### Catching up with busy actor Anisur Rahman Milon

Actor Anisur Rahman Milon is fully immersed in single-episode plays, telefilms, serials and movies, with as many as 20 to 22 plays to be aired this Eid.

Milon found time off from his busy schedule to talk to The Daily Star (TDS) about his current assignments.

TDS: How many plays do you have on your plate

Milon: I have worked in at least 20-22 plays for this Eid. Some of them are: Shokal Ahmed's "Ekti Moddhobitto Bhabna"; Koushik Shankar Das' "Ekti Onnorokom Premer Golpo"; Masud Mohiuddin's "Prapti Shunno"; Zafar Al Mamun's "Tomari Kachhe"; Masud Sezan's "Bhoot Gaari" and Chayanika Chowdhury's "Jara Brishti te Bhijechilo".

TDS: Which are your favorite plays?

Milon: Singling out a play is not possible, as all of them are interesting and I thoroughly enjoyed working in them. I had chance to act with star actresses in some of the plays. I have worked with Aupee Karim in "Bhindeshi Taraa" and with Tarin in "Ekti Onnorokom Premer Golpo".

TDS: Any recent work in serials?

Milon: The pressure for Eid plays allows me less time to work on serials. However, I have seven/eight serials on hand. The latest serial, based on Humayun Ahmed's "Rumali", is being directed by Arun Chowdhury.

TDS: Any update on the film "Shoachan Pakhi"? Milon: Most of the work for the film is over. An interesting thing about the movie is that I have recorded a song for the soundtrack.



### Julia Roberts charms Tokyo

Over 20 years after Julia Roberts first flashed her toothsome smile on the big screen, the Hollywood A-lister finally touched down in Japan for the first time. America's sweetheart of romantic comedies arrived in Tokyo this week to promote her latest movie "Eat Pray Love", which is set to premiere in Japan on September 17.

As one of the biggest movie markets overseas and a frequent stop on international film promotion tours by other high-flying actors, Japan has to naturally wonder: what took you so long?

In recent years, the actress's absence from Japanese red carpets even manifested into a rumoured theory that she does not like the country. Try searching for "Julia Roberts" in Japanese on the Internet: Google offers to fill in the rest of the search phrase with "hates Japan". But such rumours could soon be dispelled by the actress's current visit.

"It's just my good fortune to finally find myself here in Tokyo with all of you nice people," said Roberts when asked how it was arranged for her to finally come to Japan at a press conference last Wednesday afternoon. To which one female journalist in the back cooed, "She's so cute."

While the new romantic comedy got pummelled in the box office opening weekend in the U.S. and Canada by Sylvester Stallone and his all-star cast of muscle men in "The Expendables", Japan swooned over Roberts during her maiden visit to the country. Wednesday all Roberts had to do to earn a healthy round of applause was greet the press with a "konnichiwa", the standard 'hello' phrase.

But not all language barriers were as easy to overcome. Before answering questions asked by a radio disc jockey who introduced herself as "Love", Roberts joked that she expected the radio personality to say her sisters' names were "Eat" and "Pray". Cue stony faces in the room. But it wasn't for its lack of humour that the joke fell flat. It wasn't until five minutes later when the interpreter got around to translating the play on words that the joke elicited a delayed guffaw, at which point Roberts had forgotten about the joke and the interpreter had to explain the sud-

Roberts did at least get a quicker laugh when the first question asked was from a reporter for a magazine called "This Film is Great."

"That's a magazine you want to be in," said the Hollywood veteran -- to peals of laughter.
