

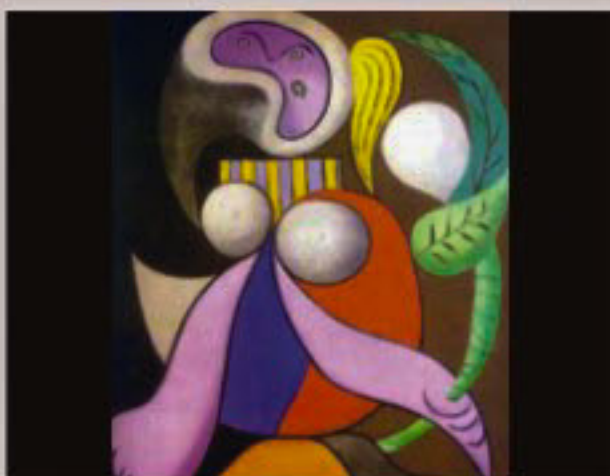

## Discussion on Nazrul at Bangla Academy

On the occasion of the 34th death anniversary of National

Poet Kazi Nazrul Islam, Bangla Academy held a discussion and cultural programme at its Seminar Room on August 29.

Nazrul artiste Dr. Leena Taposhi Khan read out an essay on the sub genres of Nazrul songs. Noted researcher and music expo-

nent Dr. Karunamaya Goswami and theatre personality Khairul Alam Sabuj were present as discussants. Professor Golam Murshid presided over the programme. Shamsuzzaman Khan, director general of Bangla Academy, delivered the welcome speech at the programme.

The discussants were of the view that Nazrul was not only a remarkable poet but also an outstanding music composer, brave journalist and profound philosopher.

The poet was sent to jail for his outspoken nature and literary works against the British rule. His poems and songs inspired the nation during its times of need -- they added.

The discussants also

focused on the poet's struggles and his unique style of writing.

Khairul Alam Sabuj said, "After Nazrul was incapacitated by neurological illness in 1942, his songs were distorted beyond imagination. His writings address our contemporary socio-political issues."

Golam Murshid said, "The poet had lived a life of hardship. He believed in secularism and we should not categorise him as a representative of a certain community or group. We should read his works closely."

After the discussion, noted Nazrul singers Fatema-Tuj-Zohra, Ferdous Ara, Khairul Anam Shakil and Sujit Mustafa rendered songs at the programme.

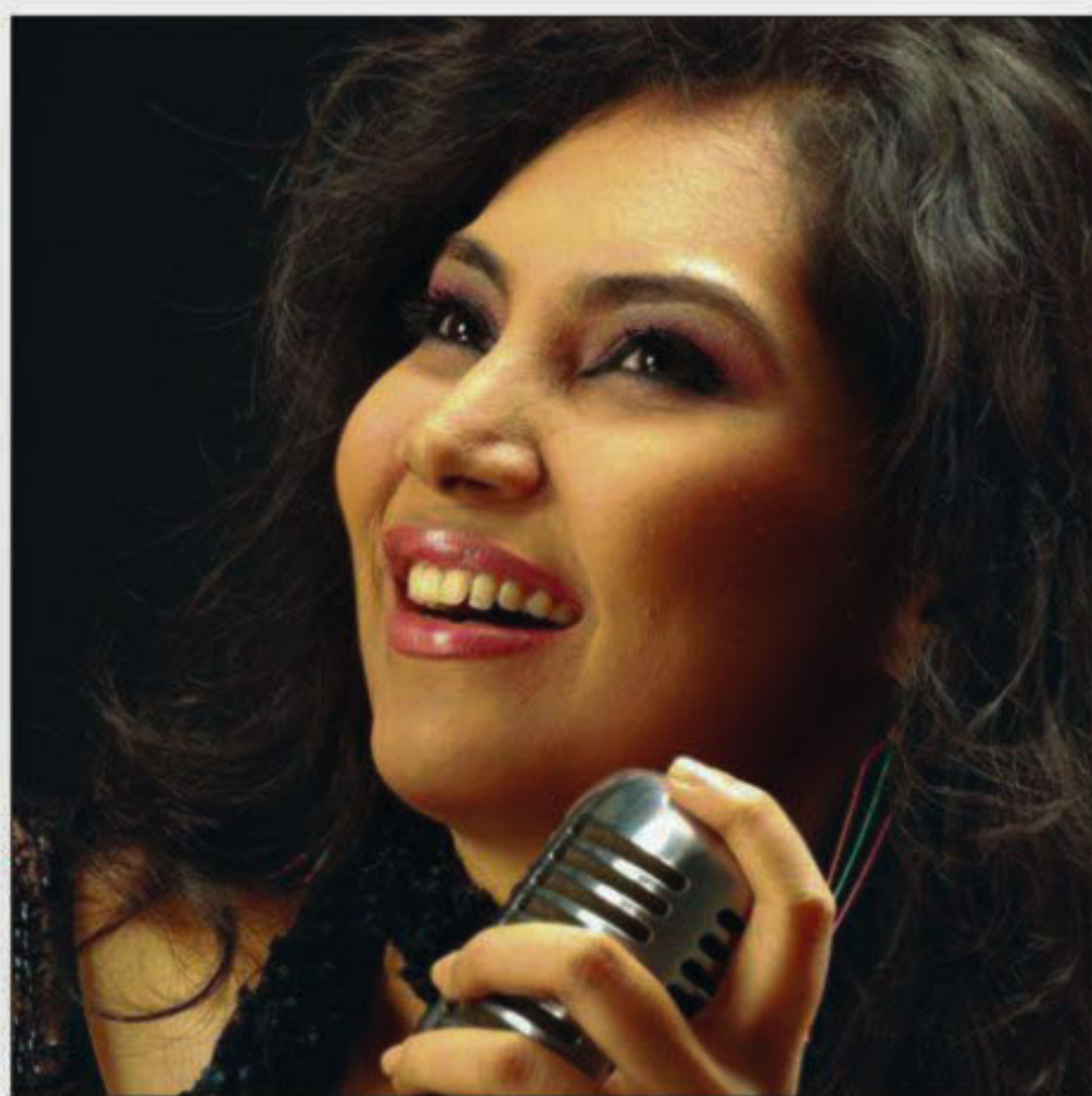
## Mehreen to sing a Najma Zaman song this Eid
