One killed, 9 hurt in clash

UNB, Rangpur

A man was killed and nine others were injured in a clash over land dispute at Padaganj Madrassahpara in Mithapukur upazila of the district Friday noon. Locals and police said, Moktar Hossain Master of the village bought 36 decimals land a few years ago from Nesar Ali of the same village. But Nesar did not register the land in the name of Moktar Hossain and sold the land secretly to one Shafiqul Islam of the same village. Shafiqul on Thursday transplanted aman seedlings on the land. On information, Moktar along with his men uprooted the seedlings from the land on Friday. Later, a bloody clash ensued between them at noon leaving 10 people injured, three critically. Injured Anwarul Islam, 42 died in the hospital. He was the son of Raju Miah of the village.

JU student commits 'suicide'

UNB, Cox's Bazar

A student of Jahangirnagar University (JU) was found dead near Shahpuri Island jetty ghat in Teknaf upazila Wednesday morning. Police recovered the body of Sohanul Hasan Sohan, 24, Botany department final year student of Jahangirnagar University. Son of Mohammad Babar Ali, he hailed from Baro Bazar of Meherpur Sadar upazila. Police said being refused by a girl, Sohan decided to commit suicide at Bay in St Martin's Island on July 25. As per his decision, he left for St. Martin's on July 23 and switched off his cell phone. Since then, he remained missing. His elder brother Zahir Raihan identified the body at Teknaf police station on Wednesday morning. Before committing suicide he left a chit in which he wrote about his affairs with a girl and decision to commit suicide, police said.

Fugitive convict held

Police arrested a fugitive convict on Friday night at Pachghoria village under Haripur upazila in Thakurgaon. The convict was identified as Jahangir Alam, 38, son of Rafizuddin of the same village. Police said a police team of Haripur police station led by sub-inspector Rezaul Karim raided Jahangir's house and arrested him. A Thakurgaon court awarded Jahangir Alam one-year imprisonment on 23 June 2010 for embezzling money of Thakurgaon Sugar Mills.

JP confce after 13 years

Lalmonirhat district Jatiya Party (JP) held its conference yesterday after long 13 years. A discussion meeting was held on the occasion at district auditorium cum community center at noon, where the Civil Aviation and Tourism Minister GM Quader, MP, was present as chief guest. All the leaders, workers of Jatiya Party and its front organisations joined the programme. Sources said, the activities of Jatiya Party in Lalmonirhat district could not be held properly during the last 13 years as there was no chain of command in the party. JP leader Nazrul Islam NDC was elected president of Lalmonirhat district JP uncontested. Mahbubur Rahman and SK Khaja Moinuddin were contesting for the post of secretary till filing of this report at 4pm yesterday.

Rice sale at fair price

Sale of rice through fair price card will begin from Monday or Tuesday in Khulna city. Each card holder will get 20 kilograms of rice a month at the rate of Tk 22 per kg under this programme. Though many city dwellers are yet to get their fair price cards, I have been asked by higher authorities to take necessary preparations in this respect, said District Controller of Food Md. Monirul Islam. Five dealers would be appointed in every ward for this purpose, he said ruling out possibility of any crisis of rice and politicisation in appointment of dealers. The appointment of new dealers would be completed by Sunday, he said. There are 33,400 metric tons of rice in stock in two central food godowns in Khulna. He said that two foreign ships reached Mongla Port last Monday carrying 6,380 metric tonnes of rice imported from Pakistan.

Assault on teachers triggers protest

Students of Goswami Durgapur High School in Kushtia Sadar upazila yesterday boycotted their classes and examinations demanding immediate arrest of an exemplary punishment to those involved in assaulting two teachers of the school on Thursday.

Police arrested two people following a case filed by one of the two assaulted teachers with Islamic University Police Station against nine unidentified people the same day. The arrestees are Bokul Ali and Golap Hossain of Durgapur area.

School sources said local Awami League leader Mahir Uddin was elected chairman of the school managing committee recently. Upazila Nirbahi officer (UNO) was the chairman of the committee and his tenure expired in December last year. The education board ordered holding of election to the post after the UNO expressed his opinion not to continue as the chairman of the committee.

Newly elected chairman Mahir went to the school at around 11:00am on Thursday and asked Headmaster Ehsanul Haq to send names of two people of his choice to the education board as members of the committee.

As headmaster refused to do so before expiry of the tenure of the present committee, Mahir had an altercation

with him in presence of some teachers who sided with the headmaster.

While returning home from school, Assistant Headmaster Hasan Jahid Pias and senior teacher Fazlul Haq came under attack by a gang near a bridge at Badumazu village at around 4:30pm. They took the teachers to a nearby poultry farm, beat them up severely and left the scene.

Hearing screams, local people rushed to the spot, rescued the teachers and took them to Kushtia General Hospital. Assistant Headmaster Hasan Jahid Pias filed a case with Islamic University Police Station accusing nine unidentified criminals immediately after the incident.

The incident sparked protest in the area. Locals have urged the police superintendent of Kushtia and the officer-in-charge of Islamic University Police Station to nab the criminals involved in assaulting the teachers.

The students of the school also took out a procession in the area yesterday and held a rally protesting assault on their two teachers. They demanded immediate arrest of the culprits. Locals also expressed their solidarity with the demand.

Contacted, Officer-In-Charge (OC) of Islamic University Police Station Motiar Rahman said the drive is on to arrest the persons involved in Thursday's incident.

Rab recovers 13 firearms

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) recovered 13 firearms from five districts on Thursday and Friday.

Rab recovered five firearms and bullets from Chuadanga and Rajbari on Friday and Thursday night, reports our correspondent.

Rab also arrested an outlaw from Rajbari in this connection.

Acting on a tip-off that a group of criminals carrying firearms were hiding at Monhorpur in Jibonnagar upazila in Chuadanga, a Rab-6 team raided the area at about 9:30pm on Friday.

Sensing presence of Rab men, the gang fled the scene leaving their firearms at a place where from the elite force recovered 2 pistols, one shutter gun, one pipe gun and

4 bullets.

Another team from Rab-12, Kushtia raided the house of outlaw Sudhangshu at Piralipara village in Pangsha upazila in Rajbari district at about 10:30pm and arrested him.

Sudhangshu is a top cadre of Janajuddho faction of outlawed Purba Bangla Communist Party (PBCP-ML). He is also a close aide of Janajuddho regional leader Poritosh alias Poirat.

On his confessional statement, Rab recovered a shutter gun and one bullet from his house. Later they handed the outlaw to Pangsha police in Rajbari.

In Cox's Bazar, the elite force recovered 4 firearms and arrested two criminals in separate drives on Friday, reports UNB.

Rahman, Senior Assistant Director of Rab-7 said, acting on secret information, they conducted a drive in Baniarchhara Forest Station area of Chakoria upazila and recovered three pipe guns and one LG gun.

None was arrested in this connection as the criminals managed to flee the scene sensing presence of the Rab team.

On the same day, Rab arrested M Rubel, 26, and M Gias Uddin, 30, while they were vandalising the house of Enamul Huq after beating him and his family members mercilessly at Chiringa Stationpara in the same upazila.

Another report from Bogra adds: A team of Rab-12 led by Major M Mostafa Asad Iqbal on secret information recovered one pipe gun and

two bullets kept in a plastic bag at Durgahata Bazar in Gabtoli upazila at 1:30pm on Friday.

Later the seized firearm and bullets were handed over to Gabtoli police station.

In Pabna, Rab men in a drive recovered three firearms and six bullets from Rajapur early Thursday, reports our correspondent.

Acting on secret information that a gang was preparing to commit a crime, a Rab-5 team of Joypurhat district cordoned off the local cotton mill area at night.

Sensing the presence of Rab, the criminals fled the scene leaving their arms there.

Later, the Rab members recovered one foreign made revolver, two shutter guns and six bullets from the spot.

7 injured as robbers, villagers clash

Seven people, including three robbers, were injured in a fierce clash between robbers and villagers at Pirpurkulla village in Damurhuda upazila on Friday night.

Locals said, a gang of robbers numbering 10/15 intercepted a group of people at about 10:00pm while they were returning home from nearby Karpashdana bazaar and tried to loot valuables from them.

Hearing their hue and cry, villagers rushed to spot and locked in a clash with the robbers that left seven people including three robbers injured. Later, the robbers fled the scene along with their injured accomplices.

Three injured villagers were rushed to Chuadanga Sadar Hospital.

In Sirajganj, a gang of robbers looted cash and valuables worth Tk 4 lakh from an engine-driven boat in Jamuna river injuring seven businessmen on Friday.

Police said, around 25/30 businessmen from Meghna Ghat were going to nearby Natuarpara market by the boat. A gang of robbers swooped on the boat when it reached Biralgari char area and took the businessmen hostage at gunpoint at about 8:00am.

Later, they beat the businessmen mercilessly leaving seven injured and looted Tk 3 lakh in cash and other valuables from them.

4 electrocuted in 3 dists

Four people have been electrocuted in Mymensingh and Lalmonirhat and Dinajpur districts.

A boy died and his father was seriously injured from electrocution at Ramkrishnapur village in Nandail upazila of Mymensingh early Tuesday.

The deceased was identified as Ahad Mia, 12, a class seven student of Madhupur Madrassa and son of Abul Kashem, 45, of the village, reports UNB.

Witnesses said, Ahad while working in a cucumber field beside his house suddenly came in contact with a snapped electric wire and died instantly at around

6:00am.

Abul Kashem also sustained serious injuries when he tried to save his son. He was admitted to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital where his condition was stated to be critical.

In Lalmonirhat, two people were electrocuted at Khordo Bisondoi village of Dawabari union in Hatibandha upazila on Tuesday morning, reports a correspondent.

The victims were identified as Reazul Islam, 52, and Laily Begum, 55, of the same village.

Police said, Reazul was electrocuted as he came in contact of an electric wire at his homestead. Laily Begum was

also electrocuted as she touched Reazul Islam. Both were rushed to Hatibandha upazila health complex but the doctors declared them dead.

A man was electrocuted in Bahadur Bazaar area of Dinajpur town on Thursday night, reports UNB.

The deceased was identified as Azizul Huq, 42 son of Khatir Uddin, hailed from Dogachhi village in Biral upazila.

Witnesses said the incident occurred while Azizul was repairing an electric wire in the area. He was rushed to Dinajpur Medical College Hospital the same night where he died next morning.

Police handed over the body of Azizul to his relatives of after autopsy.
