Paris Saint-Germain goalkeeper Apoula Edel was on Monday interviewed by police as part of an investigation into claims he lied about his age and real identity.

Edel was quizzed at a police station in Poissy in the Paris suburbs and left late on Monday afternoon without speaking to reporters.

The goalkeeper first hit the headlines last year when Philibert, who says he coached the player in Cameroon, claimed Edel was 29 rather than 24 and was actually called Ambroise Beyamena. French sport weekly Le 10 Sport on

Friday published documents accusing Edel of lying about his age and identity, which were handed to the authorities by Philibert. PSG subsequently released a state-

ment saying they were "dismayed" by the reports and claiming that the article "added nothing new" to the case.

The club have also made a claim of defamation against Edel's accuser.

The documents published by Le 10 Sport included a copy of a request for a playing licence for the 1998-99 season

made under the name Ambroise Beyamena, whose date of birth was given as April 19, 1981.

The request had been validated by the Cameroon football federation and was subsequently authenticated by the Cameroonian authorities in January this
