

Robbers kill house owner in Comilla

4 held with arms in Noakhali

Robbers killed one person while looting his house in Comilla yesterday while four of a gang were held and arms recovered from their possession in Noakhali on Thursday.

A house owner was killed and five other members of his family were injured as armed robbers stormed into the house and looted valuables at Perul village in Sadar Dakkhin upazila of Comilla early yesterday.

UNB quoting police said, a gang of robbers stormed into the house of Ajit Barun Roy and looted valuables including Tk 40,000 in cash, five tolas of gold and a mobile

phone set keeping the house members hostage at gun-point.

At one stage, the gang beat up Ratan and Jatan, two sons of the house owner mercifully and stabbed Ajit to death as they tried to resist them.

Hearing the hue and cry locals rushed to the spot. Sensing danger, the robbers opened fire on them, leaving Sujon, Bijoy, Moron and Jatin injured and left the place safely with booties.

In Noakhali, Companyganj police arrested four robbers and recovered a light machine-gun (LG) and other lethal weapons from their possession in Kojarghat area under

the upazila early Thursday.

The arrestees were identified as gang leader Jahurul, 38, Billal, 30, Mainuddin, 28, and Jasim Uddin, 25, reports a correspondent.

Officer-in-charge Companyganj PS Md Jasim Uddin said, on Wednesday midnight, acting on a tip-off, he along with his team conducted a drive in Kojarghat area and cordoned the whole area while the robbers were taking preparation to commit a robbery and arrested those robbers from the spot in the early hours of Thursday.

Two separate cases were lodged with Companyganj police station in this connection.

Classes resume at RU amid tight security

Classes resumed at Rajshahi University (RU) amid tight security yesterday after a 17-day Eid vacation.

Earlier, the residential halls of the university reopened on Friday.

Police and Detective Branch men were seen checking the identity cards of students at seven gates of the university as they were returning to halls while law enforcers patrolling the campus to thwart any untoward situation.

The RU authorities also asked the teachers, officials, students and employees to keep their identity cards with them while on the campus.

Proctor Prof Chowdhury M Zakaria told this correspondent that the authorities strengthened security to avoid any untoward situation and also imposed restriction on movement of outsiders on the campus.

"Stern action would be taken if anybody tries to create chaos on the campus", he said. Earlier, the university author-

ities vacated all the residential halls during Eid vacation from September 7 as rival activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) locked in a series of clashes on the campus.

On August 15, BCL worker Nasirullah Nasim was severely stabbed and tossed from first floor of Shah Mukhdoom hall after an iftar with his rival faction.

Eight-day after his injury, he died at Dhaka Medical College and Dhaka Hospital.

Following the incident, BCL central committee through a notice suspended university unit president Awal Kabir Joy and secretary Mazdul Islam Opu for life.

About two weeks before Nasim killing, the committee (BCL central committee) suspended the university unit BCL activities for indefinite period because of a series of factional clashes. Opu was arrested and sent him jail.

Besides, the university authorities in a syndicate meeting temporarily expelled six activists of BCL on September 6 on charges of killing Nasim.

Urea output suspended in B'baria

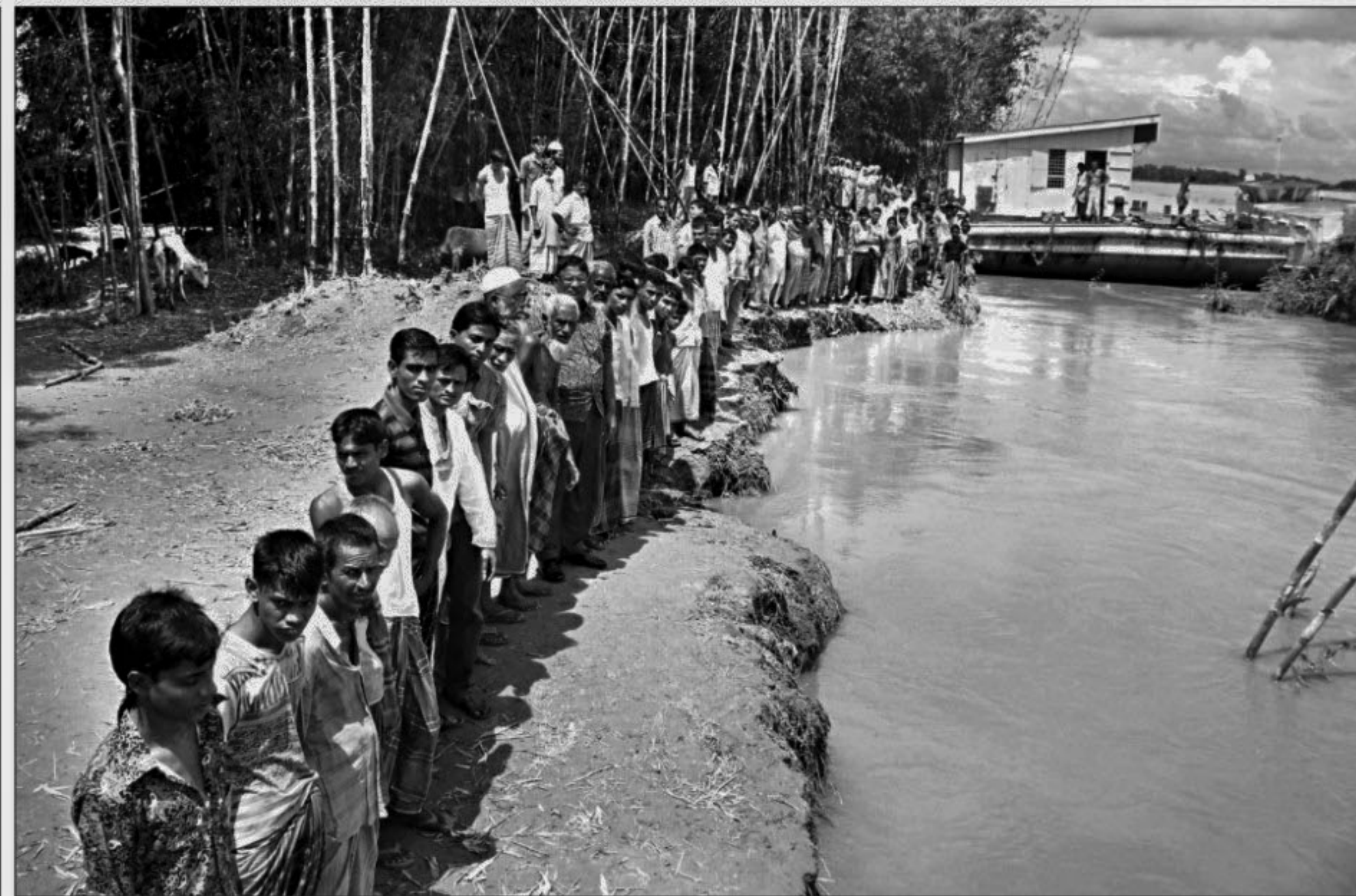
Urea production at Ashuganj Fertiliser and Chemical Company Limited (AFCCCL) remain suspended since Friday night due to technical glitch at the plant.

Managing Director of AFCCCL Md Osman Gani said the authorities shut down the production at about 8:00pm after a leakage developed in its HTCC vessel.

The factory that produces around 1150 metric tonnes (MT) of urea daily will be able to restart production on September 21, the MD said.

In Natore, the workers of North Bengal Sugar Mill staged a sit-in on the factory premises yesterday morning demanding a separate wage board, reports a correspondent.

Anwar Kamal, general secretary of the union, said the strike will continue until the demand is met.

Hundreds join Gur Pukur Mela

The traditional Gur Pukur Mela (fair) began in Satkhira town on Friday through worshipping Devi Manasha (goddess of snakes) by Hindu devotees.

Traders from different parts of the country have set up stalls around the pond at Manasha tala in Palashpool area of the town. Hundreds of people visit the fair everyday and buy goods of their choice. Saplings of fruit bearing and medicinal plants are also brought to the mela.

The mela is being arranged around the pond at Palashpool on the basis of a heresy that a king of the Gaud dynasty took rest here while returning from the

Sundarbans. When the king was asleep, goddess Manasha asked him to dig a pond. He dug a pond that was filled with sweet water. The king worshipped goddess Manasha and then the pond was named as Gur Pukur.

Some people say ancestors of the Gaud Brahmin Community dug the pond and arranged puja on its bank 300 years ago. Others say the scion of Gaud dynasty dug the pond and worshipped goddess Manasha.

But the mela has lost its significant number of visitors following bomb blasts at Roxy cinema and at a circus in the town in 2002. At least three people were killed and 100 others injured in the blasts.

10 injured as transport workers clash

At least 10 people were injured in a clash between two groups of transport workers at Kurua bazaar in Sreebordi upazila Friday afternoon.

Of the injured, Babul Mia, 28, Aslam Iqbal, 34, Rana, 6, Nazrul Islam Tota, 25, Asad, 18, were admitted at Sreebordi and Sadar hospitals.

Locals said there was a long-standing dispute between members of Sherpur District Auto-tempo Leguna Drivers Union and Sherpur District Auto-tempo, Auto rickshaw Drivers Union over collecting tolls from tempo, CNG-run auto-rickshaw and others small vehicles.

The clash ensued as one group of transport workers led by Billal, Liton and Rajib attacked their opponent group of Feroz and Rubel at about 1pm at the bazaar.

At one stage the feuding groups also ransacked 10 shops at the bazaar.

Patient's death triggers protest by relatives

Three employees of Patuakhali General Hospital were injured as relatives of a patient went into rampage following her death at the hospital yesterday morning.

The injured are Zafar Pada, 22, security staff, Sohag, 20, ward boy, and Tara Banu, 50, sweeper of the hospital.

Kohinoor Begum, 23, wife of Farid Uddin Jomadder of Rajnagar village under Baufal upazila was admitted to the hospital on Thursday as she was suffering from anaemia, police and hospital sources said.

The patient, who was kept under the observation of Dr Atiqur Rahman, medicine consultant of the hospital, died at about 9:40am on Saturday.

Getting the news of her death at about 11:00am yesterday, her relatives became agitated and tried to attack the doctors when the hospital staff resisted. Relatives of the patient ransacked doors, windows and furniture of the hospital and injured the three staff.

Kohinoor's relatives claimed Kohinoor died due to negligence by the doctor and other staff of the hospital.

Following Dr Atiqur Rahman's advice, we brought a bag of blood for Kohinoor on Friday but it was not pushed into her body. As a result she died," said the patient's aunt Aleya Begum.

Denying the allegation of negligence to the patient, Dr Atiqur said, "The patient was not in a condition to receive blood as she was suffering from anaemia for long."

Dr Mostafizur Rahman, acting superintendent of the hospital, said proper treatment was given to the patient but her condition was very critical.

"Police arrested Halim, 35, Milton, 32, and Rahima, 28, -- all relatives of the patient, but later freed them. The situation is under control and police have been deployed on the hospital compound," said Noresh Chandra Karmaker, officer in charge of Patuakhali police station.
