The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a Credit (No. 4475 BD) in the amount of about US\$ 130 million from the International Development Association (IDA) toward the cost of Secondary Education Quality and Access Enhancement Project (SEQAEP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for consulting services to be procured under the project. - Scope of services of the FMS will include, but not limited to, the following:
  - Preparation of annual budget estimates and financial plan, submission of the original and revised budget to the planning wing of the MoE and variance analysis as part of the quarterly Financial Monitoring Reports (FMRs).
  - Preparation of annual and quarterly disbursement forecasts for all components and analyze the reasons for variances between actual and forecast disbursements.
