NEWS Call to stop culture of secrecy in information dissemination

Speakers at a consultation meeting hoped that the Right to Information (RTI) Act would build informed citizens and ensure transparency in information dissemination process to make existing democratic norms more functional.

They stressed the need for coordinated efforts at individual and institutional levels to stop culture of secrecy in information dissemination.

The RTI Act overrides the Official Secrets Act and similar laws and rules and strikes at the heart of the centuryold practices in the government offices

and public establishments. Management and Resources

Development Initiative (MRDI) organised the meeting supported by USAID Progoti in Barisal yesterday.

Government officials, development workers and rights activists, journalists, academics and members of the civil society took part in the open note presentation pointed out the discussion, moderated by Farid Hossain, Bureau Chief of Associated Press (AP).

Deputy Commissioner of Barisal SM Arif-ur-Rahman said enforcement of the RTI Act will help government officials to be more accountable to the
