

Wall Street to keep close eye on key Fed talks

Wall Street will keep a close eye on a key Federal Reserve policy meeting the coming week amid concerns the US economic recovery could stall following larger-than-expected job losses.

Investors may be anticipating an extension or expansion of the Fed's policy of quantitative easing, or massive purchases of Treasuries and other securities to provide further liquidity to the economy.
