceased was identified as Sumon, 28, of Vanuai village under Sonaimuri upazila.

Locals said, at around 9:00pm Sunday night, Sumon and Rubel, another activist of Jubo League locked in an altercation over control of drug trade in the area.

At one stage, Rubel stabbed Sumon in his chest and back with a knife leaving the latter

seriously injured.

Locals rescued Sumon and took him to Noakhali General Hospital where the on-duty doctors declared him dead.

Sonaimuri police recovered the body and sent it to hospital for autopsy.

Officer-in-charge Nazibul Islam of Sonaimuri police station said they have recovered a knife from the spot.

However, Rubel went to hiding after the killing, he said.

Sonaimuri GRP police lodged a case with Laksam police station in this connection.

Pirates abduct 14 fishermen

Pirates of Sunderbans abducted 14 fishermen from 14 boats in Marabaghi area under Sharankhola police station on Sunday evening and demanded Tk 3.5 lakh ransom.

Police quoting fishermen said, pirates numbering 12/14 belonging to 'Rubel Bahini' intercepted the 14 boats as they reached the area on their way back home and looted nets and fishes.

Later, the pirates abducted 14 fishermen each from one boat demanding per head

ransom of Tk 25,000. All the fishermen hailed from different villages of Sharankhola upazila.

The pirates also threatened to kill the abducted fishermen if their family members fail to give the money within next three days.

Mihir Kumer, DFO of Sunderban East Range said drive was on to rescue the abducted fishermen.

Earlier in last two weeks pirates attacked over a hundred boats and trawlers, looted valuables worth Tk 30 lakh and abducted 120 fishermen for ransom from the area.

Rapist gets life

UNB, C'nawabganj

A court here on Sunday sentenced a man to life imprisonment for violating a girl. The court also fined the convict, Tauhidur Rahman Biraj, son of Hamsed Ali of Biswanathpur village under Shibganj upazila, Tk 20,000, in default, he is to suffer another year in jail. According to the prosecution, Biraj raped a girl of the village on the night of December 1 in 2004. Later, the village people in arbitration asked Biraj to marry the girl, which he refused. After his refusal, the victim filed a case with Shibganj Police Station. After examining the records and witnesses Judge of the Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal-2 Arup Kumer Goswami pronounced the verdict.

Fugitive convict arrested

A fugitive convict and leader of a gang of inter-district robbers was arrested at Manikpur village in Arahazar upazila early Sunday. The arrestee was identified as Habibullah, 40. Acting on a tip-off, Arahazar police raided the village and arrested him at around 4:00am. Police said Habibullah remained absconding since a court here in 1994 had sentenced him to 15 years rigorous imprisonment in a robbery case. Another report from Jhalakati adds: Police arrested three people in the town's Gorostan road area on charge of stealing transformers on Saturday night. The arrested were identified as Mohammad Shahid, 40, of Chandkathi area in the town, Babul Chandra Mistri, 38, of Aura village in Kathalia upazila and Mohammad Bahadur Hawlader, 25, of Pingri village in Razapur upazila.
