Girl commits 'suicide'

A mentally challenged girl allegedly committed suicide on Monday afternoon at Accha village under Sadar upazila in the district. The deceased was identified as Sonamoni Bala, 15, daughter of Shopen Bala of the village. Police and family sources said at about 4:00pm on the day the girl committed suicide by hanging herself from the ceiling of her room. On information police went to the spot and recovered the body. An unnatural death (UD) case was filed with Thakurgaon police station in this connection.

Man held with arms

UNB, Goalanda

Police in a drive arrested a criminal along with a firearm from a Dhaka-bound passenger bus at Doulatdia Ghat early yesterday. The arrestee was identified as Mohammad Rana Mollah, 28, son of Mannan Mollah of South Gangarampur village in Moksudpur upazila of Gopalganj district. Acting on a tip off, a team of Goalanda Ghat police intercepted a capital-bound Hanif Paribahan bus from Benapole near Kafil Uddin filling station at about 3am. Sensing presence of police Rana tried to flee targeting a pistol at Goalanda police station SI Shamul Haque who quickly dived and caught the criminal. Police recovered an American-made 9mm pistol along with a few bullets from him.

Boy electrocuted

A seven-month-old boy was electrocuted in the city's Sadarpara under Upasahar area on Monday noon. The deceased was identified as Sohan Ahmed, son of Mizan Mia, of Naya village of Zakigan upazila. Police quoting family sources said, when Sohan's mother went out of the room at about 11am leaving Sohan alone he touched a multi-plug and got electrocuted. He was rushed to Sylhet Osmani Medical College Hospital where the attending doctor declared him dead. A UD case was filed with Kotwali PS in this connection.

Two jailed for murder

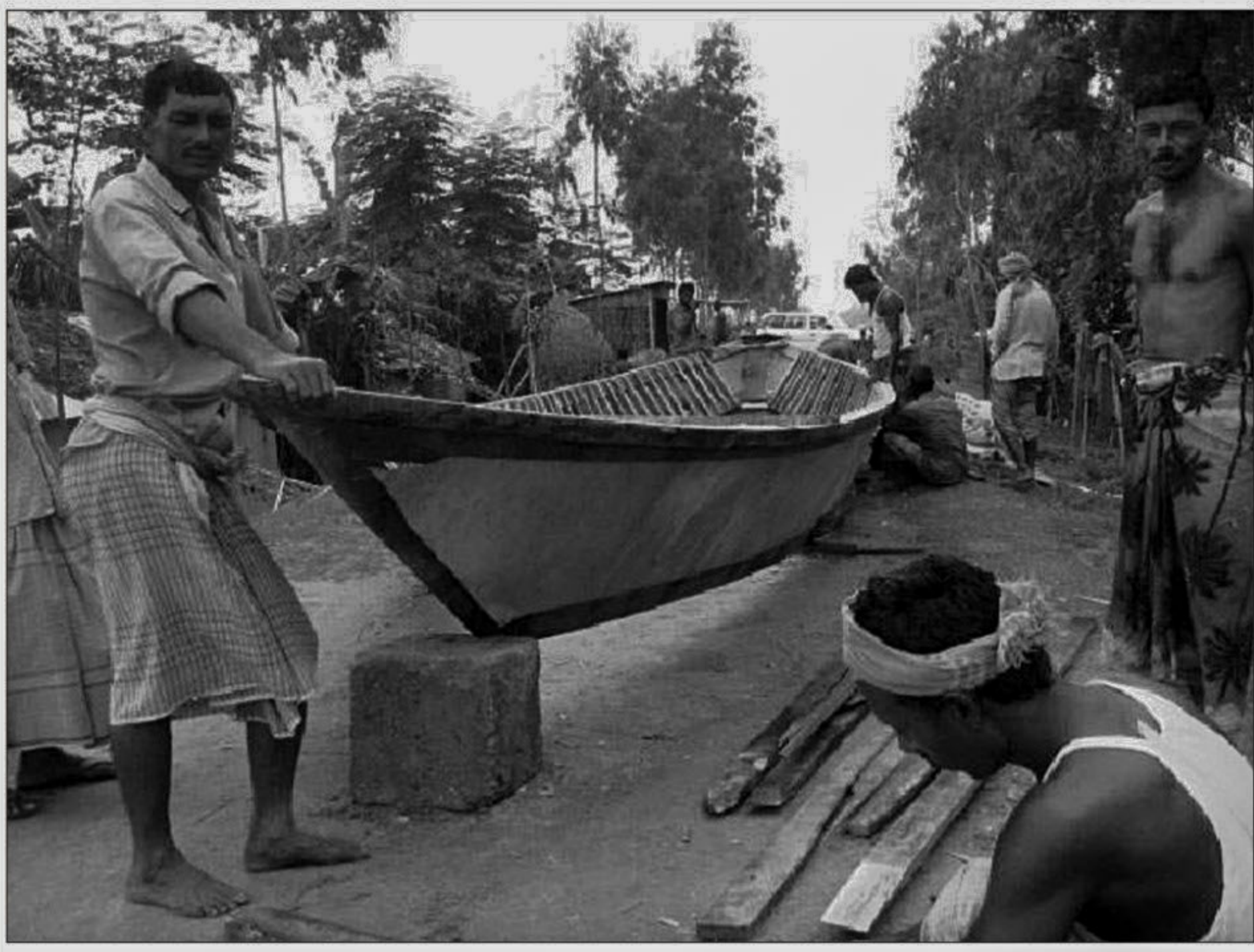

A Dinajpur court yesterday jailed two persons for life for killing a man. The court also fined each Tk.2,000, in default to serve more 3 months in jail. Md. Rafiqul Islam, Judge of Dinajpur Special Judge Court delivered the verdict in presence of the accused in a crowded courtroom. The convicts are Shahinur Islam alias Babu, son of Md. Abdul Hakim of village Jagannathpur and Md. Motaleb Hossain, son of Md. Jalal Uddin of village Jagannathpur of Parbatipur upazila in the district. According to the court prosecution, Md. Moqsedul Haque, son of Younus Ali of village Jagannathpur of Parbatipur upazila went missing on February 1, 2007 after his marriage. Five days later police recovered his body from a nearby paddy field. Later Younus Ali father of Moqsedul, filed a case with Parbatipur police station accusing two people.

Fake fertiliser seized

Police recovered 438 sacks of adulterated TSP fertiliser from a shop at Banshipur Bazar in Shyamnagar upazila yesterday evening. They also arrested Mahabur Rahman and Mostafa Kamal, owners of M/s Krishi Bitan at Banshipur Bazar. Quoting locals police said, acting on a tip-off, Police raided the shop in presence of Agriculture officials and recovered the fake fertiliser kept hidden in a room. Shyamnagar upazila agriculture officer Ali Hossain filed a case with Shyamnagar PS accusing the two.

Two housewives murdered allegedly for dowry

Two housewives have been killed allegedly over dowry in Panchagarh and Narsingdi districts.

A housewife was killed allegedly by her husband and in-laws for dowry at Saprajarh village under Atwary upazila in Panchagarh on Sunday evening, reports our Thakurgaon correspondent.

To cover up the murder, the killers allegedly poured poison in her mouth and claimed it as a case of suicide, reports our correspondent.

The victim was identified as Kulsum, 24, wife of Dhajibul Islam of the same village.

Police and locals said Kulsum, daughter of Shahidul Islam of Baroaulia village under Atwary upazila was married to Dhajibul Islam, son of Mojibul Islam of Saprajarh village under the same upazila about four years ago.

After marriage, Kulsum's

husband and the in-laws used to torture her frequently for dowry.

On the fateful day, the family members of her husband beat her mercilessly over a trifle matter leaving her dead.

After her death they told the villagers that she committed suicide by taking poison. Hearing the news, Kulsum's family members rushed to the spot and found several injured marks on her body.

Later the victim's father, Shahidul Islam, filed a murder case with Atwary police station accusing four people including her husband.

In Narsingdi, a housewife was strangled allegedly by her husband and family members over dowry at Pirpur village of Raipura upazila on Friday midnight, reports a correspondent.

Victim Razia Akter, 27, was daughter of a freedom fighter Abdul Barik of Charuzilabo

village in Belabo upazila.

On the fateful night, Morshed, 30, following an altercation, strangled Razia, mother of two children, as she refused to bring dowry money from her father's house, said Abdul Baten, officer-in-charge of Raipur police station.

Family sources said Morshed married Razia about five years ago. After the marriage, Morshed and his family members used to torture her for dowry.

Recently Morshed asked Razia to bring Tk one lakh from her parents to send his brother Osman abroad. On Friday, Morshed, with the help of his brother Osman Mia strangled her to death.

On information, police recovered the body at about 10am and sent it to Sadar hospital morgue for autopsy.

Morshed, along with family members, went into hiding immediately after the killing.

BAU golden jubilee today

Golden Jubilee of Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) will be celebrated today with due festivity.

Marking the occasion, BAU authorities have chalked out a day-long programmes including hoisting of national and university flags, rally, tree plantation, seminar, farmers' gathering and inauguration of fish museum at BAU.

Agriculture Minister Begum Matia Chowdhury will be the chief guest at the inaugural session while Fisheries and Livestock Minister Abdul Latif Biswas, MP, State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Captain (Retd) Mujibur Rahman Fakir, MP and State Minister for Cultural Affairs Promod Mankin, MP will be the special guests.

BAU Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. M A Sattar Mandal will chair the function.

Students Affairs Adviser and president of celebration committee Prof. M.D. Mustafizur Rahman and BAU registrar Md. Nazibur Rahman will also address the inaugural session, among others.

BAU was established in 1961 on the bank of Old Brahmaputra river, some 4 km away from Mymensingh town with a view to rendering higher education and research in agriculture.

Now this university is one of the most renowned technical institutions in South East Asia which runs six faculties.

Dr. MA Osman Gani was the first Vice Chancellor (VC) of BAU.

BHASANI UNIVERSITY

Students agitate for month to rename degree

Academic and administrative activities at Maolana Bhasani University of Science and Technology in Tangail are suffering badly as the students of three of its seven departments have continued agitation for the last one month demanding BSc (Engineering) degree instead of BSc (Honours) degree.

To press for the demand, around 750 students belonging to different years of Biotechnology and Genetic Engineering (BGE), Environmental Science and Resource Management (ESRM) and Food Technology and Nutritional Science (FTNS) Departments formed human chains on the campus and staged sit-in in front of the administrative building yesterday.

Students of BGE and ESRM departments also locked the department buildings but a police team later broke the locks.

As the agitating students observed their programme defying the authorities' ban that was imposed earlier, a police team led by an assistant superintendent of police of Tangail reached the campus immediately after getting information from the university authorities.

Earlier on August 10, the university authorities served show cause notices to eight students of BGE department and 14 students of FTNS department for holding agitation programmes on the

campus defying the ban. To press for their demand, the students of three departments started boycotting their classes and examinations on July 20.

They also observed token hunger strikes and formed human chains on the campus, held press conferences at Tangail Press Club and gave memorandum to the university authorities including the vice chancellor, the registrar and teachers of the departments concerned for the purpose.

Claiming that BSc (Engineering) degree will help to keep them 'fit' in the job race, the agitating students of the three departments said they will not join classes and examinations until they get a positive announcement about their demand.

When contacted, Prof Nurul Islam Miah, vice-chancellor of the university, said, "The students have taken admission to this university to get the honours degree. Following agitation of the students of the three departments, I have held an urgent meeting with all the teachers and chairmen of the departments. On the basis of the opinions of experts and the departmental teachers on the syllabus of the three disciplines, the meeting decided that there is no scope to change or rename the degrees."

"I have directed the students of the three departments to join their classes as all the examinations of the university will be held in time," he added.

KHULNA UP CHAIRMAN MURDER

Protest on, no case filed, no arrest yet

An uneasy calm is prevailing in Phultala upazila following murder of Damodar union parishad chairman Sarder Abu Saeed Badal.

All shops at the upazila headquarters remained closed for the second day yesterday in protest against the murder. Local BNP held a condolence meeting followed by a mourning procession in the morning.

Police seized the blood stained motorcycle, which the slain UP chairman was riding at the time of being gunned down. Though no case was filed with Phultala Police Station as of filing of this report as 5:00pm yesterday, police launched combing operation to arrest the killers.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) Kazi Daud Hossain said the murder was committed by hired killers. But he did not tell who hired the killers for killing the UP chairman.

Leaders of BNP Khulna city and district units issued a joint press statement on Monday night, accusing the ruling party

men of masterminding the murder of Badal. They demanded immediate arrest of the killers and the masterminds.

Sarder Abu Saeed Badal was gunned down at around 11:00am on Monday near his house at Damodar under the upazila. He was the organising secretary of Phultala upazila BNP.

Two young men waylaid Badal when he was going to the union parishad office on a motorbike from his house. They fired five bullets from their revolvers from point blank range, hitting him in the head, chest and back, said witnesses and police.

He was rushed to the emergency ward of Khulna Medical College and Hospital where the doctors declared him dead.

Protesting the murder, locals put up barricades at several places of Khulna-Jessore highway, disrupting transport services on different routes of south-western region.

The slain UP chairman was elder brother of Phultala Upazila Parishad Chairman Ariful Islam Mithu, also the president of Phultala unit of BNP.

Cop murder: Another outlaw held

An outlaw and suspected killer of three policemen in the remotest Dhalarchar last month was held from the district's Rajbari border area on Monday night.

The arrestee was identified as Jaita Prakash alias Jaita Rafique, 45, of village Vurai in Dhalarchar of Bera upazila.

Officer-in-charge of Bera police station Sheikh Zillur Rahman said, acting on a tip-off, police caught him from a hideout at Char Nagdaha village of Dhalarchar.

Outlaws shot dead three unarmed policemen at Daspara village on July 20. Police arrested 9 criminals earlier in connection with the incident. Rafique is one of the suspected killers of the incident, Bera OC said. He was later produced in the court yesterday, he added.


Missing man found dead

UNB, Sylhet

Body of a missing man was recovered from under a bridge on Radhanagar Road in Goainghat upazila on Monday evening.

The deceased was identified as Alim Uddin, 45, son of late Zafar Ali of West Jafong in the upazila. Local sources said Alim left his home on Saturday and did not return. He remained missing since then.

Locals found his slaughtered body under Chhoto Khel Bridge and informed police who recovered the body and sent it to Sylhet Osmani Medical College and Hospital for autopsy.
