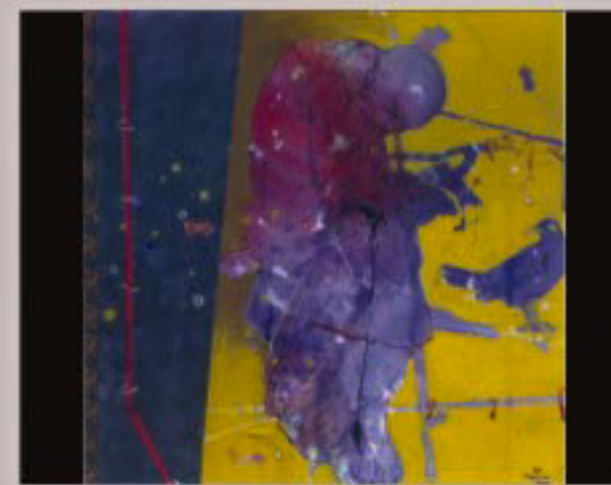

Bangladeshi artist Alpana honoured in London

Bangladeshi expatriate painter Murshida Arzu Alpana has been working in Berlin since 1993. She is considered a

conceptual artist whose works focus on the state of women in society. A woman is a symbol of justice, peace and harmony,

feels Alpana. Recently, the artist was accorded ROSL (Royal Over-Seas League) Centenary Reception at St

James's Palace in London, according to a press release. Queen Elizabeth II, the Duke of Edinburgh and Danish Princess Alexandra were present at the reception.

Alpana's works are mostly figure oriented and portraits. Her approaches are close to realistic but at times she feels comfortable in abstract expressionism.

Alpana does studies of landscapes too, and often mingles figures with the landscapes in the background. She studied under KG Subramanian at Shantiniketan, India and then went to Berlin in 1993 on a scholarship. Her paintings also put human forms with objects like computer, mobile phone and mouse. Her preferred mediums are silkscreen printing, oil, mixed-media, acrylic, pigments, papers, textile, acryl-glass, pencil, crayon, oil sticks and charcoal.

New Michael Jackson album due in November

An all-new Michael Jackson collection featuring 10 unreleased songs will be released this November, a rep for the Jackson estate exclusively tells Rolling Stone. At the time of his death Jackson reportedly left hard drives filled with unheard music, much of it recorded during the King of Pop's '80s peak.

Jackson's manager Frank DiLeo told RS that he estimates that Jackson's vaults contain more than 100 completed and unreleased songs, including collaborations with Akon, Will.i.am and Ne-Yo.

"Every time that [Jackson] recorded, he over-recorded. He would record anywhere from 20 to 30 songs for each album," former Sony Music CEO Tommy Mottola told RS last year. Any of them could have been as big a hit as the ones that came out." One of the most noteworthy tracks was a Thriller outtake titled "Don't Be Messin' Around." Other candidates include any of the reported five songs that Jackson recorded with Will.i.am.

Last year, a pair of unreleased Jackson tracks, "Another Day" and "A Place With No Name," leaked, and recently Rodney Jerkins, who co-produced Jackson's 2001 album *Invincible*, revealed to VladTV that he's currently working on the collection.

The album of never-before-heard Jackson songs will be the first in a 10-project, seven-year deal the Jackson



estate inked with Sony Music in March 2010-- a \$250 million pact that will also include reissues of Jackson's classic albums, new greatest hits sets, a DVD collection of all Michael's music videos and possibly a Cirque du Soleil show. The

hybrid karaoke and dance simulator *Michael Jackson: The Video Game* is also expected out by the end of 2010.

The villagers believe the accusation because of Manik's poor past record.

Unable to deal with the false accusation against her son, Manik's mother suffers a fatal heart attack. Manik is shaken and is forced to return to hard reality.

In the upcoming romantic drama "Eat, Pray, Love," Julia Roberts plays a woman who embarks on a journey of self-discovery. It seems the actress has also learned some life lessons of her own along the way, especially when it comes to accepting her appearance.
