

Today marks the 61st birth anniversary of noted playwright Selim Al Deen. Al Deen was born in Senerkhil village, under Shonagazi upazilla of Feni. He completed his masters in Bengali Literature from Dhaka University and did his PhD from the Department of Bangla, Jahangirnagar University on the subject 'Modhyo Juger Bangla Natyo' (Medieval Plays of Bengal). Al Deen is widely credited for his postcolonial approach to the neo-theatre movement in Bangladesh. His notable works include "Keramat Mangal," "Prachya," "Hat Hadai," "Joiboti Koinnar Mon," "Chaka," and "Nimojjon." He received the Ekushey Padak in 2007.

To celebrate the birth anniversary of 'Natyacharya' Selim Al Deen, a four-day programme begins today at the Experimental Theatre Hall of Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy (BSA). The slogan of this year's celebration: "Prachya Moncher Partha Hey Tumi Punyaslok Selim Al Deen".

"Ishi Cha" was an adaptation of Ed Bullins' "Death List". Aungojai Marma adapted the play and Taslima Jahan directed it. The play highlights an indigenous revolutionary, who makes a death list of individuals from his own community. The list includes high officials in the government, journalists, politicians and cultural personalities.
