

When the official announcement of India's highest national cinema award was announced on September 10, 74-year-old Daggubati Ramanaidu was busy living life the way he has always done -- by overseeing the shooting of his latest film. And when the news about his choice for Dadasaheb Phalke award reached him at a picturesque place in his home state of Andhra Pradesh, he just wiped the sweat off his face and was humility personified. "I'm indeed honoured by the award," all that Ramanaidu told reporters on reaching the nearest major city of Visakhapatnam wrapping up the day's shoot.

The award carrying a cash prize of Rs one million will be presented to the veteran producer when national film awards are conferred by the President of India in October this year.
