Oil prices edged slightly down in Asian trade Thursday after soaring in New York the previous day on strong US manufacturing data, analysts said.

New York's main contract, light sweet crude for October delivery, slid five cents to 73.86 dollars a barrel in the afternoon.

Brent North Sea crude for delivery in October fell 25 cents to 76.10 dollars.

The Institute of Supply Management said its manufacturing index rose to 56.3 points from 55.5 percent in July, trumping forecasts for a fall to 52.9 percent.

A reading above 50 percent indicates an expanding manufacturing sector.
