Speakers at a rally yesterday urged the heads of state and government of different countries to hand over the six fugitive killers of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman to Bangladesh.

They made the appeal at the rally on the National Press Club premises in the city organised by Bangabandhu Sangskritik Jote.

"They (foreign countries) will have to prove that they want a world free from crimes and terrorism through sending back the killers of Bangabandhu," Tarana said.

She said they would submit memorandum The Jote also formed a human chain in to foreign missions in Dhaka and form human chain in front of the foreign missions apart from taking hunger strike programme in future in support of their demand.

Actor Faruq said they would expand their movement unless the killers are sent back through Interpol.






