

RU forms body to identify alleged war criminals

Rajshahi University authorities on Saturday formed an 11-member committee to identify people who committed war crimes and crimes against humanity on the campus during the Liberation War in 1971.

RU vice chancellor Prof M Abdus Sobhan formed the committee with syndicate member Prof Chowdhury Zulfikar Matin as its convenor.

Contacted the VC said that formation of the committee was necessary as the International War Crimes Tribunal sent a letter seeking

information on persons who committed crimes during the 1971 war.

Other members of the committee are -- RU teachers Tofazzal Hossain Tarafdar, Abul Kashem, Shafikunnabi Samadi, Ananda Kumar Saha, Chowdhury Sarwar Jahan Sajal, Moloy Kumar Bhoomik, Sadekul Arefin Matin, Mahbuba Kaniz Keya, and Hasibul Alam Proshan.

Prof Fayekuzzaman was made member secretary of the committee and asked to submit report in quickest possible time.

Fayekuzzaman told this correspondent that the committee began working soon after it was constituted

and its first meeting would be held today.

In Netrakona, twelve alleged collaborators of Pakistani occupation forces have been sued on charge of killing a freedom fighter, reports our correspondent.

Mohammad Ali Reza, nephew of late freedom fighter Badiuzzaman Mukta of village Narandra Nagar under Sadar upazila of the district filed the case with the court of Senior Judicial Magistrate Netrakona Aminul Haque a few days ago.

The accused are Md. Obaidul Haque Tahar, 60, Ataur Rahman Nani, 59, Shahidullah Pintu, 62, Shahidur Rahman Maju, 58,

Md. Fazlur Rahaman, 68, Md. Yusuf, 61, Mister Mia, 58, Md. Hafizuddin Mir, 80, Md. Abdul Wahab Khan Ronu, 60, Md. Manik Mia, 58, Abdur Rashid, 60 and Farid Ahamed, 62, of different areas of Netrakona town.

The court took the case into cognizance and sent to the International War Crimes Tribunal.

The complainant in his petition stated that the accused picked up his nephew freedom fighter Badiuzzaman Mukta from Birampur Bazar under Sadar upazila and shot him dead at Mukterpara bridge in the town.

Firearms, jihadi books seized

Joypurhat Rab in a raid on Sunday evening recovered several firearms, lethal weapons, explosive materials and books and leaflets on jihad in Khetlal upazila.

The recovered materials include three pipe guns, 4 daggers, 3 books and 250 leaflets. However, none was arrested till filing of this report yesterday afternoon.

Sources said a Rab-5 team, acting on information, raided Moheshpur village in Khetlal upazila of Joypurhat at 7:40pm and recovered the arms and other materials from an abandoned well near the house of Montezar Rahman, a 'regional commander' of banned Islamist outfit Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB).

Contacted, Md. Alamgir Hossain, commanding officer of Joypurhat Rab confirmed

the incident.

The printed leaflets called people to join 'Allahr Dal' to free the country from the rule of human being. The leaflets also called for establishing rule of Allah, failing which it threatened to oust this government from the power within two months.

Police said at Moheshpur village in Khetlal upazila of Joypurhat police and JMB members had a gunfight when police raided the house of

Montezar Rahman during a 'secret' meeting. The gunfight left at least 7 policemen including then OC Iqbal Safi, injured.

During the gunfights, the JMB members also took away at least 28 bullets, two magazines and two shotguns and walkie-talkies from the policemen.

After the incident, 21 top JMB men including Bangla Bhai were arrested but all of them later got bail.

JCD ACTIVIST MURDER

13 including top outlaw sued

Police arrest one

One person was arrested on Sunday night in connection with the killing of Jatya Samajtantrik Dal (JSD) activist Sujit Kumar Singha Roy in Mirpur upazila of the district on Saturday night.

The arrestee is Hitler of Kazipara village under the upazila. Police said they are interrogating the arrestee and also looking for one Ashraf who took away Sujit from a shop at the village in his motorbike on Saturday night.

JSD activist Sujit was abducted on Saturday night and his body with throat slit was found in Lkhamidhar water body in the upazila Sunday morning.

Asit Kumar Singha Roy, elder brother of Sujit, filed a case with Mirpur Police Station on Sunday, accusing 13 people, including regional leader of outlawed Gono Bahini Anwar Hossain Anu, of killing his brother.

According to police, Sujit came out of his house at around 8:30pm on Saturday after receiving a phone call. Sujit arrived at a shop of Kazipur at around 9:30 pm and Ashraf, a suspected cadre of outlawed Gono Bahini and

also an accomplice of Anwar Hossain Anu, took away Sujit from the shop in a motorbike.

"Sujit might have been killed by outlawed Gono Bahini and one Anwar Hossain alias Anu, a regional leader of the outfit, was the mastermind behind the murder," Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Mirpur Police Station Mehedi Hasan said.

Sujit's cousin and president of JSD Bheramara upazila unit Ranjit Kumar Singha Roy was shot dead by the operatives of outlawed Gono Bahini in October 20, 1998. Anwar Hossain Anu is prime accused in Ranjit murder case which is still pending with a Kushtia court.

Sources said Ranjit was killed as he raised his voice against the criminal activities of Gono Bahini in Mirpur area.

Golan Mohsin, JSD district unit president has demanded immediate arrest of the killers of Sujit. JSD Mirpur and Daulatpur units brought out processions at the upazila headquarters on Sunday evening demanding immediate arrest of Sujit's killers. Contacted, Kushtia Police Superintendent Sahabuddin Khan said police have identified the killers and drive is on to arrest them.

Three rescued from robbers' microbus

Police arrested three alleged robbers in Lolbaria area of Sadar Dakkhin upazila on Saturday night and rescued three people from their microbus.

Police said a gang of armed robbers in a microbus barricaded the Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Lalbag area of the upazila at midnight.

Identifying themselves as DB men they halted a Dhaka-bound covered van from Chittagong and took away cash and mobile phone sets from its two drivers -- Abul Qasem and M Alauddin and helper Masud.

Later, two of the gang members took control of the

van loaded with plastic materials worth Tk 2 crore and fled away with the vehicle.

The rest five robbers forcibly took the two drivers and helper to the microbus and started for Lalmai hill but on the way at Lolbaria the victims raised a hue and cry.

Hearing their cry for help, a team of patrol police after a hot chase seized the microbus and arrested the robbers identified as Omar Faruque, 30, Mosharraf, 31, and Mizan, 30, while two others, Delwar and Wasim, managed to flee.

Later, police recovered the hijacked covered van in abandoned condition from near the Mohona CNG Filling Station in Daudkandi upazila.
